Chief Secretary flags off rally from Netaji Stadium

We should collectively work to ensure zero new HIV cases in Isles: CS

World AIDS Day was observed in these Islands too together with the rest of the World today on the theme 'Equalize'. To mark the day, the Andaman Nicobar AIDS Control Society (ANACS) organized a rally from Netaji Stadium. The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS as the chief guest flagged off the rally comprising of school and college students.

Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Secretary (Health), A & N Administration and Dr. Munni Singhania, DHS-cum-Vice Chairperson, ANACS also graced the occasion.

In his brief address on the occasion, the Chief Secretary expressed his happiness over the large turn out of School and College students in the rally to create awareness about this disease. The Chief

Secretary further stated that AIDS is a disease which depends upon our lifestyle. There are certain things we have to be aware of and certain other things which we need to avoid to keep this disease at bay, he said. The Chief Secretary pointed out that as responsive citizens we must ensure that in all respect and in all field the person affected with HIV virus should get equal treatment in the society. He said, we must refrain from certain habits & activities which makes us prone towards acquiring the disease. The Chief Secretary said, we should collectively work to have zero new HIV cases and ensure that the positive numbers in the Islands remain static. "If we are very conscious in our behavior, it will certainly have a major impact in containing this disease", the Chief Secretary added.

The Chief Secretary further said that the two main aim of observing this day is to create awareness among the students



about this disease and methods of prevention and to help those who have acquired this disease to live a dignified life.

Earlier, Dr. Priyanka Yadav, Medical Officer, i/c, ART Centre at ANIMS welcomed the chief guest and others present and threw light on the significance of the day. Around 500 students from schools and colleges holding banners and placards with AIDS Day message walked through the vantage points of the town, spreading the message about 'Know AIDS to

eliminate AIDS'.

Later, a prize distribution ceremony was organized at Dr. B.R Ambedkar Auditorium, Mohanpura wherein the Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Health), Shri Nikhil Kumar, IAS was the chief guest while the Secretary (Health), Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS was the guest of honour.

the pandemic and encourage progress in HIV/AIDS prevention, treatment and care around the world. He further said as there is no treatment for AIDS so far and only prevention is the cure for AIDS. He said there are four methods through which a person can be infected and urged the gathering to take precautions on this count. He said antiretrovirals (ART) to treat those infected with HIV is given at present. Through ART we can manage the problem and lead a healthy life, he said.

Impressed by the cultural programme, a mix of dance, drama & skit presented by the artistes of Balakrishna Nritya Academy & Dance Nritya Academy spreading message about AIDS with simplicity, the Commissioner -cum-Secretary said this programme should be showcased in different schools to create more awareness among school students of class 8th and above. He also appreciated ANACS for conducting this event and said, this should not stop here for just one day but should continue throughout the year. He also gave away prizes to the winners of various competitions organized by ANACS among school, college students and Youth Clubs as part of the AIDS day observance.

Speaking as the guest of honour, the Secretary (Health) said, World AIDS Day is celebrated on 1st December every year to raise awareness about HIV/ AIDS and to demonstrate solidarity for people around the world who are affected by HIV. Doctors and staff to continue the good work and also gave valuable suggestion for better patient care services.

The Deputy Commissioner (N) has agreed to facilitate necessary logistics at Car Nicobar while the Mission Director, NHM in consultation with DHS has agreed to facilitate these patients at Port Blair.

The Mission Director, NHM has requested the Deputy Commissioner (N) to make available Specialists especially Gynaecologists & Pediatrician at Campbell Bay PHC at least once or twice on monthly basis, so that patients in these remote areas are duly attended to.

The Mission Director NHM also laid emphasis on thorough screening of TB suspects & contacts to achieve the national target of elimination of TB before 2025. For the purpose, additional funds will be provided to the District under NTEP, a press release from DC (Nicobars) said.

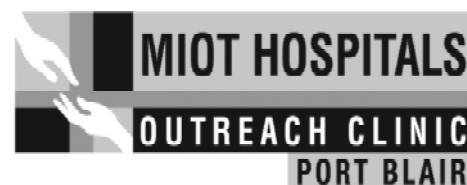

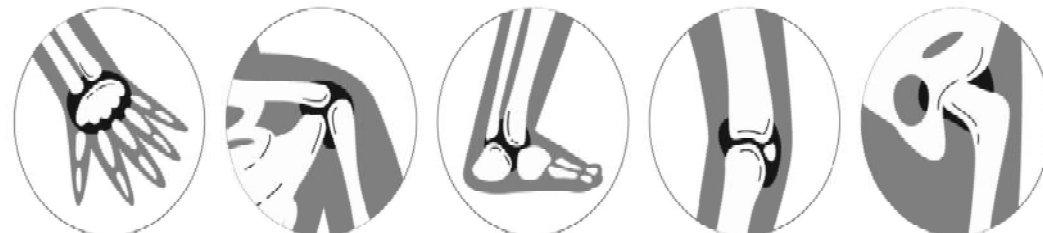

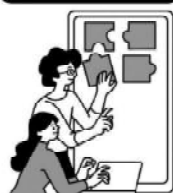
