The CANI Submarine OFC project, with an investment of Rs 1232 crore, has been a game changer for the strategic network connectivity of the Islands by being implemented two years ahead of schedule. The Lt. Governor further said that projects like 'Azad Hind Fauj Setu' on Humphrey Strait, with an investment of Rs 203 crore and 20 MW Solar Power Projects in the direction of sustainable green energy with an investment of Rs 138 crore have further strengthened the developments in Isles.

Informing about the ongoing IDA projects, the Lt. Governor said that 29 projects of Island Development Agency (IDA), (66 per cent) are rapidly moving towards completion and will give new dimensions to the progress of the A&N Islands. Among these, the work of Floating Solar Panels at Kalpong River at Diglipur with an investment of Rs 27 crores is in progress.

He said that the airport in INS Kohasa of Shibpur is ready for civil operations where 'Passenger Terminal' and basic facilities have been completed with an investment of Rs 206 crores. He further stated that approximately 800 km apart along the North-South Axis of these Islands, there are four airports, each with an average distance of 230 km. With the completion of Runway extensions at GNI and Shibpur airports, these four dual-use strategic airports, equipped with runways of over three kilometers, will be capable of handling operations for large aircraft and will be a game-changer from a geo-political perspective, for the country.

The Lt. Governor disclosed that operators have been selected under the RCS-UDAN scheme to start sea-plane operations soon from Port Blair to Swaraj Dweep, Shaheed Dweep and Long Island sectors with an investment of about Rs 60 crores. In addition, operators have also been selected to start fixedwing aircraft services soon, on Port Blair to Shibpur, Car Nicobar and Campbell Bay routes. "Our proposal for fleet upgradation by new 12-seater, large capacity Sikorsky Helicopters has also received financial approval from SFC", the Lt. Governor said.

The Lt. Governor further informed that in the Tourism, Hospitality & Services sector, works are in progress for the development of Megapode, 4 Islands project and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose National Memorial, with the appointment of Consultants. He further stated that Master Plan is in final stages of package IV Islands/11-sites in North and Middle Andaman and South Andaman. The A&N Administration is making efforts to develop eco-friendly resort in PPP mode at the Radhanagar Beach of Swaraj Dweep besides developing a Chatham, Viper and Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Island Heritage Tourism Circuit. Apart from this, work on Lighthouse Tower on the Invisible Bank Rani Laxmibai Shila is in progress and will be completed by March, 2024.

Mentioning about other projects under IDA, the Lt. Governor said there are many ambitious projects of IDA in which preliminary costing has been done and the process of various clearances, consultancy reports, DPR, EIA etc. are in various stages. He further informed that following the Hon'ble Prime Minister's directives, several visionary projects with investments totaling approximately 78.663 crore

Regarding the projects completed under the IDA, the Lt. Governor said, despite the archipelago's rupees in the GNI Project, such as the International Container Transshipment Terminal, Greenfield hub but also serve as a force multiplier in establishing India's dominance in the Indo-Pacific region.

The Lt. Governor further stated that several projects fall under the category of Policy Decisions whose intangible benefits will have a multiplier effect on the economy, besides setting benchmarks for the all-round development of the Islands in the times to come. The projects include:

• Making 30 Islands free from Restricted Area Permit and Visa-on-Arrival/e-visa facility has proven to be important for tourism in the Isles. The 'No Development Zone' has been reduced from 50 meters to 20 meters to encourage developmental activities in small Islands.

• In order to increase the exports of Fisheries and Marine Products, the A&N Administration is working towards establishing trade-link with South-East Asian countries through direct sea and air transport.

Turning to other projects being implemented by the A&N Administration, the Lt. Governor informed that apart from the IDA projects, many infrastructure, connectivity and development projects being implemented independently by the A&N Administration are in various stages of completion in the last 5 years. The Lt. Governor said, projects such as construction and improvement of rural roads with an investment of about Rs 74 crores, District Hospital Complex with an investment of Rs 24 crores in Garachrama, Hostel facility with an investment of about Rs 13 crores in Bakultala of Middle Andaman, ITI Academic block including staff quarter, etc. gave impetus to development in the Islands.

The Lt. Governor expressed happiness that the Police Administration of the Islands has been bestowed with three Police Medals for Meritorious Service. He also extended his best wishes to the contingents of the parade, school children and everyone present.
