New Delhi, Dec. 3

Counting of votes for Assembly elections in Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh and Telangana were held today. As per the

results, BJP has won absolute majority in Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Chhattisgarh while the Congress has won/leading in 69 seats. Bharat Adiwasi Party has claimed 3 seats. Others have

taken up tomorrow (Dec. 4).

In Rajasthan, BJP has won 115 seats. The Congress has won/leading in 69 seats. Bharat Adiwasi Party has claimed 3 seats. Others have

won 12 seats. Voting was held in 199, out of 200 constituencies. Election Commission has postponed the polls in one assembly seat following the death of a candidate.

In Madhya Pradesh, ruling BJP has won/leading in 163 seats. Congress has won/leading in 66 seats. One seat has gone to others.

In Chhattisgarh, the BJP has regained

Recently, unknown miscreants who introduced themselves as RBI staff sent fake RBI Master Card purportedly issued from RBI (could be used for withdrawal of money from ATM like ATM Card) to some persons with their names printed on the cards. The senders further instructed the card recipients/holders on how to activate the card with ATM and as a result, he/she could withdraw some amounts of money i.e Rs. 10,000/- per transaction from the ATM. The debiting bank accounts could not be traced since the said card and



its numbers were fake, and could result in unforeseen problems for the card users. In this regard, public are cautioned to note points mentioned below:

Ministry of Tourism launches National Best Tourism Village and National Best Rural Homestays Competition 2024

Applications for competitions open till 31st December

India wins T20 series against Australia 4-1

Bengaluru, Dec.3 Arshdeep Singh held his nerve under pressure in the final over as India won the fifth T20I against Australia at Bengaluru by six runs. Going into the final over of the match, Australia needed 10 runs to win with Matthew Wade (22 runs) and Nathan Ellis (3) at the crease with the visitors seven wickets down. Arshdeep bowled

superbly, getting Wade's wicket and giving away just three runs to take India home.

The hosts sealed the series 4-1. Earlier, India had managed to score 160 runs batting first at Bengaluru with Shreyas Iyer top scoring with 53. Axar Patel (31), Jitesh Sharma (24) and Yashasvi Jaiswal (21) all got starts but they could hang on to their

wickets to help Iyer. After Wade had won the toss and opted to bowl first at the M Chinnaswamy Stadium in Bengaluru on Sunday, the Indian team found it being reduced to 55 for four at one stage. It was Iyer's resolute batting that held up one end as the Suryakumar Yadav-led team staggered past the 100-run mark in the 15th over.

PS Ograbraj apprehends ATM Burglary suspects

Port Blair, Dec. 3

The PS Ograbraj team has demonstrated exceptional efficiency in their swift response to an attempted burglary at an SBI ATM machine in Ferrargunj on Nov. 29, 2023. The incident was reported by vigilant SBI Bank Officials, leading to the immediate activation of PS Ograbraj staff. In a determined effort to conceal their identities, the burglar utilized a helmet, a handkerchief as a mask, a full-sleeve T-shirt, and socks on their hands, along with a knife for the attempted burglary. The gravity of the situation prompted the formation of multiple special teams by the PS Ograbraj, led by SI Devanand Pathak, with SI Agnes Bartholoma

serving as the Investigation Officer. The relentless pursuit and dedicated efforts of the police personnel, including ASI Jagdish Prasad, HC Abdul Nazar, HC Ashok Roy, PC (D) Rehman, PC Biplob Das, PC Rajdhari Yadav, PC Sanjit Shill, PC Rakesh Narayan and PC Jared Roderick, culminated in the successful tracing and apprehension of the offenders. Through a combination of technical analysis and intelligence gathering, the team, under the supervision of Shri Sandeep Lamba, SDPO Bambooflat and overall guidance of Shri Kalaivanan R, IPS, Superintendent of Police, South Andaman, identified one of the offenders as a juvenile, and the

other as Selvendran, 27, S/o Perya Swamy, resident of Nayashar. All articles used during the attempted burglary were seized as evidence. Selvendran was promptly produced before the Hon'ble Court and has been remanded to Judicial Custody, while the juvenile offender has been admitted to Juvenile Home. The success of this operation exemplifies our commitment to upholding law and order in the region. 
