Accomplice of Nigerian arrested by A&N Cyber Cell of CID for committing cyber crime

Pot Blair, Dec. 7

In a groundbreaking cyber operation, the Cyber Cell, Port Blair, has successfully apprehended one A. Ashwin, a college student, for his involvement in a sophisticated cybercrime case. This case involved the morphing of victim's images followed by their dissemination to the friends of victim alongside threatening emails. The investigation, initiated after a formal complaint by the victim, revealed the disturbing use of advanced techniques to morph images and orchestrate cyber threats. Such acts not only violate the law but also inflict severe emotional and psychological distress on the victims.

Inspector Ranga Raj, In charge of the Cyber Cell, Port Blair, along with his tech-savvy team which includes Insp. Mohd. Sameer, ASI Raja, HC Bhupender Kr.

Singh, PC Kayan Mohd, PC Atish, PC Wilson Toppo, PC Sangeeta Mazumder, PC Hari Krishna, PC T. Vikash, HG(R) Gnana Sekar, meticulously traced and apprehended A. Ashwin, who attempted to conceal his digital footprints. Employing advanced cyber forensic techniques, the team tracked down and arrested Ashwin. Notably, he was a friend of victim and had accompanied her when she initially came to lodge the complaint in Cyber Cell.

During interrogation, Ashwin disclosed his connection with an individual from Nigeria, engaging in frequent W h a t s A p p conversations. This connection led to the sharing of his classmates' photos, eventually evolving into a plan to extort money from the victim through morphed photos. The entire investigation is being conducted under the

supervision of Shri Lakshay Pandey, Dy.SP (Cyber), and the overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, Superintendent (CID). The accused has been produced before the Court of Law for Police Custody, facing charges under relevant sections of the Information Technology Act and other applicable laws.

The A&N Police reaffirms its commitment to ensuring the safety and security of our digital space. Vigilance and prompt reporting of suspicious online activities are encouraged. It is crucial to adopt measures to safeguard your digital identity, and any cybercrimes noticed should be reported promptly to law enforcement agencies. PS Kalighat Police continues its action against manufacturing of illicit liquor

Acting on an input received from reliable source regarding illicit liquor/lehen at Kishorinagar jungle today, the SHO PS Kalighat took swift action by forming a specialized team. The Police team led by SI Silpi Singha, SHO PS Kalighat conducted a comprehensive search

expanded polystyrene, commodities have been prohibited.

(a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration

(b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers

Further, as per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, the manufacture, storage, use, import, transportation, distribution and sale of single use plastic items is banned in A&N Islands.

- > PET Bottles- Water & Beverages, including alcohol, <2L (Less than 2 litres)
- > Plastic Bodied Cigarette Lighters
- > Sachets (Shampoo, Conditioners and similar personal care items, Mouth-fresheners, Pickle/Jam/Sauces, Spices, Condiments, etc.), <15 mL (or equivalent in weight)
- > Single-use plastic bodied use & throw Pens
- > Plastic sheet / Pouches (transparent/coloured/layered) used for packaging of Water, Cooked Food, Gift items, etc. including bubble-wraps.

As per the A&N Administration vide Notification No.225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands. Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website is also prohibited.

All concerned entities and general public have been advised to abide by the directions and non-compliance, if found, may be intimidated to the Member Secretary, ANPCC for necessary action as deemed fit, a press release from ANPCC said.

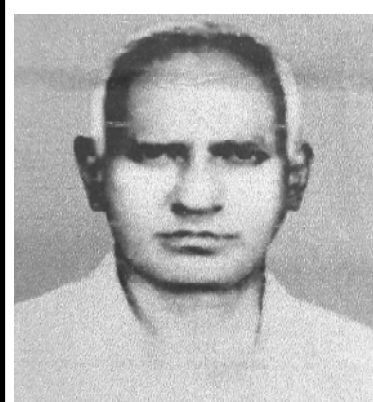

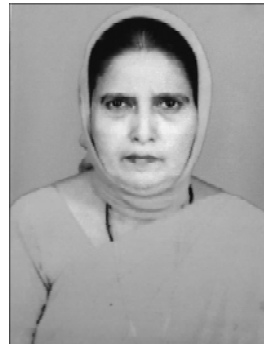
