Govt introduces Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita and Bharatiya Sakshya Bills in LS to replace 3 British-era laws

New Delhi, Aug. 11

The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 and the Bharatiya Sakshya Bill 2023 were today introduced in the Lok Sabha. While introducing the Bills, Home Minister Shri Amit Shah said, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 will replace the Indian Penal Code 1860 and Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha, 2023 will replace the Criminal Procedure Act, 1898. He said, Bharatiya Sakshya Bill, 2023 will replace the Indian Evidence Act, 1872. The Minister said these



bills will transform the country's criminal justice system. The legislations are aimed to provide justice to the people

rather than penalizing them. He said these bills have been brought after thorough deliberations. Talking about the

provisions of the Bills, he said, provisions related to sedition will be repealed completely. He said, 313 changes have been made in the laws which are aimed to strengthen the criminal justice system. Shri Shah said special provisions have been made to provide speedy justice to women and children. He added that special focus has been made to digitalize the entire criminal justice system. Later, the Bill was sent to the Parliamentary Standing Committee for further deliberations. (Source: india.gov.in)

can now register their Lost/Stolen mobile phone complaints directly into CCTNS Citizen Service Portalat <http://citizen.andaman.gov.in/Login.aspx>. This

information will further go into the CCTNS Core Application. Missing mobile registration requires some specific mandatory information like mobile number and IMEI details. First time in the history of A&N Islands ANIIMS's Interventional Cardiology Unit performs cases of conduction system pacing & cardiac resynchronization therapy implantation successfully in a single day

Port Blair, Aug. 11

The ANIIMS's Interventional Cardiology Unit performed a case of Conduction system pacing (Lt bundle pacing) and Cardiac resynchronization therapy (CRT-D) implantation successfully in a single day for the first time in the history of A&N Islands on July 17, 2023. Conduction system pacing is a mode of



physiological pacing, carried out for the first time in the world in 2018 in China. Since then, only a small

number of centers in the nation have been capable of performing such sophisticated pacing techniques.

The first patient was a 66-year male who presented with syncope with intermittent complete heart block with left ventricular (LV) dysfunction. He underwent left bundle pacing successfully with complete resolution of symptoms. The second patient was a 51-year female diagnosed with dilated cardiomyopathy

The tournament is arbitrated by the Chief Arbiter, Dinesh H, A&N Islands, (International Arbiter), the Deputy Chief Arbiter, Anil N J, Karnataka (International Arbiter) besides eight other local Senior National Arbiters (SNA) from A&N Islands. The inaugural function concluded with the vote of thanks proposed by the Vice President of ANCA, Shri Tanveer Singh. On the first day of the tournament, P Tata Rao being the top seed maintaining the lead position with 2 full points winning against Daksh with white pieces whereas the tournament's 2nd seeded Women FIDE Master CH Meghana faced a tough competition from Chittiboyna Mageswari from A&N Islands on second board.

the Citizen Portal is as follows:-
1) Citizen will have to login in the State CCTNS Citizen Service portal.
2) He/She will enter his/her lost phone details to be blocked.
3) After submission of the form, a request number will be generated and given to the user for tracking and future reference on an alternate number after due OTP verification.
4) The lost mobile details given by the complainant will be shared with CEIR.
5) CEIR will send daily alert to the PS under which the complaint has been registered if a mobile phone is traced.
6) When the mobile phone is recovered by the police, the complainant will be informed and an alert will be generated to his alternate mobile number.
7) When the user gets his lost/stolen phone back, he may refer his request number and request for unblocking his mobile through Citizen Portal. The Andaman & Nicobar Police is committed towards providing a safe and secure environment to all its citizens. The department is working hard to ensure that quality policing services are provided to the citizens in a citizen friendly manner, a press release from SP (CID) said.

PRESS NOTE

It is notified for the information of the General Public that the following Traffic arrangements have been made for the rehearsals of the Independence Day celebrations on 13th August 2023(Sunday) (Full Dress Rehearsal) and for the main function on 15th August 2023 (Tuesday).

1. The carcade of Hon'ble Lt. Governor and other dignitaries, holders of parking card 'P' (Green) shall be parked inside the Netaji Stadium.

2. The holders of parking card 'P' (Pink) shall be parked near Andaman Club and in the parking area in front of Sports Hostel.

3. The holders of car parking label 'P', (both Green and Pink) may use any route of their choice to approach the place of function, but are requested to reach the place of function latest by 0845 hrs., failing which, their vehicles will be stopped near the Gymkhana Crossing, RK Mission and Fire Brigade (HQ) crossings.

4. After the departure of the Chief Guest from the place of function, the vehicles bearing parking label "P" (both Green & Pink) shall follow the route Scout Hut Junction-VikasBhawan(ANIIDCO Office)-Fire Brigade-APWD Crossing to their destinations.

5. The holders of 'P-1' parking labels will arrive at the Netaji Stadium via Model School-Clock Tower-Gymkhana Crossing to Netaji Stadium. Thereafter, the vehicles shall proceed to the parking on the western side of main gate of Netaji Stadium and near Swimming Pool.

6. After the departure of all vehicles parked inside the stadium and near Andaman Club having "P" parking label the vehicles with "P-1" parking label will be released to come to the main entrance of Netaji Stadium to pick up the guests and shall leave via Scout Hut Junction-Girls School Crossing-RK Mission and RGT Road.

7. All other vehicles without any parking label including two and four wheelers will be parked near Water Sports Complex and Girls School parking.

8. The vehicles intending to proceed to South Point from Aberdeen Bazar shall be diverted towards Model School Crossing – Bengali Club – Goalghar- Secretariat Junction – Police Line and Nayagaon.

9. No heavy vehicles, private and STS buses will be allowed to proceed towards Cellular Jail from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs and shall be diverted to other routes from Bengali Club Junction.

10. The vehicles intending to proceed to Aberdeen Bazar from South Point shall follow the route of South Point-Shadipur-Nayagaon Junction-Police Line-RBV-Secretariat Junction and Goalghar.

11. Heavy vehicles shall be diverted to Goal Ghar and Junglighat from Bengali Club from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.

12. No vehicles shall be allowed to proceed towards the place of function from Y-Narayan Junction, RK Mission, Fire Brigade Junction and Water Sports Junction after 0830 hrs.

13. No vehicle shall be allowed to proceed towards Aberdeen Bazar after the start of the function from any direction till the dispersal of the crowd.

14. The vehicles carrying parade contingents after dropping the contingents in front of Netaji Stadium shall proceed to Water Sports Complex/Girls School Parking and will remain stationed there. After culmination of parade they will come to Netaji Stadium via Y- Narayan Junction and proceed to their respective units with the parade contingents.

15. Further vehicles intending to proceed to GB Pant Hospital shall follow the routesfrom 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs.

(i) Gandhi Statue- Marine Gate – Sisty Nagar – Dignabad Sea Shore Road – Khan Jn. – exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.

(ii) Bengali Club - Clock Tower - Gymkhana Crossing - Round Basthi - Dignabad Sea Shore Road – Khan Jn. – exit gate of Hospital and then GB Pant Hospital.

16. Ambulance and vehicles with medical emergency caes proceeding to GB Pant Hospital shall take the route Y-Narayan Junction-Cellular Jail-GB Pant Hospital and this route shall be closed from 0700 hrs to 1100 hrs for all other vehicles except Ambulance and vehicles with medical emergency.
