Whereas, a Notification (F.No. FS/4-2/27 dated 04th September 2023) under section 4 of The Indian Forest Act, 1927 to constitute the area specified in the schedule below as “Reserved Forest” has been issued by the A & N Administration and published in the Extraordinary issue of the Official Gazette No. 86 dated 04/09/2023.

Now under section 6 of the said Act the Assistant Commissioner, Forest Settlement appointed as the Forest Settlement Officer vide the aforesaid Notification dated 14th February 2017, do hereby publish this proclamation explaining the consequences which will ensue on the reservation of the Forest land in the schedule below:-

SCHEDULE

Nischintapur Village in DiglipurTehsil , North Andaman (area 2.00 Hectares).

A compact parcel of Revenue Land bearing Survey No. 85/1/3 measuring 2.00 hects situated in Nischintapur Village under Diglipur Tehsil, North and Middle Andaman District mutated in favour of the Forest Department for raising Compensatory Afforestation, separately demarcated on the ground with the boundary descriptions of the aforesaid piece of land under

a) kindles, keeps or carries any fire except at such seasons as the Forest Officer may notify in this behalf;
b) trespasses or pastures cattle or permit cattle to trespass ;
c) causes any damage by negligence in felling any tree or cutting or dragging any timber;
d) fells, girdles, lops, taps or burns any tree or strips off the bark or leaves from or otherwise damages the same;
e) quarries stone, burns lime or charcoal or collects subjects to any manufacturing process, or remove any forest produce.
f) clears or breaks up any land for cultivation or any purpose; or
g) In contravention of any rules made in this behalf by the state Govt. hunts , shoots, fishes, poisons water or set traps or snares;
Shall be punishable under relevant section of Indian Forest Act 1927 or any other applicable law in force, but nothing shall be deemed to prohibit, if any act done by the permission in writing of the Forest Officer, or under any rules made by the State Govt.

Any person, claiming any right alleged to exist in his/her favour in or over the land mentioned in the schedule, or over any Forest produce may, within three months from the date of issue of this proclamation ,either present to the undersigned a written notice specifying or to appear in person and state the nature of such right and the amount and particulars of the compensation (if any) claimed in respect thereof and in either case, to produce all documents in support thereof. No claim will be entertained after the expiry of the stipulated period
