India's digital public infrastructure offers scalable, secure & inclusive solutions for global challenges: Prime Minister

Bengaluru, Aug. 19
Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi has said that India's Digital Public Infrastructure offers scalable, secure, and inclusive solutions for global challenges. Virtually addressing the G20 Digital Economy Ministers' Meeting in Bengaluru today, the Prime Minister stressed the unique opportunity with the G20 forum to lay the foundation of an inclusive prosperous, and secured global digital future. He has called upon G20 delegates to work on a global technology-based ecosystem to address the challenges faced by humanity. He said this will advance financial inclusion and productivity through Digital Public Infrastructure. He laid emphasis on

The Central Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2023 is to amend the Central Goods and Services Tax Act 2017 while, the Integrated Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2023 is to amend the Integrated Goods and Services Tax Act 2017.

The Central Goods and Services Tax (Amendment) Bill, 2023 defines the expressions online gaming, online money gaming, and virtual digital assets. According to the

he added.

Shri Modi emphasised inclusive and sustainable development for all. He informed that India has over 850 million internet users enjoying the cheapest data costs in the world.

The Prime Minister also mentioned the development of ‘Bhashini’, an AI-powered language translation platform to support digital inclusion in all the diverse languages of India. He stated that Aadhar coverage of 1.3 billion, GEM trinity application has revolutionised financial inclusion in India and delivers benefits through Direct Benefit Transfer. This has plugged leakages of resources and saved 33 billion dollars, he added. The CoWIN portal supported India's Covid vaccination drive and helped deliver over two billion vaccine doses along with producing digitally verified Certificates, remarked the Prime Minister.

Union Minister for Railways, Communication, Electronics, and IT, Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw represented the country during the G20 Digital Economy Ministers Meeting. Addressing the gathering, he stressed on democratisation of technology as envisaged by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. He said that every citizen must benefit from technology and Digital Public Infrastructure must bring everyone in its fold. He informed that India has made big strides in applying digital tools as it recorded 10 billion transactions using Unified Payments Interface during July this year.
