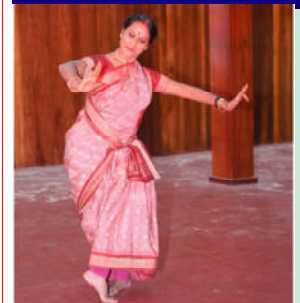
Expressing his concern in the Lok Sabha,

Interview Islands etc. The outpost teams basically look for the poachers who are coming from Myanmar and other parts of Southeast Asia for sea cucumbers and trochus shells which are considered to be of high value in the Southeast Asian markets, he said. 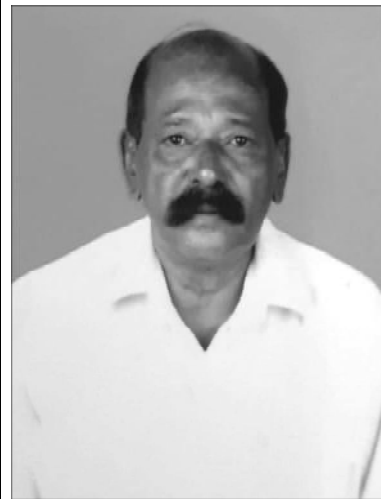
