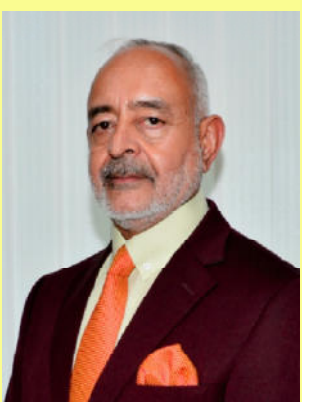

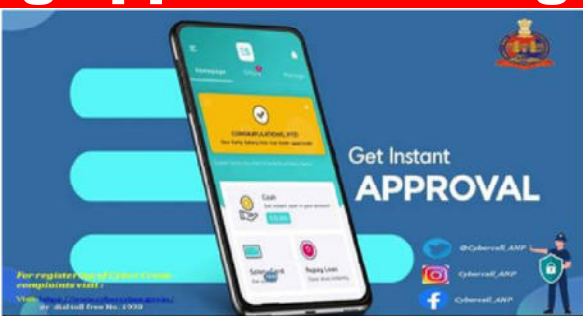

## A&N Police issues public advisory on illegal digital lending apps

### Citizens advised not to use illegal lending apps for availing loans

Port Blair, Aug. 29

A large number of complaints are being reported nationwide pertaining to illegal digital lending apps, which provide short term loans/ micro credits at exorbitant interest rates along with processing/ hidden charges. These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of



vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/ videos, in order to avail the loans. This personal data is then misused for blackmail and harassment. The illegal apps make use

of bulk SMSes. Digital advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale.

All citizens have been therefore advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been cheated, blackmailed or harassed as a result

He also stressed on the need to implement DMHE programme in JNRM which can play vital role for strengthening disaster preparedness and effective response in their institution, locality and community level.

Dr. H.K. Sharma, Principal, JNRM who was the guest of honour appreciated the efforts of the Directorate of Disaster Management for organizing this training workshop for capacity building of the Institute which will be very useful in managing any disaster/emergency situation in future. Associate Professor, Dr. S.C. Two bike theft cases solved and stolen property recovered by PS Pahargaon

Port Blair, Aug. 29

In continuation to zero tolerance policy against any kind of crime, PS Pahargaon has once again cracked two theft cases and recovered the stolen motorcycles. On Aug,23, 2023, based on the complaint of Shri Charles Primeo, S/o Chinnappan, R/o Beodnabad Village, a case was registered at PS Pahargaon and the investigation was entrusted to ASI Peter Indwar of PS Pahargaon regarding theft of a motorcycle make model Bajaj Pulsar 125 CC bearing registration number AN01Q 2591.

In this connection, a dedicated team of PS Pahargaon led by SI

Manish Narayan, ASI Peter Indwar, IO of the case, PC/Jagdish Babu, PC/S S Yadav, PC/ Santosh Lall under supervision of K M Priyanka, IPS (P), SHO PS Pahargaon was constituted to find out the culprit. During the search, the stolen motorcycle was recovered and identified through its chassis number. The recovered motorcycle was found to be without number plate and without other company markings.

On further investigation, the accused was identified as Manish Narayan, S/o Late Dharmender Narayan (23) yrs, R/o Teylerabad. On

interrogation, the accused revealed that he had stolen the motorcycle and had removed the number plate, company markings and some other parts of the bike. He further revealed that he had stolen another vehicle bearing registration number AN01J 0766 from Garacharma, for which, a case was already registered at PS Pahargaon. The stolen motorcycle bearing registration number AN01J0766 was also recovered from the house of the accused, but the motorcycle was found to have most of its parts removed by the accused, a press release from SP (SA) said.
