ISRO releases video of Chandrayaan-3 rover Pragyan rolling down to Moon's surface from lander

Bengaluru, Aug.25

Chandrayaan 2 orbiter revolving around the Moon since 2019 has taken photos of Chandrayaan 3 Lander Vikram. The High Resolution Camera in Chandrayaan 2 has transmitted the photograph of the Lander stationed on the surface of the Moon. ISRO has tweeted that it is the best camera shot with the best resolution that anyone



currently has around the Moon. The tweet says, "I spy you! Chandrayaan 2 Orbiter." ISRO has also tweeted a video of Rover Pragyan rolling down on a ramp of Lander

The Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojna (PMFBY) is one of the Flagship Schemes of the Govt. of India. The scheme is being implemented in these Islands since 2016. The scheme envisages providing insurance coverage to

the farmers for crop loss arising out of natural calamities. The PMFBY supports sustainable income in Agriculture sector by providing financial support to the farmers who suffer crop-loss due to unforeseen events. The scheme ensures flow of credit

to the agriculture sector and stabilizes the income of the farmers. Isles farmers have been urged to take maximum benefit. The cut-off date for enrolment under the scheme for Kharif 2023 is 15.09.2023 and for Rabi 2023-24 is

15.01.2024. The farmers have to approach the SBI or Co-operative Bank of concerned areas along with land records and enroll under the scheme. The PMFBY has been presently notified for 2023-24 season for implementation

Major abdominal surgery conducted by G.B. Pant Hospital/ ANIIMS

Port Blair, Aug. 25

A 62 year old lady from North Andaman with huge abdominal distension and fullness for more than 1 year was referred to the Surgery OPD, G.B. Pant Hospital/ ANIIMS. She was immediately admitted and full evaluation and MRI Scan was done. After obtaining Anesthesia fitness, the patient was taken for a major abdominal operation by Surgical Unit-I. During the surgery,



huge tumor of size 60x50x40 cm involving entire abdomen weighing 8.2 kg was successfully removed. Post operation, she was managed in the ICU. Subsequently, she has improved well and was discharged in fully ambulant condition.



Pathological staging & reporting was done from the Department of Pathology, ANIIMS, which showed complete removal of tumor. The surgery is curative and the patient does not require chemotherapy. She

has been sent home and will be followed up on OPD basis. With better team work and resources, such major surgeries are routinely being done in ANIIMS under the able guidance of Director, ANIIMS, a press release from ANIIMS said.

All farmers (loanee or non-loanee) enrolled under PMFBY will be entitled for subsidy on the premium. Farmers will have to pay maximum or actuarial premium rate, whichever is lower, for the notified crops under Kharif and Rabi seasons. As per revised operational guidelines of PMFBY, 2% for Paddy (for Kharif 2023 crops) & 1.5 % for Pulses & 5% for Vegetables (for Rabi-2023-24 season) of the sum insured is to be paid by the farmers as insurance premium for availing subsidy under the scheme. However, in case of Andaman & Nicobar, farmers need to pay only 0.5% of the sum insured while the remaining amount is additionally borne as subsidy.

PMFBY covers risks of losses arising from either of the possibilities of prevented sowing, sowing to harvesting (due to dry spells, flood, inundation, pests and diseases, landslides, natural fire and lightning, storm, cyclone, etc), post-harvest losses up to a maximum period of two weeks from harvesting, for those crops which are required to be dried in cut and spread/ small bundled condition depending on crops in that area, in the field after harvesting against cyclone, cyclonic rains and unseasonal rains.

After enrolment, any losses to the crop arising out of risks may be intimated immediately (within 72 hours) by the insured farmer directly or through his own mobile or landline phone or any of his own media or Toll Free Numbers, if any to the Implementing Agency (The Kshema General Insurance Limited), concerned bank, local Agriculture Department.

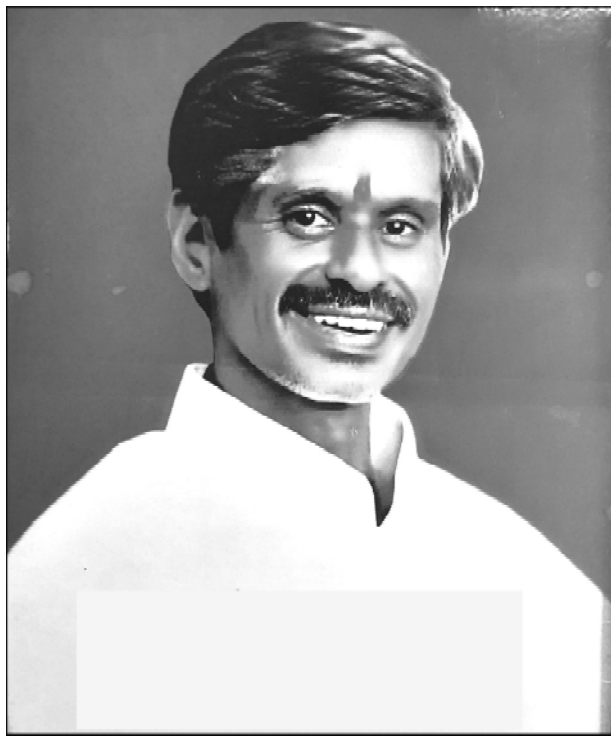

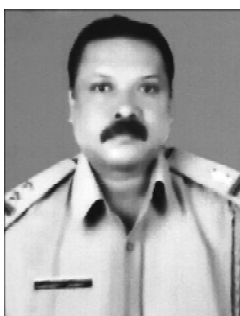
