Ministry of I&B issues fresh Advisory warning against advertisements of betting and gambling

Advertisements of betting platforms in violation of Indian laws, reiterates Ministry

New Delhi, April 6 (PIB) The Ministry of Information & Broadcasting has today advised media entities, media platforms and the online advertisement intermediaries to refrain from carrying advertisements/ promotional content of betting platforms. In an Advisory issued today, the Ministry has taken strong exception to the recent instances of mainstream English and Hindi newspapers carrying advertisements and promotional content of betting websites. The Advisory has been issued to all media formats, including newspapers, television channels, and online news publishers, and showed specific examples where such advertisements have appeared in the media in recent times. The Ministry has also objected to the promotion by a specific betting platform encouraging the audience to watch a sports league on its website, which prima facie appears to be in violation of the Copyright Act, 1957. While emphasizing on the legal obligation as well as the moral duty of the media, the Advisory refers to provisions of the Norms of Journalistic Conduct of the Press Council which, inter alia, mentions that "newspapers should not publish an advertisement containing anything which is unlawful or illegal.....", and further that "The newspapers and periodicals should scrutinize the advertisement inputs from ethical as well as legal angles in view of the editor's responsibility for all contents including advertisement, under Section 7 of PRB Act, 1867. Revenue generation alone cannot and should not be the sole aim of the Press, juxtaposed much larger public responsibility". The Ministry had earlier issued Advisories in the months of June and October, 2022 stating that betting and gambling are illegal, and hence direct or

New Delhi, April 6 Total enrolments under various schemes of National Pension System (NPS) and Atal Pension Yojana (APY) have crossed one crore 35 lakh margin during the Financial Year 2022-23. With a cumulative enrolment of over 10 lakh subscribers, NPS Private sector comprising NPS All Citizen and NPS Corporate - accounted for about 60 per cent. The Ministry said, over thousand nine hundred vaccine doses of COVID were administered during the last 24 hours. Over 220 crore 66 lakh vaccine doses have been administered across the country so far.

Directorate of Disaster Management issues Safety tips on Hot Weather Condition

Port Blair, April 6
From last few weeks temperature has risen drastically due to summer season which can be dangerous, especially for vulnerable populations such as the elderly, young children, and people with certain health conditions. Dr. Nitin Shakya, Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration has requested the residents of ANI to follow Do's and Don'ts on Hot Weather Condition. Here are some Do's and Don'ts to help you stay safe during Hot Weather Condition:
Do's:
➤ Drink plenty of water: Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water and other non-alcoholic beverages throughout the day.
➤ Stay in a cool place: Stay in an air conditioned environment, or if that's not possible, find a cool, shaded area, such as a tree-covered park or a building.



➤ Wear appropriate clothing: Wear lightweight, loose-fitting, and light-colored clothing to help your body stay cool.
➤ Use sunscreen: Protect your skin from the sun's harmful rays by applying sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher.
➤ Check on others: Keep an eye on friends, family, and neighbours who may be more vulnerable to heat-related illnesses.
Don'ts:
➤ Never leave children or pets in hot cars: Never leave children or pets in a parked car, even for a few minutes.
➤ Never Exercise outdoors during peak heat hours: Avoid outdoor exercise during the hottest parts of the day, typically from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m.
➤ Avoid Drinking alcohol: Avoid drinking alcoholic beverages as they can dehydrate your body and make it harder to regulate your body temperature.
➤ Never overexert yourself: Avoid over exertion, especially during the hottest parts of the day. Take frequent breaks and rest as needed.
