Dwivedi, Director, Disaster Management, A&N Administration who was the chief guest urged the participants to take in depth knowledge on various topics and acquire hands on training and be prepared to face any crisis. He also stressed on the need to implement DMHE programme in JNRM which can play vital role for strengthening disaster preparedness and effective response in their institution, locality and community level.

Dr. H.K. Sharma, Principal, JNRM who was the guest of honour appreciated the efforts of the Directorate of Disaster Management for organizing this training workshop for capacity building of the Institute which will be very useful in managing any disaster/emergency situation in future. Associate Professor, Dr. S.C. Chaturvedi also shared his experience gained during the Tsunami, 2004 and briefed about the devastated conditions and management system adopted by the individual and institutions.

In his welcome address, Shri Gyan Singh, Assistant Director (Log.), DDM briefed about Andaman & Nicobar Disaster Management System and stressed on student's participation in disaster preparedness and to respond to any disaster effectively in Higher Institutions and also make the community safer. During technical session, Ms. Sanjana and Smti Sarita Kumari, DDM elaborated on the vulnerability profile and communication system of this UT and various disaster preparedness activities carried out in A&N Islands towards disaster mitigation.

Shri Deen Mohammed, ex. Safety Officer, DDM also elaborated on Emergency Communication and Early Warning System of ANI and also on various communication elements that renders an institution 'well prepared' to manage any events during disasters. Dr. Swapan Kumar Biswas, Sr. Consultant (SFDRR), DDM briefed about College/ Institutions Level Disaster Management activities to respond to disasters and urged to conduct regular mock drills on various disasters to test their preparedness level.

Heavy rain (07-11 cm) is likely to occur at one or two places over A & N Islands. Thunderstorm with lightning and gusty wind (speed 30-40 kmph) is also likely to occur at one or two places over A & N Islands on Aug. 30 & 31.

Heavy to very heavy rain (07-20 cm) is very likely to occur at one or two places over A & N Islands on Sept.2

Meanwhile, due to strong Southwest Monsoon current, wind speed exceeding 45 kmph is likely to prevail over Andaman Sea and neighbourhood, fishermen have been advised not to venture into the sea till Aug. 30.


