Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi's mother Smt. Heeraben was cremated at the crematorium in Gandhinagar. Shrimati Hiraben breathed her last at UN Mehta Institute of Cardiology and Research Center Ahmedabad at early morning today. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi came to Ahmedabad this morning and after his arrival, the mortal remains of Smt Heeraben was cremated. Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi along with Modi family members, close relatives, Chief Minister of the State, Shri Bhupendrabhai Patel and many others were



present during the last rites. In an emotional tweet, Prime Minister said that a glorious century now rests at the feet of God. Paying tribute to his mother, Shri Modi said that he felt the presence of a trinity in his mother which symbolizes the journey of an ascetic, a selfless Karmayogi and a life dedicated to values. Recalling his meeting with his mother on her 100<sup>th</sup> birthday, the Prime Minister said that she encouraged him to work with intelligence and live a life with purity. Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare and Hon'ble Lt. Governor hoist National Flag amidst patriotic fervor at Flag Point

The 79<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the hoisting of the National Tri-colour for the first time on the Indian Soil by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose was celebrated today. It was on this day i.e. December 30, 1943, Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose had hoisted the National Tri-Colour for the first time at Port Blair, declaring the Islands, the first Indian Territory freed from the British rule.

To mark the Day, a State Level function was organized by the Department of Art and Culture at Flag Point this morning, in which the Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, Dr. Bharati P. Pawar and Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency hoisted the National Flag amidst patriotic fervour. The Flag hoisting function was attended among others by the Commissioner-cum-Secretary, Shri Nikhil Kumar, Adhyaksha, ZPSA, Smt. Pramila Kumari, Chairperson, PBMC, Smt. Kavitha Udhaya Kumar, Senior Officers of A&N Administration, prominent citizens, tourists and general public.

Later, the Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare interacted with media persons at Flag Point and stated that the First Flag hoisting by Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose in A&N Islands is a historical occasion and reminds us about how the freedom fighters fought against the Britishers to liberate our Country. The Minister who arrived to attend the Flag Hoisting



ceremony also paid her obeisance to the freedom fighters who were incarcerated in the National Memorial Cellular Jail. She said, the supreme sacrifices made by our freedom fighters will inspire the young generation.

Reminding about the contribution of the freedom fighters in India's freedom struggle, the Minister said, people visiting the Cellular Jail must take inspirations from the life of the Freedom Fighters. With the support and sacrifice of all, the First Flag hoisting by Netaji Subhas was possible in A&N Islands, the Minister added.

## CBSE releases date sheet for Class X and XII Board Exams

New Delhi, Dec. 30  
Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has released the date sheet for Class X and XII Board Exams 2023. Class 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> exams will begin from 15<sup>th</sup> February next year. The Board exams for Class 10 will conclude on March 21<sup>st</sup>. For Class 12, the exams will end on April 5.

The exams will start at 10.30 am. The detailed Board sheet is available at the official CBSE website - cbse.gov.in. The CBSE said that competitive examinations including JEE Main have been taken care of while preparing the date sheet for Class XII. The Board said that it has given a sufficient gap between two subjects which are generally offered to students in both classes. The Board said that the date sheets have been prepared by avoiding a combination of nearly 40,000 subjects to ensure that no two subjects' examinations of a student fall on the same date. ## Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare holds press conference Schemes being implemented by Central Govt. in Primary, Secondary & Tertiary health care reviewed: Minister

Port Blair, Dec. 30  
Hon'ble Minister of State for Health & Family Welfare, GoI, Dr. Bharati P. Pawar today lauded the Health Department of A&N Administration for effectively implementing various Schemes launched by the Central Govt. in Health Sector, benefitting the Islanders. The Minister was interacting with the media persons at a press conference held in the conference hall of the Directorate of Health Services here today. Addressing the scribes, the Minister informed that a meeting was held with the Health Officials and doctors of Health Department of A&N Administration during which, the infrastructure facilities and schemes in Health Sector provided by the Central Government in Primary, Secondary and Tertiary health care were reviewed. Prior to the meeting, a two minute silence



was observed to pay homage to Smt. Heeraben Modi, mother of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi who passed away today at Gujarat, the Minister informed. The Minister further mentioned that as per the guidance of the Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, the Primary Health Centres have been converted into Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) to provide health care facilities in Allopathy, Homeo, Ayurveda and Yoga under one roof. She expressed happiness that in A&N Islands, all the 21 PHCs have

been covered under the HWC Scheme. Similarly, out of the 124 Sub- Centres, 102 Sub Centres have been covered under HWCs. Apart from this, 5 UHCs have also been converted into HWCs, the Minister stated adding that 4 CHCs and 3 District Hospitals are also functioning in A&N Islands. The Minister also informed that 60 percent work of the ANIIMS near Corbyn's Cove which is being developed under PM's Central Sponsored Scheme has been completed and the remaining work will be completed soon. She

further informed that efforts are on to expand the new AYUSH Hospital at Junglighat into a 50-bedded Hospital. Informing about some of the positive outcomes, the Minister said that with the collective efforts of ASHA Workers, Anganwadi Workers, Nurses and Doctors, the Institutional delivery has been increased which is more than 98 percent at present. This effort has brought down the maternal mortality rate and infant mortality rate in A&N Islands, she said. The Minister said there are 49 Ambulances

available in A&N Islands and assured that more ambulances will be provided, if proposal for the same is submitted. She said, last year Rs. 41 crores were sanctioned under NHM which were fully utilized and this year Rs. 22 crores have been sanctioned till now and remaining funds will be available by March, 2023, the Minister said.

The Minister also stated that under the PM Jan Arogya Yojana, 35000 people have been covered and more than 700 people have availed the benefit under this scheme. An amount of Rs. 1 crore has been provided to the people to avail health benefits from the 3 empanelled Hospitals in mainland. She said, under Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), 100 percent coverage has been made in creating Health ID cards. The Minister said, 10 Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendras have been opened in A&N Islands and (Contd. on last page)

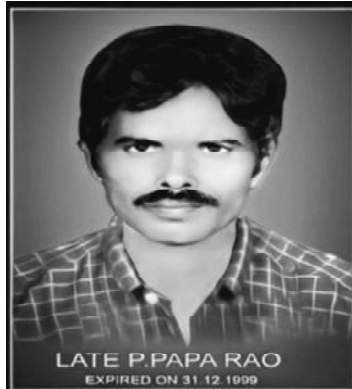
