## National Education Policy, 2020 provides for setting up a Gender Inclusion Fund: Minister

New Delhi, July 31 (PIB)

The National Education Policy (NEP), 2020 focuses on 'Equitable and Inclusive Education' which reverberates the idea that no child should be left behind in terms of educational opportunity because of their background and socio-cultural identities. It has taken into account the concerns of the Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs) which includes female and transgender individuals. In

addition, NEP prescribes to approach gender as a cross-cutting priority to achieve gender equality in education with the partnership of states and local community organizations.

National Education Policy, 2020 provides for setting up a Gender Inclusion Fund (GIF) especially for girls and transgender students to build the nation's capacity to provide equitable quality education for all girls as well as transgender students. The objectives of NEP for equitable and quality

education for girl children are being met through specific provisions under Samagra Shiksha 2.0 by allocating dedicated resources for Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs). Under Samagra Shiksha, various interventions have been targeted for providing quality education to girls, which include opening of schools in the neighbourhood to make access easier for girls, free uniform and text-books to girls up to class VIII, additional teachers

and residential quarters for teachers in remote/hilly areas, appointment of additional teachers including women teachers, stipend to CWSN girls from class I to class XII, separate toilets for girls, teachers' sensitization programmes to

The Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D.K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) has condoled the death of Shri Vakkom Purushothaman (95), former Lt. Governor of A&N Islands, who died at Kumarapuram, Thiruvananthapuram- 11 on 31.07.2023.

Shri Vakkom Purushothaman was an Indian Politician who served as the Lt. Governor of A&N Islands from 1993 to 1996, the Governor of Mizoram from 2011 to 2014, Former Speaker of Kerala and State Minister.

In his condolence message, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor has conveyed his deepest sympathy, sorrow and heartfelt condolence to the members of the bereaved family. The Hon'ble Lt. ## Member of Parliament raises issue of Chatham-Bambooflat Bridge in Parliament

Port Blair, July 31 The Member of Parliament, A&N Islands, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma has requested the Government to intervene and pass necessary orders to speed up the construction of Chatham-Bambooflat Bridge which will bring a sea change for enabling convenient vehicular traffic movement from a major part of the South Andaman

region to Port Blair City and reduce the travel time for the commuters from the several villages. Raising the issue in Parliament under rule 377 on 28.07.2023, the Member of Parliament added that the Chatham-Bambooflat Bridge involves the construction of a 1.6 km bridge worth Rs. 2,000 Crore to connect Chatham and Bambooflat Islands. He mentioned that at present, people

need to travel about 48 kms to reach from one point to another through land. The construction of a bridge will bring the two regions closer. The task for implementing it has been given to National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. The MP added that the ground works for the proposed Chatham-Bambooflat

promote girls participation, gender-sensitive teaching-learning materials including text books etc. In addition, to reduce gender gaps at all levels of school education, Kasturba Gandhi Balika Vidyalayas (KGBVs), which are residential schools from class VI to XII for girls belonging to disadvantaged groups such as SC, ST, OBC, Minority and Below Poverty Line (BPL), are sanctioned in Educationally Backward Blocks. As on 30.06.2023, a total of 5639 KGBVs have been sanctioned in the country with the enrolment of 6.88 lakh girls. The task of up-gradation of the KGBVs was started in the year 2018-19 and till the year 2022-23, a total of 357 KGBVs have been approved for up-gradation to Type-II (class 6-10) and 2010 KGBVs have been approved for up-gradation to Type-III (class 6-12). The information was given by the Minister of State for Education, Smt. Annpurna Devi in a written reply in the Lok Sabha today.

includes completion of some major projects like development of Marina Park, development of Gandhi Park, opening of Tourist Guest Houses in several remote islands for the first time, widening of roads in Port Blair city etc. During his tenure tourism started booming and being a good Administrator he took several steps to promote Tourism in Andaman. He had been a five-time legislator and twice elected to the Lok Sabha. He was a state cabinet minister on three different occasions and Speaker of the Kerala Legislative Assembly on two occasions. Shri. Purushothaman also served as Governor of Mizoram and Tripura. After 2014, when he quit as Governor of Tripura, he retired from active politics and was mostly confined to his home, in Thiruvananthapuram, a press release from MP Office said.

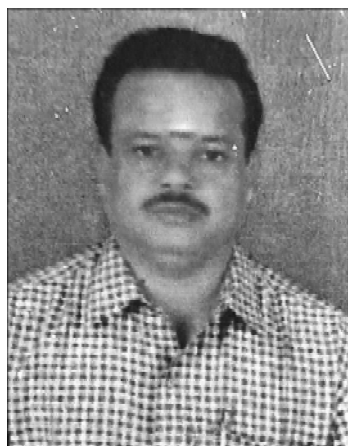

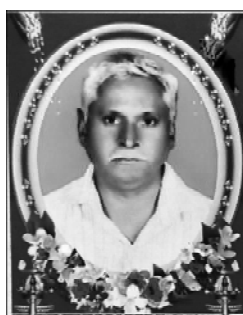
