G7 Ministers' Meeting on Climate, Energy and Environment

Protecting and restoring ecosystems can help reduce extent of climate change and cope with its impacts : Union Minister

New Delhi, April 16 (PIB) Union Minister for Environment, Forest and Climate Change and Labour and Employment, Shri Bhupender Yadav said, protecting and restoring ecosystems can help us reduce the extent of climate change and cope with its impacts. Speaking at the Plenary Session at the G7 Ministers' Meeting on Climate, Energy and Environment in Sapporo, Japan he said, it is therefore important that we address issues related to climate change in tandem with environmental action, holistically. We do hope that this is at the core of deliberations of this meeting of the Climate, Energy and Environment Ministers of



the G7 Countries, he added.

Shri Yadav said, climate change, desertification and biodiversity loss are deeply interlinked and pose existential challenges to humanity. In response to these challenges, Rio Conventions have made remarkable progress, through a consensus driven approach, based on principles, he said. Shri Yadav said, very recently at the CBD conference in Montreal we adopted the Global

Biodiversity Framework and at CoP27 at Sharm el Sheikh, landmark decisions on issues like the Loss and Damage Fund were taken. However, there still is a long way to go.

The Union Minister said, India in its Presidency of G-20, for example, has taken this approach and embedded mitigation and adaptation deeply across priority areas of arresting land degradation, accelerating ecosystem restoration, and enriching biodiversity. He said, the approach promotes a sustainable and climate resilient blue economy; encouraging resource efficiency and circular economy; with Lifestyle for

State Level Medical Board constituted to enquire cases of medical negligence against public & private hospitals/staff and doctors

Port Blair, April 16 The competent authority has approved the State Level Medical Board, which will cover all three Districts of Andaman and Nicobar Islands to enquire into the cases of medical negligence against Public and Private Hospitals/staffs and doctors. The Director, ANIIMS, Port Blair will be the Chairman of the Board. The Director of Health Services, A&N Administration; a

member from District Indian Medical Association; Subject Specialist/HOD specially related to complaint; Section In-charge, Legal, ANIIMS will be the Members of the Board. The Medical Superintendent will be the Member Secretary.

The Board shall examine complaints against the Private/ Govt. Doctors/Hospitals of A&N Islands for medical negligence and will be empowered to

call and seek the assistance of anybody or any record associated with the complaint and will have the power to inspect the premises as per need of the case and submit the concerned report to the Director, ANIIMS, who is the Chairman of the Committee and who will take necessary needful action or onward submission to the competent authority, a press release from MS, GB Pant Hospital said.

Octogenarian undergoes Supra Major Cancer Surgery laparoscopically at G. B. Pant Hospital/ANIIMS Patient now on chemotherapy and is doing extremely well

Port Blair, April 16

An 86 year old lady was admitted in the Department of General and Minimal Access Surgery with complaints of abdominal distention, pain in abdomen and not passing stool for last 4 to 6 weeks. She underwent preoperative investigations with blood, CT scan abdomen and colonoscopy which revealed a cancerous growth in the transverse large colon causing obstruction to the passage of solid food particles and faeces. Clinically she



was poorly nourished and anaemic and per abdomen there was a mass palpable in the upper abdomen. Pre-operatively, her nutritional status improved by giving IV fluids, albumin and parenteral nutrition.

She was taken up for a major Laparoscopic Surgery under high risk on



22/02/23. A team of Specialist Doctors headed by Laparoscopic Surgeon, Dr. Saji Vargheese and Anaesthetist, Dr. Narayan carried out a 4 1/2 hours key whole surgery through 5 ports and removed the entire right half of the large bowel namely right extended radical Hemicolectomy with

2 weeks and was doing extremely well. Patient was started on adjuvant oral chemotherapy agent once the biopsy report came. Now, she is on regular follow up every 21 days as she is on chemotherapy and is doing extremely well.

It is pertinent to mention that such Advanced Supra Major Surgeries are now regularly being performed in this hospital, for which previously patients were referred to mainland Super Speciality hospital, a press release from ANIIMS said.

CIPMC conducts Slug Caterpillar Survey in Nancowry Group of Islands

Port Blair, April 16

Pest monitoring and surveillance is a significant activity of DPPQS, Faridabad, Union MoA&FW. In the wake of incidence of Slug Caterpillar infestation in coconut orchards of Nimbudala area and report of previous incidence in Katchal and Chowra Islands, a periodic pest survey was conducted by Dr. Shiva Kumar H.D., Assistant Plant Protection Officer, Central Integrated Pest Management Centre (CIPMC), Port Blair to identify pest and disease associated with Coconut based agro ecosystems of Kamorta, Katchal, Teressa, Chowra Islands in consultation with Shri S.P. Prasad, Asst. Director (Soil), Zonal Agri Office, Nancowry Group of Islands.

A team comprising of Dr. Shiva Kumar H.D. and Sh. Mohammed Haneefa, AFA, Spices Progeny Orchard, Katchal inspected the coconut plantations in Kapanga, E-Wall, Japan Tikrey, Kambelwe, Jhoola, Jansin and discussed with Shri L. Aron, Captain-Meenakshi Ram Nagar Shelter about Nicobari Aloo



and Coconut Slug Caterpillar in the present and previous years.

Since Coconut Slug Caterpillar infestation was reported in Chowra Island in previous year, Dr. Shiva Kumar H.D. visited the infested orchard in Kuitasuk area to observe the recovery with Shri David Froster, 1st Captain Ta-eela, Shri Peter Patrick, Farmer Friend, Shri Godfred, Secretary, NYKS and observed Rhinoceros

Beetle, leaf spot in trace to low intensity and informed the farmers to report any incidence of pest and diseases to CIPMC through Directorate of Agriculture to protect the only livelihood crop of the Island. There was no report of slug caterpillar in Chukmachi, Minyuk, Hinam, Aloorang of Teressa Island when scouted with Shri Ahab, Agriculture Deptt., Teressa, a press release from CIPMC said.

Environment (LiFE) as a cross-cutting theme, thus mainstreaming climate change, and addressing the impacts in an ambitious, decisive and action-oriented manner.

Shri Yadav said, India has been part of providing solutions, while it historically has not been part of any of the problems. He said, India has rather taken strong domestic actions, set challenging ambitious targets for itself and is also steering international actions through various initiatives. Shri Yadav said, India's approach has been focused on the convergence of the issues related to Climate Change, Biodiversity loss and pollution. This has reflected in taking up initiatives based on specific interventions through International Solar Alliance (ISA), Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure (CDRI), Lead IT.

The Union Minister said, India has also focused on action by all, including individual and community actions through Mission LiFE. Changing individual and community behaviour alone can make a significant dent in the environmental and climate crises. Shri Yadav stated that the recently launched International Big Cat alliance, on the occasion of 50 years of Project Tiger, is rooted in the fact that conserving big cats and their habitats can secure some of the most important natural ecosystems on Earth leading to natural climate change adaptation, water, and food security for millions of people, and provide livelihood and sustenance to forest communities.
