PM addresses National Rozgar Mela Distributes about 71,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government Departments and Organizations

New Delhi, April 13 (PIB)

The Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi addressed the National Rozgar Mela via video conferencing today. He distributed about 71,000 appointment letters to newly inducted recruits in various Government Departments and Organizations. The new recruits selected from across the country will join various positions/posts under Government of India such as Train Manager, Station Master, Sr. Commercial cum Ticket Clerk, Inspector, Sub Inspectors, Constable, Stenographer, Junior Accountant, Postal Assistant, Income Tax Inspector, Tax Assistant, Sr. Draughtsman, JE/Supervisor, Assistant Professor, Teacher, Librarian, Nurse, Probationary Officers, PA, MTS, among others. The newly inducted appointees will also be able to train



themselves through Karmayogi Prarambh, an online orientation course for all new appointees in various Government Departments. 45 places were connected with the Mela during the Prime Minister's address.

Addressing the gathering, the Prime Minister greeted the nation on the auspicious occasion of Baisakhi. He congratulated the candidates and their

families for getting the appointment letter. The Prime Minister remarked that the Government is committed to providing the right opportunities for the talent and energy of the youth to achieve the resolutions of a developed India. He noted that recruitment letters to more than 22,000 teachers were handed out in Madhya Pradesh only yesterday. "This Rozgar Mela is proof of our commitment towards the youth of the nation."

examples of startups and Indian youth's enthusiasm, the Prime Minister referred to a report that said that startups have created more than 40 lakh direct or indirect jobs. He also mentioned drones and the sports sector as new avenues of employment.

The Prime Minister said, "The thinking and approach of Aatmnirbhar Bharat Abhiyan go beyond adopting swadeshi and 'vocal for local'. Aatmnirbhar Bharat Abhiyan is an 'abhiyan' of creating crores of employment opportunities from villages to cities." He gave examples of indigenously made modern satellites and semi-high-speed trains. He said that more than 30000 LHB coaches have been manufactured in India in the last 8-9 years. Technology and raw materials for these coaches have created thousands of jobs in India.

Directing his address to those who have received their appointment letters today, the Prime Minister remarked that this is the opportunity to contribute to the development of the country while the nation moves ahead with the goal of becoming a developed India by 2047. "Today you are starting your journey as a Government Servant", the Prime Minister continued, "In this journey, one should always remember those things which you used to feel as an ordinary citizen." Noting the expectations of the new appointees from the Government, the Prime Minister highlighted that it is now their responsibility to fulfill the expectations of others. "Each one of you will affect the life of a common man through your work in one way or the other", he added. The Prime Minister emphasized that efforts should be made to create a positive impact on the work and improve the lives of the common man. Concluding the address, the Prime Minister urged the new appointees to not pause their learning process and said that the nature of knowing or learning something new is reflected in both work and personality. He also advised them to upgrade their skills by joining the online learning platform iGoT Karmayogi.

in which 336 persons died and 1040 were injured. Out of 336 who died, 68 were Officers and Jawans of Mumbai Fire Brigade.

To commemorate the act of bravery of the Officers and men of Mumbai Fire Brigade who lost their lives during the fire fighting operation, April 14th is observed as Fire Service Day. A week long programme has been chalked out by A & N Fire Service as part of the observance.

On April 14, Commemoration Day Parade will be held to pay homage to Martyrs at Fire Service Headquarter at 0700 hours. On the same day, Fleet march of Fire vehicles in and around Port Blair will be conducted from 0730 hours. On April 15, a 5 kms Walkathon will be conducted from Light House Restaurant, Marina Park to Corbyn's Cove from 0530 hours. This will be followed by Fire Awareness class and demo of fire extinguishers and equipment at Flag Point at 1730 hours. On April 16, Mock Drill/Awareness programme will be held at Bay Island Resort from 1000 hours onwards followed by Fire Awareness class and demo of fire extinguishers and equipment at Corbyn's Cove Beach from 1730 hours. On April 17, Yoga practice will be held at Fire Service Headquarter at 0600 hours. On the same day, Fire awareness class and demo of fire extinguishers and equipment will be conducted at Bathubasti Market place from 1730 hours. Similarly, on April 18, a Drawing & Painting competition for school students in two categories (1st to 5th class & 6th to 9th class) will be conducted at Fire Station Aberdeen from 1000 hours onwards. This will be followed by Mock Drill at GSSS School Line and Hotel Bathu Basti at 1500 hours. On April 19, Badminton singles will be conducted for Police/Fire personnel at Fire Station Marine from 1000 hours onwards followed by Mock Drill at G.B. Pant Hospital for Hospital staff & general public at 1500 hours. The closing programme of Fire Service Week will be on April 20 at Fire Service Headquarter.

The weeklong programme will start with a Commemoration Day Parade on April 14, 2023 at 0700 hours at Fire Service Headquarters, Port Blair. Two minute silence will be observed to pay homage to those Fire Service personnel who had laid down their lives for ensuring fire safety of countrymen. Soon after the parade, a Fleet March of Fire Vehicles shall be taken out in and around Port Blair town. The rationale behind the week long programme is to create awareness among general public with respect to fire safety, educational campaign through banners, pamphlets, lectures and demonstrations at various institutions including village community premises, hospitals, schools, hotels & resorts. Similar programmes will also be conducted in Fire Stations located at far flung Islands.

In the year 2022, a total of 223 fire calls and 587 special service calls were attended by A & N Fire Service and property worth about Rs. 85.46 crores was saved.

The A & N Police Fire Service is committed to generate public awareness about Fire Prevention by conducting special campaign in densely populated areas, Government buildings, industrial establishments, hospitals, hotels and resorts during the Fire Service Week, a press release from SP (Fire) said.

by the Secretary (Fisheries). The traders and exporters were advised to take benefit of the workshop for registration of their chilled fish establishments as per the required quality compliance for better acceptance of Andaman branded Seafood in the International Market.

On the occasion, multilingual pamphlets (Hindi, English, Tamil, Telugu, Bangla) of PMMSY Programme devised by Department of Fisheries was also released for intensification of the extension activities and better dissemination of the scheme components among all sections of the society.

During the inaugural session, Shri Vikram Singh, Director of Fisheries and Shri S.U Maheshwar Rao, GBM-NFDB, Hyderabad addressed the gathering on the intervention being initiated by the Administration to boost export of seafood and capacity development. Dr. Ansar Ali, Deputy Director, MPEDA Chennai Regional Office delivered lecture on Export Promotional Activities, Registration Procedure and Global Status of Seafood Export and emphasized on setting up of more number of chilled fish packaging units in Andaman and Nicobar Islands in light of opening international air route from Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Dr. Joy V Thomas, CEO, NETFISH highlighted the importance of hygienic handling of fish catch from the level of harvest to marketing for better export earnings and reduction of post-harvest loss. Shri Sarvanan, Scientific Officer, RGCA explained about the breeding, seed production and rearing of potential aquaculture species like Seabass, Tiger Prawn and Mud Crab etc. and the activities of RGCA in Aquaculture sector. The RGCA assured supply of fish seeds on request of fish farmers of Andaman and Nicobar Islands for initiating Brackish water aquaculture activities.
