Vice-President inaugurates 16th Civil Services Day celebration

Civil Servants play a pivotal role in facilitating the Cooperative Federalism through uniformity in administration across the Union and the States: Vice-President

Lauds increasing representation of all sections of society in the Civil Services

New Delhi, April 20 (PIB)

The Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar called upon the Civil Servants to facilitate uniformity in administration across the Union and the States 'so that Federalism blossoms into Cooperative Federalism.' Referring to Civil Services as the backbone of the governance, he acknowledged the role of Civil Servants as the 'most visible and effective agents of change' in ensuring the inclusive development of the nation. The Vice President was addressing the large gathering of Civil Servants after inaugurating the 16th Civil Services Day at Vigyan Bhawan here in New Delhi today.

The Vice-President, Shri Dhankhar underlined that this year's theme of Civil Services Day 'Viksit Bharat: Empowering Citizens and Reaching the Last Mile' is a true reflection of the Preamble of the Indian Constitution that seeks to secure Justice, Liberty, Equality and Fraternity for all its citizens. Highlighting the key



Government Schemes like Aspirational Districts, Smart Cities, Jal Jeevan Mission, Digitisation of payments and PM Jan Aarogya Yojana, among others, he noted that these initiatives represent our march towards 'a Viksit Bharat that is on the rise with primacy of citizen empowerment.'

The Vice-President, Shri Dhankhar



applauded the Mission Karmayogi- a National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building, launched in September 2020, which is turning-out to be a game changer shaping the future-ready Civil Service with the right attitude, skills and knowledge, aligned to the vision of New India. He said that Civil Servants in Amrit Kaal are the Warriors of 2047 laying the

foundations that will shape India that is Bharat, when it celebrates its Centenary of Independence.

The Vice-President expressed his appreciation for the increasing representation of all sections of society, especially young talent from remote villages, belonging to humble family backgrounds as well as from marginalized communities who are joining the Civil Services in large numbers. The rising number of women in public administration, he noted in particular, will pave the way for a more sensitive and well-rounded bureaucracy.

e-District services will enhance efficiency of various Departments at district level to enable seamless service delivery to citizens

96 services have so far been rolled out in Isles

Port Blair, April 20

The Secretary (IT), A & N Administration, Shri Pankaj Kumar, IAS in a simple function has soft launched the additional 21 G2C (Government to Citizen) services (https://edistrict.andaman.gov.in) for end-to-end online solution of Revenue Department today in the presence of Special Secretary (IT), Executive Officer (SOVTECH), Tehsildar (Port Blair) and representatives of DIT and System Integrator. With these 21 services, a total of 96 services have so far been rolled out.

The portal will provide a platform to all the citizens to avail various services viz. Issue of notices, publishing of daily cause list, case management, case status tracking, case of final



order, tracking of status related to execution of order, application for providing information under RTI, providing information about Government schemes, grievance redressal, application for visiting tribal area for foreigners / Indians

under research purpose, Income Certificate for relief fund, security deposit for VAT registration, monthly payment of VAT, application of VAT registration, renewal of royalty of earth cutting, development of earth cutting, renewal of development of earth cutting,

commercial permission of insecticides, Dependent Certificate for claiming Parent's Government Pension, OBC, NCL Certificate and Renewal of Tribal Pass.

With the roll out of these e-District services, it will enhance the efficiency of various Departments under A & N Administration at the district level to enable seamless service delivery to the citizens.

The applications have been developed by Department of IT with the assistance of SOVTECH through System Integrator. Henceforth, the concerned Departments have also been requested not to entertain manual mode of submitting applications, a press release from Executive Officer, SOVTECH said.

awareness on road safety. As part of this vision and in order to extend the road safety awareness to the rural and sub-urban areas, the Transport Department conducted a day long road safety

awareness camp today chief guest.

the camp. It was also graced by the Officials of Traffic Police.

Speaking on the occasion, the Secretary (Transport) expressed his concern on the increasing road accidents and related fatalities in the UT. He said that analysis of the road accident data for the last few years reveals that 90% victims are two wheeler riders and pedestrians which is a matter of serious concern. Major causes of these accidents were over speeding and drunken driving which gives scope that human error can be rectified. In most of the cases, the motorcycle riders did not wear head gears (helmets) and the sustained head injuries led to their death. The Secretary further said that the State Road Safety Council under the able leadership of Chief Secretary is closely monitoring the road safety scenario in the Pan UT level and the District Road Safety Committees in the three districts under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioners are also committed to reduce road accident fatalities. The Committees have been formed to identify more parking spaces and ways to suggest better regulation of parking spaces to optimize the use of carriage ways. Moreover, with the help of CRRI, 16 junctions in the city have been identified and the Administration is exploring all the means to rectify the junctions for better safety. Black spots have been identified and rectification measures are being undertaken by the concerned agencies, he said. The chief guest further added that the Transport Department and Traffic Police are working tirelessly to enforce the traffic laws on the road for the safety of road users. He emphasized the necessity to spread the road safety awareness by all stakeholder Departments and public representatives collaboratively to achieve the target of GoI to reduce the road accidents and fatalities by 50% by 2024. He further stressed the need for sensitizing the young students through the Education Department so that the road safety awareness can be inculcated at a very young age and they can become responsible drivers. The Secretary also appealed to one and all to join in the road safety campaign to reduce the road accidents and save the precious lives of road users.

Shri Ajay Kumar Rai, Dy. SP (Traffic) sensitized the gathering about common traffic violations whereas the other traffic official informed about the penal provisions of various traffic violations. Immediate post-accident cares to be taken within the first hour of accident was briefed by the MO I/c PHC Chouldari. The Pradhans of Chouldari and Mithakhadi Panchayat also addressed the gathering and applauded the initiatives of Transport Department for organizing such a useful camp in the outskirt of the city for the benefit of the villagers.

During the day long camp, all the services related to Registration, fitness, driving license, permits etc. were provided. Around 500 people visited the camp and 155 learner's license was issued on the spot. Apart from this, vehicle owners availed the service related to fitness, permit, etc., a press release from Transport Deptt. said.

Interruption in power supply on April 19 & 20 was
due to damage of main Tie Lines 33 KV underground
cables connecting two major Power Houses

Port Blair, April 20

There was interruption in power supply on April 19 and in the day hours of April 20, 2023 in some area of the city. The power interruption occurred due to damage of main Tie Lines 33 KV underground cables connecting two major Power Houses viz. Chatham Power House and Phoenix Bay Power House. On inspection, it was found that the cable had got damaged due to drilling works carried out by the firm M/s. Ratna Fibers

Limited for laying of CCTV Camera under Smart City Project. In order to repair the underground power cables, the excavation work was undertaken in the morning hours of April 20, 2023. It was found that two underground power cables had got damaged i.e. one 11 kV Tie Line and another 33 kV Tie Line connecting Phoenix Bay Power House and Chatham Power House. While carrying out excavation work which involved manual digging also, as

a safety precaution all the cables which were running in proximity were also isolated. Due to this, there was disconnection between two major power stations and hence, to manage the gap between demand and supply, some of the feeders were isolated on requirement basis. The inconvenience caused to the consumer due to the interruption of the power supply is deeply regretted, a press release from Electricity Department said.

erstwhile colonial rulers and by all the well recognised indications, it will become the Third Largest Global Economy at the turn of the decade.

Safety tips on Hot Weather Condition

From the last few weeks, temperature has risen drastically due to prolonged summer season which can be dangerous, especially for vulnerable populations such as the elderly, young children, and people with certain health condition. In this regard, Dr. Nitin Shakya, Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration has requested the residents of ANI to follow the Do's and Don'ts on Hot Weather Condition

Do's:

- **Drink plenty of water:** Stay hydrated by drinking plenty of water and other non-alcoholic beverages throughout the day.
- **Stay in a cool place:** Stay in an air conditioned environment, or if that's not possible, find a cool, shaded area, such as a tree-covered park or a building with air conditioning.
- **Wear appropriate clothing:** Wear lightweight, loose-



fitting, and light-colored clothing to help your body stay cool.

- **Use sunscreen:** Protect your skin from the sun's harmful rays by applying sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher.
- **Check on others:** Keep an eye on friends, family, and neighbours who may be more vulnerable to heat-related illnesses.
- Don'ts:**
- **Never leave children or pets in hot cars:** Never leave children or pets in a parked car, even for a few minutes.
- **Never Exercise outdoors during peak heat hours:** Avoid outdoor exercise during the hottest parts of the day, typically from 10 am to 4 pm.

- **Avoid Drinking alcohol:** Avoid drinking alcoholic beverages as they can dehydrate your body and make it harder to regulate your body temperature.
- **Never overexert yourself:** Avoid overexertion, especially during the hottest parts of the day. Take frequent breaks and rest as needed.
- **Never ignore warning signs:** Pay attention to your body and take action if you experience symptoms of heat exhaustion or heatstroke, such as dizziness, nausea, headache, or confusion. Seek medical attention immediately if necessary. (Source: Directorate of Disaster Management)

A & N Administration had released a Press Release in the Daily Telegram dated 09.04.2023 regarding the Skills Test (Tier-II & III) Computer Based Typewriting Speed Test and Shorthand test to fill up the 465 vacancies of LGC/LDC and 41 vacancies of Stenographer (OG) based on the scores/merit shared by Staff Selection Commission, New Delhi, wherein the candidates were advised to download their Admit Cards from the website www.karmic.andaman.gov.in on or after 18.04.2023 onwards.
In this regard, the following guidelines for Visually Handicapped (VH)/Cerebral Palsy & Persons with Benchmark Disability (PWD) shortlisted candidates for Computer based Typing speed Test (Tier-II) and Shorthand Test (Tier-III) of Stenographer (OG) the following guidelines are given:
1. Typing test will be conducted on computer.
2. Persons with benchmark disability in the category of Visually Impaired(VH),Orthopedically handicapped (afflicted by Cerebral Palsy), Orthopedically Handicapped (both arm affected), Orthopedically Handicapped candidates who has a locomotor disability wherein, the dominant writing extremity is affected to the extent of **slowing down** the performance of the candidate (such deficiency to be indicated in the certificate, issued by competent authority, submitted by the candidate) **will be allowed compensatory time of additional 05 minutes.** (In the demo video uploaded in the website of A & N, additional time was inadvertently mentioned as 30 minutes.)
3. Visually Impaired (VH) Cerebral Palsy / Candidates are eligible for scribe/passage dictator to be arranged by themselves.
4. **The VH/CP & PwD candidates who wish to avail the facility of scribe shall apply for allowing the Scribe addressed to the Deputy Secretary (R&E) latest by 25th April 2023 upto 05.00 PM or by email deputyresetaryre@gmail.com.**
5. The Scribe/Passage dictator will read out the passage to Visually Impaired (VH) candidates only within the allotted time.
6. Passage will not be provided in Brail for the Visually Impaired (VH) candidates.
7. The candidate shall be responsible for any misconduct on the part of the scribe/Passage dictator brought by him during typing test.
8. **For Exemption from Typing Test:** Persons with Disabilities candidates who claim to be permanently unfit to take the Typing test because of a physical disability may, with the prior approval of the Competent Authority, **be exempted** from the requirement of appearing and qualifying at such test, provided such a candidate submits in the attached format (**Appendix-I**) to the Deputy Secretary (R&E), Secretariat, A & N Administration from the competent Medical Authority, i.e. Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical superintendent of a Government health care institution, declaring him/her to be permanently unfit for the typing test because of a physical disability **on or before 27.04.2023 (Thursday) upto 5.00 PM without fail or by email deputyresetaryre@gmail.com.**
9. Candidate as well as the scribe/Passage dictator will have to give a suitable undertaking, in the prescribed format 'Letter of Undertaking for Using Own Scribe/Passage dictator' as **Appendix-II**.
10. **In case, it later transpires that he/she did not fulfil any laid down eligibility criteria or suppressed material facts, the candidature of such applicant will stand cancelled, irrespective of the result of the online examination.**
11. The decision of A & N Administration in this case shall be final and binding.

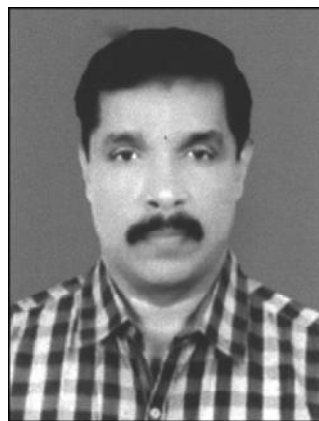

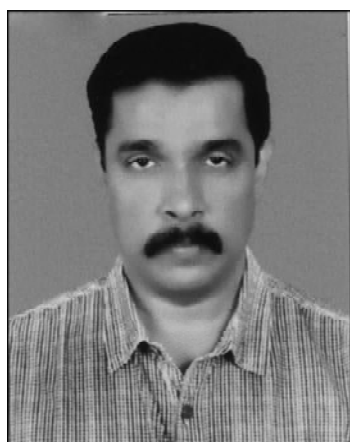

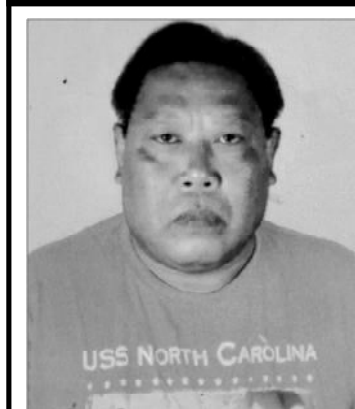
