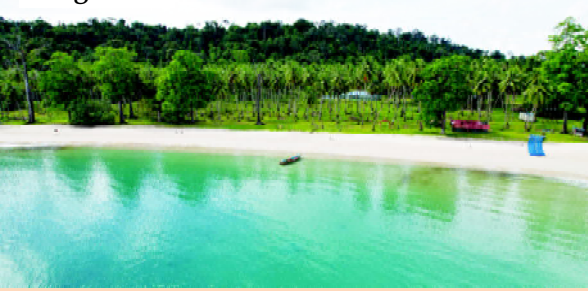

Chief Secretary inaugurates Workshop on Natural Resource Management and Conflict Skills for Forest Management for IFS Officers

"We need to work in tandem to protect Mother Earth and find solution to human-animal conflict": CS

A 3-days Compulsory Training Workshop on Natural Resource Management and Conflict Skills for Forest Management for the Indian Forest Service (IFS) Officers got underway at TSG Grand, Dollygunj today. The Zoological Survey of India, Andaman & Nicobar Regional Centre is organising the workshop which is sponsored by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change,

Government of India. The Chief Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, as the chief guest inaugurated the workshop by lighting the lamp in the presence of Dr. T.S. Ashok Kumar, IFS, PCCE, & Shri Kamal Datta, IFS, Addl. PCCE, Department of Environment and Forests, A & N Islands, the guests of honour and the participating delegates from different parts of the country.

In his inaugural address, the Chief

Secretary, A & N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, at the outset welcomed the delegates of the workshop who have converged from different parts of the Country to these picturesque Islands to attend the training workshop and also spoke briefly about the history of A&N Islands.

The Chief Secretary stated that we have the responsibility to take care and work together to

protect and preserve Mother Earth. Regarding the human- animal conflicts, he said that we need to strike a balance between the human requirements and conservation of wildlife & natural resources. It should not go off balance at any point of time and we need to keep this in mind, the Chief Secretary added.

Referring to the human- animal conflicts in the context of A&N Islands, he said, crocodile conflict

is not merely a statistical conflict about how many people were injured/killed in the last few years but we need to find a solution to this problem and a detail discussion should be held in this context. He also urged to find a solution to the human-animal conflict pertaining to the Nicobar long-tailed Macaque (monkey).

DGP visits A&N Police Dog Squad Unit in Austinabad Issues direction to modernize the squad aligning with latest K9 standards

The Director General of Police of A&N Police, Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, IPS, visited the A&N Police Dog Squad Unit in Austinabad on Dec.4. Upon the DGP's arrival, the Police Canines (K9s) presented the Guard of Honour. Subsequently, a demonstration was presented by the Police K9s, simulating a building collapse scenario to showcase their search and rescue capabilities. The K9s also exhibited their physical and mental efficiency by engaging in various obstacle and agility exercises.



Subsequently, the Director General of Police, visited the Dog Kennels and Staff Barracks, inspecting the designated area for the erection of agility equipment for K9s, and also reviewed the ongoing projects at the Dog Squad. He also held interaction

session with the personnel posted at Dog Squad and addressed their duty related issues.

The A&N Police Dog Squad Unit was established in the year 2002 and started functioning with 4 Sniffer Dogs. At present, 11 Dogs are available with A&N

of Environment and Forests, A & N Islands stated that the topic of the workshop is very appropriate and vital and the participants working in different States in different capacities come across day-to-day conflicts of different nature including human-animal conflicts. The Forest Officials being the custodians of the land area, resources below the land and biodiversity including flora and fauna has to develop skills for dealing with conflicts of varied nature including human-animal conflicts, he said. The population growth which increases the demand of natural resources is also a factor leading to human animal conflicts, the PCCF said underlining the need for sustainable development as well as sustainable management of natural resources.

In his address, the Addl. PCCF, Department of Environment and Forests, A & N Islands informed that about 1117 species and sub species of animals of major groups, both vertebrates and invertebrates, inhabiting terrestrial freshwater and marine habitats are considered endemic to A&N Islands. Referring to the human-crocodile conflict, he said, these Islands have large habitat of crocodile and many a times human beings were injured and became victims to crocodiles. Efforts are on to shift the crocodiles from the human habitats whenever found and from 2019 onwards, the Forest Department has shifted 55 live crocodiles to the 'Chidiyatapu Biological Park' from different parts of these Islands, he added.

20 Senior Level Indian Forest Officers (IFS) from various States & Union Territory (AGMUT-Assam, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Gujarat, Jharkhand, Kerala, Karnataka, Manipur, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Rajasthan, Telangana & Uttarakhand) are attending the workshop and it will continue upto Dec. 8, 2023.

Earlier, Dr. C. Sivaperuman, Officer-in-Charge, ZSI, Port Blair, welcomed the gathering and briefed about the three days programme which include both class room and field visit. He also emphasized the role of Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair in organizing various level of training courses. Dr. Swarnakala, Research Consultant, ZSI proposed the vote of thanks.

After the inaugural session, the technical session began with Dr. Sivaperuman's talk on the overview of Biodiversity of A & N Islands and its challenges. Dr. P.S. Easa, former Director spoke on Biodiversity, Conservation and its challenges in the Western Ghats through various sampling techniques while Dr. Deepak Apte, Managing Director, Srushti Conservation Foundation, Pune gave an overview of Marine Biodiversity & its Conservation in Islands ecosystem with special reference to Lakshadweep. Dr. S. Senthil Kumar, IFS highlighted on Management of human-crocodile conflict and mitigation measures.

Police, which includes 3 Explosive Sniffer, 3 Narcotics Sniffer, 2 Tracker Dogs, and 3 Search and Rescue Dogs. These Sniffer Dogs have been trained at the National Training Centre for Dogs, BSF, Tekanpur, and ITBP, Panchkula, Haryana.

All these Dogs are being deployed along with respective Dog Handlers for various operational duties at the Airport, Sea Port, VIP Duties, National functions, and crime scenes in these Islands. Moreover, K9s are deployed with ANTF teams for the checking of contrabands. Further, Search & Rescue dogs are trained to locate missing persons, disaster survivors, or individuals in distress in diverse environments, finding people who are lost in the wilderness or trapped in the rubble of a collapsed building, etc.

These K9s are accommodated in proper hygienic kennels with regular veterinary check-ups through Veterinary Hospitals to maintain the health and up-to-date vaccination of the dogs, as well as proper nutrition and hydration. The Police dogs are valuable assets that enhance the capabilities of law enforcement agencies across various operational domains. In the recent past,



narcotic dogs on numerous occasions, detected narcotic substances at the Airport/seaport. Also the tracker dogs played a vital role in solving theft/burglary and cases of homicides.

In addition to the above, the dog squad contingent had taken part in the 77th Independence Day Parade held at Netaji Stadium and Aviation Security Culture Week-2023 at VSI Airport. As Police dogs play a vital role in law enforcement, contributing to various aspects of Police work and provide unique capabilities that enhance the overall effectiveness of law enforcement agencies. Further, A&N Police is in the process of procuring four more pups of Belgium Malinois breed for detection of Explosives and Narcotics, with the approval of A & N Administration. In addition, to enhance the physical and mental efficiency of the K9s, the erection of agility works at the Dog Squad is in progress. Moreover, Isolation Kennels and a Veterinary Dispensary at the Dog Squad are on the verge of completion.

Impressed by their dedication and skills, the DGP directed steps towards modernizing the squad, aligning with the latest K9 standards. He also emphasized enhanced coordination with various agencies for optimal operational efficiency, a press release from SP (CID) said.

The Projects will conform to internationally acknowledged benchmarking standards/ norms like GRIHA/LEED/ Green Globe.

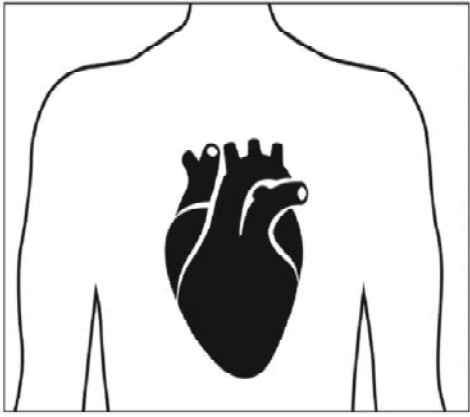

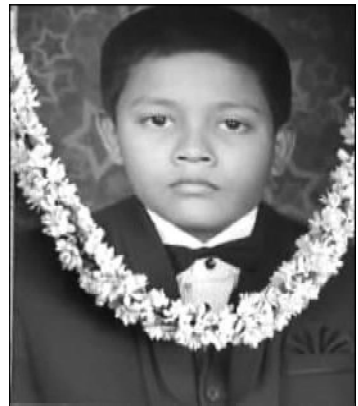
