Mysuru, April 9 (PIB) The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated the program 'Commemoration of 50 years of Project Tiger' at Mysuru University in Mysuru, Karnataka today. The Prime Minister also launched the International Big Cats Alliance (IBCA). He released the publications - 'Amrit Kaal Ka Vision For Tiger Conservation', a summary report of the 5th cycle of Management Effectiveness Evaluation of Tiger Reserves, declared tiger numbers and released the summary report of All India Tiger Estimation (5th cycle). He also released a commemorative coin on the completion of 50 years of Project Tiger.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister remarked on the prestigious moment of the growing tiger population in India and paid respects by giving a standing ovation to the tigers. He said that everyone is witness to the landmark event of Project Tiger completing 50 years today and remarked that its success is not only a moment of pride for India but the entire world. The Prime Minister emphasized that India has not only saved the tiger population from declining but also provided an ecosystem where



tigers can flourish. The Prime Minister expressed happiness that India is home to 75% of the world's tiger population in the 75th year of Indian independence. It is also a coincidence, the Prime Minister

continued, that the tiger reserves in India cover 75,000 square kilometers of land and in the past ten to twelve years, the tiger population in the country has increased by 75 percent. Reiterating the

question in the minds of wildlife enthusiasts around the world about the increasing tiger population in India when compared to other countries where it is either stagnant or in decline, the Prime Minister said that the answer is hidden among the traditions and culture of India and its natural urge towards biodiversity and environment. Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; Minister of State (Independent Charge) Earth Sciences; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh today said that nearly 9% share of electricity is likely to be contributed from India's nuclear sources by the year 2047 when India celebrates 100 years of independence and that this would help

in getting closer with the commitment of achieving net zero target by 2070.

Union Minister Dr Jitendra Singh made these remarks after holding a review meeting with a group of senior scientists from the Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Department of Atomic Energy, at Mumbai.

The Minister said that the other targets laid down by the Department of Atomic Energy are achieving 20 GW capacity of nuclear power

It is brought to the kind notice of general public that due to increase in ambient temperature, there has been a substantial increase in power demand which has created a shortage of power during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman. All the consumers of Electricity Department have been advised to use the available energy judiciously in view of shortage of power particularly during the evening peak hours.

Further, it is also requested that usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Geysers, Garden lighting may kindly be avoided during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM. This would help the Department to maintain power supply in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman without curtailment. The Electricity Department is closely monitoring for the compliance of above by conducting surprise checks to ensure effective Demand Side Management by all consumers, a press release from SE, Electricity Department said.

Several instances have come to the notice of the Transport Department that permit holders are not plying their Auto Rickshaws instead they are hiring drivers to ply their Auto Rickshaws which is a violation under section 66/192 (A) Motor Vehicle (Amendment) Act, 2019. Apart from challan, the challan will be forwarded to RTO for suspension/

cancellation of permit.

This rule is enforced against those Auto Rickshaw owners, on whose permit the above mentioned clause is stated.

In this regard, to create awareness amongst Auto Rickshaw Owners/ Drivers, a meeting was convened recently with Auto Rickshaw Union leaders under the chairmanship of Shri Ajay Kumar Rai, Dy. SP (Traffic)/DHQ to discuss the same &

Scheme which was later modified as Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS), now operational through State NHM Program Implementation Plan instead of private sector insurance company.

The objective of the Family Planning Indemnify Scheme is to indemnify all beneficiaries of sterilization, doctors and health facilities (public and accredited private/NGO) conducting sterilization operation in the unlikely event of death/ failure/complication following sterilization operation.

Recently, on compliance of directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India with respect to the doubling of compensation under Family Planning Indemnity Scheme (FPIS) and to share the burden thereof equally by the Govt. of India and the respective State Government, the UT Administration of A&N Islands has notified the doubling of ex-compensation fixed under Family Planning Indemnity Scheme under Section 1 (A-D) with effect from October 15, 2020 issue of the Notification in respect of claims being settled hereafter. The content of the scheme are as under:-

has only 2.4 percent of the world's land area but it contributes toward 8 percent to known global biodiversity. He stated that India is the largest tiger range country in the world, the largest Asiatic elephant range country in the world with nearly thirty thousand elephants, and also the largest single-horn rhino country with a population of nearly three thousand. He further added that India is the only country in the world to have Asiatic lions and its population has increased from around 525 in 2015 to around 675 in 2020. He also touched upon India's leopard population and stated that it increased by over 60 percent in 4 years. Referring to the work being done to clean up rivers such as the Ganga, the Prime Minister highlighted that some aquatic species that were once considered to be in danger have shown improvement. He credited the people's participation and a culture of conservation for these achievements.

"It is important for ecosystems to thrive for the wildlife to thrive", the Prime Minister remarked as he noted the work done in India. He mentioned that the country added 11 wetlands to its list of Ramsar sites taking the total number of Ramsar Sites to 75. He also noted that India added over 2200 square kilometers of forest and tree cover by 2021 when compared to 2019. In the last decade, the Prime Minister said, the number of Community Reserves increased from 43 to over 100 and the number of National Parks and sanctuaries around which Eco-sensitive Zones were notified increased from 9 to 468, that too in a decade.

Highlighting the motto of 'One Earth, One Family, One Future' for India's G20 presidency, the Prime Minister said that it amplifies the message that a better future for humanity is possible only when our environment remains safe and our biodiversity continues to expand. "This responsibility belongs to all of us, it belongs to the whole world", he reiterated. Mentioning COP26, the Prime Minister stated that India has set big and ambitious goals and expressed confidence in mutual cooperation that can help in achieving every goal of environmental protection.

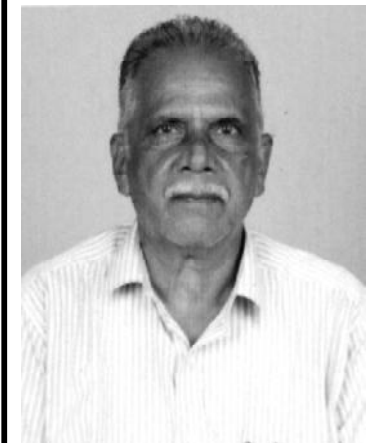
