In view of the rise in the number of COVID-19 cases noted across India recently, Dr. P.K. Mishra, Principal Secretary to Prime Minister chaired a high-level meeting to assess the COVID-19 situation in the country with focus on status of preparedness of health infrastructure and logistics, drugs, vaccination campaign in the country and the key necessary steps as a response to recent surge in Covid-19 cases.

Somanathan, Finance Secretary; Shri Rajesh Bhushan, Secretary, Health and Family Welfare, Smt. S. ## Providing Child Health Screening & Early Intervention Services through Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram

### 23,817 children screened in Anganwadi Centres & Govt. Schools across A&N Islands

Port Blair, April 19

The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, under the National Health Mission launched the Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK), an innovative and ambitious initiative, which envisages Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services, a systemic approach of early identification and link to care, support and treatment. Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is an important initiative aiming at early identification and early intervention for children from birth and developmental related defects in the age group of 0-18 years.

Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services basically refer to early detection



and management of a set of 32 health conditions prevalent in children less than 18 years of age. These conditions are broadly Defects at birth, Diseases in children, Deficiency conditions and Developmental

delays including Disabilities - 4D's.

Children in the age group from birth to eighteen years including the newborn and those attending Anganwadi Centers and Government Schools have been

benefitted through this programme. Any effective health intervention will reduce both direct costs and out-of-pocket expenditure. Child Health Screening and Early Intervention Services also aims at reducing the extent of disability, at improving the quality of life and enabling all persons to achieve their full potential.

The Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) is implemented in these Islands by the Directorate of Health Services. Regular screening of the children is being carried out by the staff of Health Department as per the age group. For new born (0 - 6 weeks), facility based new born screening is done at public health facilities especially at the designated delivery points by

ANMs, Medical Officers/ Gynecologists. Community based new born screening is done at home through ASHAs during home visits for new born care screening of the babies born at home and the institutions till 6 weeks of age. For children 6 weeks to 6 years, Anganwadi Centre based screening is done by the dedicated Mobile Health Teams (MHT) while for children 6 years to 18 years: Government and Government aided school-based screening is done by dedicated MHT.  
As per the data available with the DHS, altogether, 7120 children in the age group of 0 to 6 years have been screened in Anganwadi Centres and 16697 children of age group 6-18 yrs at Govt. Schools across the Islands. 694 children in the age group of 0-6 years and 3760 children of age group 6- 18 years were referred to the respective PHC, CHC, District Hospital, G B Pant Hospital for further treatment.

Karnataka, and Rajasthan). Further, the sudden increase in the positivity was also highlighted along with status of tests being conducted in the country. A detailed analysis of active cases within these 8 States were presented and it was highlighted that approximately 92% of the cases are under home isolation. The presentation also provided an overview of the Genome Sequencing of different variants since January 2023 and noted the proportion of circulating variants in India. The status of vaccination was discussed, followed by drug availability and infrastructure preparedness across the country. As per directions of Hon'ble Prime Minister, a nationwide mock drill for assessment of functional infrastructure was conducted and the status of mock drill was presented to participants. Further, the expenditure of COVID-19 vaccination programme and budget provisions for drugs and vaccine raw materials were also reviewed. Health Secretary also informed that States have already been advised that they may take steps for procurement of requisite Covid vaccine doses directly from the manufacturers at their end without any prior approvals from Union Ministry of Health. Private Hospitals situated in the States may also directly procure such Vaccines from the manufacturer. These vaccines once procured may be administered as per the existing Covid vaccination guidelines.  
After the detailed presentation, Dr. P.K. Mishra highlighted that for managing localized surges it is essential that sufficient health infrastructure should be available at sub-district level and the same may be ensured in consultation with States. He further exhorted that the advisories for guiding States should be assessed based on evolving scenario and updated accordingly. Further, the attendees deliberated that it is critical to focus on identification of emerging hotspots and States should monitor trends of IL/SARI cases, send sufficient samples for testing of Covid-19, and ramp up of Whole Genome Sequencing.
