The President noted that Indian Navy remains firm in its perseverance, resolute in

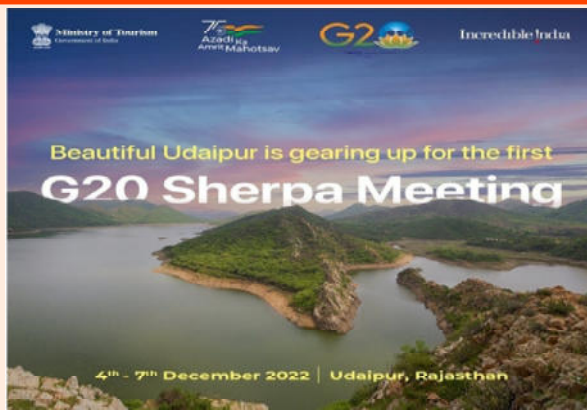

First G-20 Sherpa meeting under India's Presidency begins in Udaipur

Udaipur, Dec. 4

The first G20 Sherpa Meeting under India's Presidency, began in the lake city of Udaipur in Rajasthan today. India's G20 Sherpa, Shri Amitabh Kant is presiding over the four-day meeting. Delivering his opening remarks, Shri Kant, said, India took over G20 Presidency at a time when the world is facing several challenges. He said, India believes every crisis is an opportunity.

Representatives of 19 countries including from European Union and nine special invitee countries will take part in the meeting, setting the stage for important conversations on some of the most pressing issues of current time.



Earlier in the day, holding an informal interaction with media, Shri Kant said, India has taken over the Presidency of G20 amid geo-political crisis, rise in global debt and when as many as 200 million people have been driven into poverty while 100 million people losing their jobs globally due to Covid crisis and inflation. He, however, said New Delhi assuming G20 Presidency means it will help the country to

tell the narrative of the remarkable work done in health care sector, the massive work done in manufacturing Covid-19 vaccine, digital public infrastructure and to tell the world that India is the "Mother of Democracy".

Shri Kant said, he would be making a presentation tomorrow enlisting priorities of India. He informed that there are 12 working groups of Sherpa track and

A&N Police adopts multi-pronged strategy with zero tolerance against illicit liquor & drug menace

Port Blair, Dec. 4

In the fight against bootlegging, illicit liquor and drug abuse, Andaman and Nicobar Police has adopted multi-pronged strategy coupled with zero tolerance against this menace. On supply front, Police is cracking the whips against bootleggers and drug peddlers. On demand side, mass public awareness campaign is launched to spread awareness about ill-effects of alcohol/drug abuse.

Cracking down on bootlegging, as many as 223 cases under 32 Regulation III of 1876 were registered during the month of October-November, 2022, more than 71 a w a r e n e s s programmes on 'Alcohol/Drug Abuse' were conducted in Schools/ Colleges with Community

2022 as compared to 85 cases in August and 118 cases in September, 2022. 893 bottles of liquor, 484 kgs of Handia and 102.7 ltrs of illicit liquor were recovered from the possession of bootleggers. Apart from this, search and combing operations were carried out in jungle in which as much as 2,390 ltrs of Lehan (fermented wash to prepare illicit liquor) was destroyed.

During October-November, 2022, more than 71 a w a r e n e s s programmes on 'Alcohol/Drug Abuse' were conducted in Schools/ Colleges with Community

leaders, PRI members and other stakeholders. The message of hazardous impact of alcohol/ drug abuse on physical, mental, social and financial health was disseminated in a simple and entertaining manner with the help of Skit/ Nukkad Natak enacted by Police Team.

Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to share information pertaining to any crime or other illegal activities to Police at 100,112 & 03192-233077. The identity of the informant will be kept secret, a press release from PHQ, A & N Police said.

He said, Sherpa track, Finance track and engagement group will work towards one objective. In addition, the International Monetary Fund will make a presentation on global economic scenario. Later in the day, the discussion will revolve around India's priorities. The international organisations and invitees will also share their perspective. He said, efforts will be made to bring about a consensus in this meeting on the agenda set by India.

Shri Kant also said that Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi is of the view that the meeting should be decisive, ambitious and action-oriented. He/ she should have availed loan from a scheduled bank under the Education Loan Scheme of the Indian Banks Association (IBA) for the purpose. Students should apply for benefits under the scheme during the 1st year itself of the course. Fresh applications received during 2nd year or subsequent years will not be accepted in anycase. Preference will be given to those applications which are covered under lower rate of interest by various banks of each State/UT to their quota. Payment of financial benefit may be linked with Aadhaar Number, if available.

For availing the scheme, the total income from all sources of the employed candidate or his/ her parents/guardians in case of unemployed candidate shall not exceed Rs. 6.00 lakh per annum. Income Certificate issued by the competent authority in the State/ Union Territory should be submitted in support of income shown by a candidate.
