Strong sense of caution is required to protect hard-earned money from Ponzi Apps: FM

Govt. working with RBI and concerned Ministry to clamp down on Ponzi Apps

New Delhi, April 23

Union Finance Minister, Smti Nirmala Sitharaman has said that Government is working with RBI and concerned Ministry to clamp down on ponzi apps. Speaking at an event "Interaction with Intellectual" organized by Thinkers Forum, she said strong sense of caution is required among people to make sure to protect hard-earned money. Speaking on corona hit economic recovery, Union Finance Minister said, the methods adopted by western countries during COVID-19 times caused stress economy. Their formula to deal with the COVID-19



situation - like printing more currency and distribute among people - has now proven hurtful of their economy, she added. Finance Minister also said that COVID which was followed by Ukraine war further hit everything.

Smti Sitharaman said, due to the right approach condition of Indian economy is better than any other country. Talking on regulation of digital or cryptocurrency,

the Minister said, no one country individually can effectively control it because technology does not have any borders, it can just pass through. She said, all countries are required to be on board to control it or else efforts will not be effective.

On economic reforms in India, she said, lot of measures are being taken to widen the tax base. Smti. Sitharaman said, the Government has brought in a simplified income tax regime with lower tax rates and less exemptions. Changes have been brought to encourage people to pay taxes, she added. Mudra Yojana, a loan scheme initiated by the Government of India to offer loan amount up to Rs. 10 lakh for individuals and MSMEs to start their new business or for existing businesses, without submitting any collateral or security was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi in 2015 for providing loans up to 10 lakh to the non-corporate, non-farm small/micro enterprises. These loans are classified as MUDRA loans under PMMY.

In A&N Islands, under the Shishu loan scheme, 624 beneficiaries were disbursed loan

amounting to Rs. 1.71 crores. Similarly, under the Kishore loan scheme, 1927 beneficiaries were disbursed loan amounting to Rs. 48.61 crores while under Tarun loan scheme, 871 beneficiaries were disbursed loan amounting to Rs. 72.98 crores. An amount of Rs. 123.30 crores have been disbursed by

3,422 beneficiaries in A&N Islands' to start their income generating business as on March 31, 2023, Lead Bank sources informed. Precautionary measures for Tsunami issued by Directorate of Disaster Management



Port Blair, April 23

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and is located in one of the most seismically active part of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. Dr. Nitin Shaky, Director (Disaster Management), A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to do's & don'ts of Tsunami.

DO's:

- > Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be

aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.

- > Move to higher ground: If a tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.
- > Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
- > Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
- > Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.
- > DON'Ts: > Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami

warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.

- > Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.
- > Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.
- > Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.
- > Don't return to the area until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so. (Source: Directorate of Disaster Management)

Jal Shakti Ministry conducts first-ever census of water bodies across nation

New Delhi, April 23

Ministry of Jal Shakti has conducted the first-ever census of water bodies across the nation. The census provides a comprehensive inventory of India's water resources, including natural and man-made water bodies like ponds and lakes. In the census, over 24.24 lakh water bodies have been enumerated in the country, out of which more than 23 lakh water bodies are in rural areas and nearly 69,000 are in urban

areas. The top five States in terms of number of water bodies are West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha and Assam which constitute around 63 per cent of the total water bodies in the country. The Census also highlighted disparities between rural and urban areas and varying levels of encroachment and revealed crucial insights into the country's water resources. (Source: india.gov.in)

10,112 new cases of COVID-19 reported in the country


