The Chief Secretary said about 13,000 vacant posts in different Departments will be filled up in a time bound manner. In this series, recently, the exams were conducted to fill up the post of 'Group C' employees. Accordingly, till September 2023, all the 13,000 posts will be filled, so as to meet the staff shortages, he said.

Referring to his recent visit to North & Middle Andaman, the Chief Secretary said, he himself saw the dilapidated condition of some of the school buildings which needs immediate attention. He said, survey and mapping of these structures has been done for taking up immediate repair work. A priority wise repairing work of school building has been prepared and the work has commenced, the Chief Secretary disclosed. The Chief Secretary also stated that the Administration is committed to the welfare of the Islanders and putting its best efforts for timely completion of various projects.

The Chief Secretary also released compendium and brochures brought out by State Panchayat Resource Centre, Department of Rural Development and Panchayat.

In her opening remarks, the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (RD/ Panchayats), Smti Nandini Paliwal, IAS remarked that after the Panchayat election in A&N Islands, a large number of newly elected members were elected to the three-tier Panchayat Raj System and this training will acquaint them with the functioning of the system. She further requested the newly Elected Representatives and functionaries of Panchayats to gather more knowledge during the training and improve their capabilities so as to discharge their responsibilities effectively and efficiently. All the PRIs should familiarize themselves with schemes pertaining to Agriculture, Fisheries, Forestry, Skill Development and Livelihood, Social Sector Schemes of Health, Education etc. so that they can ensure that these schemes percolate down to beneficiaries and bring about changes in their lives, she said.

Earlier, in his welcome address, Secretary (RD), Shri Suneel Anchipaka, IAS stated that the RD Department has organized this three day 'Induction Training Program' for the newly elected Representatives of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. He said, the Panchayati Raj is a system of governance in which Gram Panchayat is the basic unit of Administration. The Panchayats are playing an important role in rural development in Isles. This training schedule has been structured in a systematic and scientific manner, so as to present right direction to PRIs and RD Office. identification and how they can publish their findings as short note which can benefit them with various opportunities. He emphasized about the three-fold benefits from the course work i.e., the trainees will gain knowledge on the conservation strategies and policies, taxonomic identification, indirect services of birding as a guide in bird tourism. He also mentioned that ecotourism involves visiting fragile, remote, undisturbed, natural areas rather than popular tourists spots which itself requires educated people.

Speaking on the occasion, the guest of honour, Dr. Ramakrishna, former Director, Zoological Survey of India, Kolkata beautifully described the basic concepts of ornithology. He gave an insight on environmental awareness and conservation of species and how these two sectors are webbed in ecotourism.

As per the Pondicherry University norms, physical fitness test will be conducted for admission to BPES and the candidate must come in proper sports outfit on the day of counselling for their fitness test for the following events viz.100

meter sprint, shot put, standing board jump, vertical jump and 12 minutes run/walk test.

Those who fail to attend the counseling session on specified date and time will not be considered for admission to the respective course and the next eligible candidate from the merit list will be considered for admission. If no candidate is present from specific category, the left out seats will be filled from the general merit list on merit basis (except EWS category).
