Commerce and Industry Minister underlines need to make e-commerce as engine of India's growth without damaging small retailers

New Delhi, April 25
Union Commerce and Industry Minister, Shri Piyush Goyal has underlined the need to make e-commerce as the engine of India's growth without damaging small retailers. The Minister was addressing the inauguration session of the Open Network for Digital Commerce's (ONDC) Enabling Bharat 2.0 in New Delhi today. Shri Goyal said there is a problem arising out of the predominance of big tech companies in the e-commerce space and also a serious challenge to small retailers across the country. He said, although e-commerce affects only three to four percent of India's retail trade but the policymakers will have to think about it and find a solution. Shri Goyal emphasised that India now believes digital public infrastructure is the need of the hour. He said, the world is living in an era of connectivity and convenience and all of it has to be citizen-centric. Shri Goyal said, UPI is providing opportunities for hundreds of fintech companies and sectoral services. The Minister added that the cost of payment in India is one of the lowest because it is not concentrated in one or two companies. Highlighting the use of technology, he said, India was able to roll-out the vaccines seamlessly across the country. (Source: india.gov.in)

Electricity Deptt. appeals to electricity consumers of Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman to judiciously use power

Port Blair, April 25
The Electricity Department in an appeal has informed the consumers of electricity that due to increase in ambient temperature, there has been a substantial increase in power demand which has created a shortage of power during evening peak hours from 5.30 pm to 11.30 pm in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman. All the consumers of Electricity Department have therefore been advised to use the available energy judiciously in view of shortage of power particularly during the evening peak hours. Further, it is also requested that usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Geysers, garden lighting may kindly be avoided during evening peak hours from 5.30 pm to 11.30 pm. This would help the Department to maintain power supply in Port Blair and adjoining areas of South Andaman without curtailment. The Electricity Department is closely monitoring for the compliance of above by conducting surprise checks to ensure effective Demand Side Management by all consumers, the appeal issued by Electricity Deptt. added.

PBMC supplies drinking water to municipal areas. Due to poor monsoon and excessive heat, there is acute shortage of water supply from PWD to PBMC. Rains are not expected any time soon. Water is a precious natural resource and cannot be wasted. The public have been advised to use water carefully and avoid any type of wastage of water. Overflow of storage tanks should be avoided at all costs. Consumers have been asked to fix leaking pipes and install float valves in water tanks to avoid overflow. Govt. offices, public institutions, commercial establishments and other major consumers of water have been asked to take precautionary measures to preserve water. PBMC is closely monitoring all tap connections and storage facilities and in case of wastage of water, strict action will be taken such as disconnection of

Stringent action against bootleggers by South Andaman District Police

Port Blair, April 25

In continuation to the intensive drive, the Police teams of South Andaman District Police are continuously making all possible efforts to curb down the menace of illegal sale of illicit liquor in their jurisdictions. All the history sheeters are being continuously monitored and raids are being conducted.

From 1st January, 2023 to 23rd April, 2023, a total of 195 Excise cases were registered in different Police Stations of South Andaman District. A total of 2516 IMFL bottles, 358 Kgs of Handia, 41.5 Ltrs of illicit liquor were seized and 195 persons were arrested for illegal sale of liquor. Regular jungle searches are also being conducted and 3435 liters of lehan were recovered and destroyed.

Further, on 23rd & 24th of April, 2023, staff of South Andaman District had shown tremendous efforts and registered a total of 11 Excise cases and arrested 11 persons with a recovery of 127 IMFL bottles containing 34.04 liters of IMFL and 25 Kgs of Handia.

The South Andaman District Police is taking all possible steps to make this district free from bootlegging, drug peddling and other anti-social activities and keeping strict vigil over bootleggers and drug peddlers. General public have been requested to pass on credible information on narcotics substance, illegal sale of liquor, gambling or any other illegal activity on the telephone numbers: 100,112 and 03192-233077. 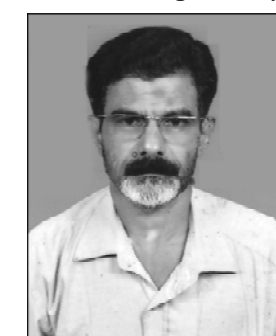
