PM addresses G20 Ministerial Conference on Women Empowerment ...

world's largest democracy and serves as the Commander-in-Chief of the world's second-largest defence force even though she comes from a humble tribal background. In this Mother of Democracy, the Prime Minister said, the 'Right to Vote' was granted equally to all citizens including women by the Indian Constitution right from the beginning and the right to contest elections was also granted based on equality. The Prime Minister noted that elected women representatives have been key agents of economic, environmental and social change and informed that 46% of elected representatives in rural local bodies in India are women numbering 1.4 million. Underlining that the mobilization of women into self-help groups has also been a powerful force for change, the Prime Minister highlighted the self-help groups and elected women representatives emerging as pillars of support for our communities during the pandemic. The Prime Minister gave examples of their achievements and mentioned the manufacturing of masks and sanitisers, and creating awareness about prevention of infection. "More than 80% of nurses and midwives in India are women. They were our first line of defence during the pandemic. And, we are proud of their achievements", he added.

Underlining that women-led development has been a key priority for the government, the Prime Minister mentioned that around 70% of the loans up to one million rupees to support micro-level units under the Pradhan Mantri Mudra Yojana have been sanctioned to women. Similarly, 80% of beneficiaries under Stand-Up India are women, availing bank loans for green field projects. Noting that clean cooking fuel directly impacts the environment and improves the health of women, the Prime Minister highlighted the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana and informed that nearly 100 million cooking gas connections have been provided to rural women. He also informed that the number of women in technical education in Industrial Training Institutes has doubled since 2014, nearly 43 percent of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) graduates in India are women, and about onefourth of space scientists in India are women. "Behind the success of our flagship programmes like Chandrayaan, Gaganyaan and Mission Mars lies the talent and hard work of these women scientists", he said. Today, the Prime Minister said, more women are enrolling in higher education than men in India. He also pointed out that India has one of the highest percentages of female pilots in civil aviation while female pilots in the Indian Air Force are also flying fighter aircrafts. Shri Modi noted that women officers are being deployed in operational roles and fighting platforms in all our armed forces. The Prime Minister highlighted the pivotal roles played by women as the backbone of rural agricultural families and as small traders and shopkeepers.

Underlining their close association with nature, the Prime Minister said that women hold the key to innovative solutions to climate change. He recalled how women led the first prominent climate action in India in the 18th century when the Bishnoi community of Rajasthan led by Amrita Devi started the 'Chipko Movement' to prevent unregulated logging. The Prime Minister informed that she along with several other villagers laid down her life for the cause of nature. "Women in India have also been brand Ambassadors for 'Mission LiFE - Lifestyle for Environment'", the Prime Minister said as he highlighted their traditional wisdom to reduce, reuse, recycle, and re-purpose. Under various initiatives, the Prime Minister added, women are actively getting trained in making solar panels and lights. He mentioned the 'Solar Mamas' initiative that has been successful in collaborating with partner countries in the Global South.

"Women entrepreneurs are significant contributors to the global economy", the Prime Minister said as he emphasized the role of women entrepreneurs in India. Decades ago, he said, in 1959 seven Gujarati women in Mumbai came together to create a historic cooperative movement - Shri Mahila Grih Udyog which has transformed the lives of millions of women and their families. Shri Modi highlighted their most famous product, Lijjat Papad, and said that it will probably be on the food menus in Gujarat! He also gave the example of the dairy sector and informed that there are 3.6 million women involved in this sector in Gujarat alone. Shri Modi pointed out that in India, about 15% of unicorn startups have at least one woman founder and the combined value of these women-led unicorns is over 40 billion dollars. The Prime Minister stresses the need to create a level platform where women achievers become the norm. He emphasized working towards removing the barriers that restrict their access to markets, global value chains, and affordable finance while ensuring that the burden of care and domestic work is appropriately addressed at the same time.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister lauded the focus of the Ministerial Conference on women's entrepreneurship, leadership and education and expressed delight at the launch of the 'Tech-Equity Platform' to enhance digital and financial literacy for women. He also mentioned that under India's G20 Presidency, a new Working Group on 'Women Empowerment' is being established. He expressed confidence that untiring efforts in Gandhinagar will give immense hope and confidence to women around the world.

As per the guidelines for Ground Water abstraction, for bulk water supply, all those users abstracting ground water and using it for supply as bulk water supplies through private tankers will now mandatorily seek No Objection Certificate for ground water abstraction.

Documents to be submitted with the application

(i) Proof of ownership of land of size 200 sqm or more on which abstraction structure is installed.

(ii) Proof of ownership/Lease of tanker (iii) Groundwater quality report.

(iv) General Conditions to be followed by the bulk water suppliers

(a) All tankers shall be labelled "Potable Water".

(b) Abstraction structures shall be fitted with tamper proof digital water flow meter with telemetry.

(c) Flow meters shall be calibrated once in a year from an authorized agency.

(d) Water shall be used for drinking/domestic purpose only. (e) Water quality being supplied by the bulk water supplier shall be adhered to

BIS norms for drinking and domestic purpose.

(f) Filling of tanker shall be done only within the premises.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman emphasized all the bulk water suppliers that they should mandatorily register themselves with the CGWA. The link for registration with Central Ground Water Authority for obtaining No-Objection Certificate for ground water extraction is http://cgwa-noc.gov.in. As on date as per the list provided by CWGA, only 17 operators have obtained the No-Objection Certificates, list of which is available in the website http://cgwa.gov.in. Further, it was also directed that Bore well machine operators shall submit report to the office of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate regarding the setting up and operation of portable drilling rig to drill wells anywhere in the District.

It was also informed that 1 month time period is being given to the bulk water suppliers for registering and obtaining No-objection certificate from the CGWA failing which punitive action will be initiated against the defaulters.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman further reiterated that general public and all ground water users may also be made aware that the purchase of water Disaster from registered bulk water suppliers should be strictly ensured, a press release from the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, South Andaman District said.

F.No.01/ACS/Quarry/SA/TS-II/2023-24/1078 - WHEREAS, in pursuance of Rule 15(1) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012, A Committee was constituted vide Notification No.132/2015/F.No.34-738/2012-Rev(PF) dated 03rd August, 2015 for preparing Quarry Plan for the area(s) identified for quarrying under the provisions of the Rules.

AND, WHEREAS, the Committee after due examination, finalized a guarry plan at Brookshabad, Port Blair.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the power conferred under Rule 5 read with Rule 16 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Minerals Rules, 2012, the Officer authorized by Lt. Governor to be competent to approve guarry plan i.e., the Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman), hereby approves the guarry plan containing the location, site plan, progressive and final closure plan, reclamation and restoration plan including specific guidelines for source-wise pollution control measures to be followed for quarry operations in South Andaman District as under:

#### **QUARRY PLAN**

A.BACKGROUND The Andaman & Nicobar Islands Minor Mineral Rules, 2012 was notified on 20th September, 2012. In pursuance of Rule 6, contiguous areas for quarrying, having due regard to the restrictions mentioned in Rule 4, general topography and environmental aspects, was identified at Brookshabad village in Port Blair Tehsil. It got approval of Hon'ble Lt. Governor A&N Islands which was conveyed to Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman vide letter no. 34-738/2012-Rev dt:11.10.2012.

An area of 3.00 hectares was identified at Brookshabad village for conduct of quarrying by use of explosives and another area of 1.64 hectares was also identified at Brookshabad village for conduct of guarrying without use of explosives.

The Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A & N Islands, in pursuance of Rule 15 and Section 5(b) of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Minor Minerals Rule, 2012 read with Administration's Order No.312 dated 30/01/2015 and in supersession of Administration's Notification No.4-2/19-R/Quarry/PF-I dated 09/10/2012 notified the following committee vide notification dated 03/08/2015 for South Andaman District for preparing quarry plan for the area(s) identified for guarrying under Rule 6 of the said rules:-

The above Committee has been assigned the task of preparing quarry plan(s) for South Andaman District, which shall include for each identified area outer boundary potential for extraction or crushing, progressive and final closure plan of quarry, plans for reclamation and restoration of land, measures for pollution control, responsibility of the guarry lease holder and any other matter that the committee may decide. The plan shall also include the cost of preparation of such plan or plans to be apportioned amongst the lease holders of quarries established on such area in such a manner as the committee may decide.

The Assistant Conservator of Forest was nominated as member of the Committee by PCCF, Research Office was nominated by Director of Health Services as member of the Committee and Executive Engineer, SAD, APWD was nominated as member of the Committee by Chief Engineer, APWD.

The Committee held its meeting on 14.03.2023 at 04.30PM, the Chairman informed about the urgency in preparing the quarry plan for the areas identified at Brookshabad village for quarrying

The committee again convened its meeting on 17.03.2023 at 04.30 pm and presented a draft quarry site map of the area before the committee for its perusal and decided to re-verify the sites located in terms of general restriction of quarry operation contained in rule-4 of ANIMMR-2012. The committee convened another meeting on 20.03.2023 at 04.30 pm and presented the site map of quarry and a draft quarry plan and after discussion it is decided to obtain report from the concerned revenue field staff as the portion of land proposed for quarry sites located is free from all encumbrance.

The Committee met on 21.03.2023 at 04.30pm and perused the report of the field staff, the quarry site map and after deliberation and making such modifications as deemed fit the quarry plan has been finalized .

# C. SITE PLAN

- i The selected quarrying area at Brookshabad is a more or less compact area. ii The HTL has been super imposed on the site plan with reference to the ICRZ Notification
- iii The selected area has limited spatial extent, recognizable through topographic expressions, small hillocks, mounds, ridges over shorter intervals having narrow depressions etc.
- iv The extraction from this area would be of minor minerals only i.e. earth and stone boulders. Physical inspection has revealed that there are sufficient deposits of these minor minerals at the site.
- v Quarrying in this area is not exactly mining but is more like digging and levelling. This would ultimately result in getting flat land bounded by hillocks having a gradient of 45degree angle. However, the rehabilitation of quarry site will be undertaken as per the prescribed norms.
- vi The Committee after considering all the above points, the occurrence of Minor mineral, geographical condition and likely difficulties to be faced by the Regulatory Authorities in monitoring the environmental impact and implementation of necessary mitigation measures, is of the opinion to adopt cluster approach in the area and lease out mines having a area

- 0.2050 hectares each.
- vii The Administration vide letter No.34-738/2012-Rev (PF) dated 21st January 2013 had recommended deletion of Corpus Fund, The Committee has also recommended its
- viii The selected guarry area was inspected and levels taken at different locations. Based on the levels taken, plots of size 0.25hectares and 0.2050 hectares have been carved. ix 12 plots have been carved out in block B where explosives can be permitted for extraction of quarry material having the size of 0.25 hectares.
- x 08 plots have been carved out in block A where quarrying can be permitted without use of explosives having the size of 0.2050 hectares.
- xi The detail layout plan may be seen at page 10 of the plan.

#### D. POTENTIAL FOR EXTRACTION OF MINOR MINERAL AND YEARLY **EXTRACTION**

- After taking levels and fixing benches within the blocks, the slope to be maintained at each plot has been arrived at in such a manner that at the end of quarrying from the area we have a gradient of 45 degree angle or a flat land which can be used for any other purposes. Details may be seen at page 10 of the plan.
- As stated earlier the committee is satisfied that the quarry sites are having existence of minor mineral. However, committee feels that it is for the prospective bidder to do the estimate prior to bidding and satisfy themselves with regard to quantity of minor minerals.
- In order to stagger the quarry operations over a period of time, the Committee decided to allow extraction of up to 12,000 cbm Minor Minerals from each site per annum.
- The site marked as X(in the map at page 10of the plan), which are depressions or account of quarrying activities in the past, have been selected for dumping of quarry waste and overburden.

#### E. PROGRESSIVE AND FINAL CLOSURE PLAN

- Considering the small size of quarry sites to be leased out, the Committee feels that progressive closure plan would not be feasible however avenue plantation is to be undertaken as an interim measure for protection of the environment.
- The Committee has decided to recommend guidelines for final closure of quarry. The following points are to be considered as a part of final closure of the quarry. (a) Location of the Quarry.
- (b) Topography of the Quarry
- (c) Reason for Closure or Reserves of Minor Minerals available for future in the quarry

(d) The reclamation and rehabilitation of the mined quarries indicating the method of reclamation/ restoration of land and guarries pits.

(e) Water quality and hydrology of the area indicating water bodies, surface run-off vulnerability to erosion, sedimentation/siltation, diversion of water course, contamination quantity and quality change of water in water bodies. The corrective and protective measures are to be considered.

(f) Air quality indicating air quality status & corrective measure to prevent pollution.

(g) Waste Management indicating status, type, quality and quantity of over burden, earth top soil removed and prevention measure & disposal methods of the overburden in case not utilized for stabilization & for filling the pits. The protective measures to be taken for prevention of siltation, erosion and dust generation from these waste materials should also be addressed.

(h) Infrastructure- Emphasis on maintaining the existing roads, etc and creation of toe retaining walls, check dams etc.

- (i) Disposal or removal of Quarrying Machineries & construction like hutment/shed if any (j) The Administration may include any activity as a part of closure of closure plan at any point of time.
- (k) Statutory obligations like payment of wages/ Compensation for retrenchment of manpower/ labours under ID Act, and handling any other kind of repercussions shall be the sole responsibility of quarry lease holder.
- (I) Disaster Management & Risk Assessment-indicating the probable high risks like landslides, seismic activities, inundation of low areas in abandoned quarry and action plan to mitigate these risks.
- (m) Monitoring and Evaluation of the activities of the closure plan.
- The above activities shall be undertaken jointly by the Department of Revenue. Forest, Andaman Public Works Department and the Pollution Control Committee of the

# F. PLANS FOR RECLAMATION AND RESTORATION OF LAND

The following activities for reclamation and restoration of the land have to be jointly undertaken from the corpus created by concerned Departments such as Revenue, Forest, Andaman Public Works Department and the Pollution Control Committee of the UnionTerritory.

(a) Plantation activities to be taken up in strips (along the approach road) & Blocks (in the

abandoned/closed quarries). (b) Coastal/Littoral species of trees/plants will be selected for Strip Plantation along road and Hardy and fast growing tree species will be selected for block plantation.

(c) The Strip Plantation along the road will be taken up in 2-3 rows depending upon the availability of land along the road.

(d) The Strip Plantation on the sea ward side of the road will be raised in staggered/ quincial pattern with spacemen of 3mts x 3mts. (row to row & plant to plant respectively). (e) Casualty/ mortality filling of the plantations will be carried out for minimum of three years starting from year of planting.

(f) Maintenance of the plantation will be done continuously for minimum of five years or more till the establishment of the plantations and activities like mulching, weeding, climber cutting and cleaning including the repair and maintenance of tree guards /fences will be taken up in each year.

(g) Cost estimation for each segment of Strip or Block plantation will be done by Forest department based on the Schedule of rates/ standard norms of the department considering the site conditions/ locality factors specially the soil and biotic factors of

#### G. MEASURES FOR POLLUTION **CONTROL**

- During quarrying operations, the water should be sprayed at least once in a day over the roads at the quarry sites and nearby areas by the lease holders.
- Kachha road, used for transportation of murrum, from the quarry site shall be invariably sprayed by water during these operations. In order to minimize dust pollution, measures such as adoption of hoods at transfer points, vulcanizing of conveyer belt joints, under belt cleaning devices, and installation of dust suppressions and/or dust extraction system for conveyance shall be adopted.
- The kachha road leading to the quarry shall have avenue plantation to arrest the dust pollution.



# **DESERTION NOTICE**

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


