## Vice-President attends Human Rights Day celebrations organised by NHRC

### Corruption is the greatest danger to human rights; corruption and human rights cannot coexist: Vice-President

New Delhi, Dec. 10 (PIB)

The Vice-President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar today highlighted the affirmative changes taking place in Bharat, home to 1/6<sup>th</sup> of humanity, in the advancement of human rights, asserting its position as a 'Role Model' for the world. "No part of the globe is so blossoming, prospering with human rights as our country is doing", he noted.

Delivering the keynote address at the Human Rights Day celebrations at Bharat Mandapam today, the Vice-President underlined, "our Amrit-Kaal has become our Gaurav-Kaal primarily due to the blossoming of human rights and values." He further observed that "our



civilizational ethos and constitutional commitment reflect our deep dedication to respecting, safeguarding, and nurturing human rights which is in our DNA". Highlighting further, he emphasized, "Bharat serves as an example to the world in nurturing, promoting, and flourishing human rights." Calling that nurturing of human rights as a 'cornerstone

to democracy'; the Vice-President stressed that "Equality before law is an inalienable facet of promoting human rights". He also appreciated the convergence of all the three organs of the State, namely the Legislature, the Executive and the Judiciary for the fostering of human rights as the "Respect for human rights is embedded in our civilizational ethos &

constitution", he added.

Talking about the recent upsurge in the politics of freebies, the Vice-President cautioned that this will lead to distorting of expenditure priority and shall undermine of basic framework of macroeconomic stability as "empowerment of pocket through fiscal grants only increases dependence", he

## A&N Police issues advisory on loan app scams

Port Blair, Dec. 10

Recently, there has been an increase in the number of complaints related to mobile apps and websites offering loans online. These apps and websites provide micro loans of a few thousand rupees. However, even after the loan amount has been paid back, the victim is told that the payment was rejected and is continuously harassed into paying again. If the amount is not paid by the victim, he/she is threatened with distribution of edited images of the victim with vulgar caption to the victim's contacts. In some cases, the victim's relatives are also harassed as the scammers have access to the victim's contacts.



When such apps are installed, it requests permission to access the phone contacts, gallery, etc. The data accessed are sent by the app to the scammers, who then

use it to threaten and harass the victim. Depending on the permissions granted by the users, these apps are capable of collecting sensitive information about the victims based on the data available on the phone, including pictures, audio, video, messages, contact list, etc. which can be used to further harass the victim.

## Ban on production, stocking, distribution, sale & use of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items

Port Blair, Dec. 10

All Producers, Stockiest, Retailers, Shopkeepers, E-commerce Companies, Street Vendors, Commercial Establishments (Malls/ Marketplace/ Shopping Centers/ Cinema Houses/ Tourist Locations/ Schools/ Colleges/ Office Complexes/ Hospitals & other Institutions) and general public have been urged to stop production, stocking, distribution, sale and usage of identified SUP items with respect to the following:

As per Rule 4(2) of PWM Rules, 2016 (as amended), "The manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single use plastic (SUP), including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities have been prohibited.

(a) Ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags,

candy sticks, ice cream sticks, polystyrene (Thermocol) for decoration (b) Plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

Further, as per the A& N Administration vide Notification No.186 dated 05.09.2019, the manufacture, storage, use, import, transportation, distribution and sale of single use plastic items is banned in A&N Islands.

➤ PET Bottles- Water & Beverages, including alcohol, <2L (Less than 2 litres)

➤ Plastic Bodied Cigarette Lighters

➤ Sachets (Shampoo, Conditioners and similar personal care items, Mouth-fresheners, Pickle/ Jam/Sauces, Spices, Condiments, etc.), <15 mL

(or equivalent in weight) ➤ Single-use plastic bodied use & throw Pens ➤ Plastic sheet / Pouches (transparent/coloured/ layered) used for packaging of Water, Cooked Food, Gift items, etc. including bubble-wraps.

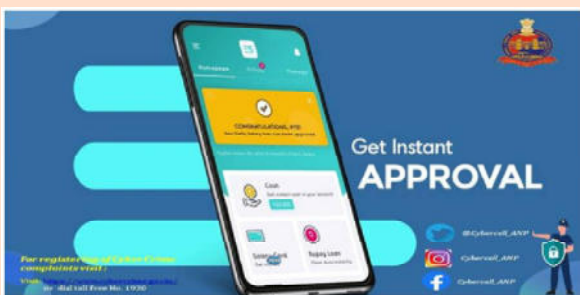
As per the A& N Administration vide Notification No. 225 dated 24.09.2019, the use, manufacture and sale of plastic carry bags irrespective of its thickness, size, color and nature is banned in A&N Islands. Selling as well as display/advertisement of Single Use Plastic (SUP) items on all E-Commerce website is also prohibited.

All concerned entities and general public have been advised to abide by the directions and non-compliance, if found, may be intimated to the Member Secretary, ANPCC for necessary action as deemed fit, a press release from ANPCC said.

## A&N Police issues public advisory on illegal digital lending apps

Port Blair, Dec. 10

A large number of complaints are being reported nationwide pertaining to illegal digital lending apps, which provide short term loans/ micro credits at exorbitant interest rates along with processing/ hidden charges. These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers, are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/ videos, in order to avail the loans.



This personal data is then misused for blackmail and harassment. The illegal apps make use of bulk SMSes. Digital advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale. All citizens have been therefore advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been

cheated, blackmailed or harassed as a result of using these apps, they are advised to report the matter to the Cyber Cell, CID, Port Blair or the nearest Police Station of the area without delay. ## Training on organic oyster mushroom cultivation organised at Sippighat

Port Blair, Dec. 10

A five-day training programme on 'Organic Oyster Mushroom Cultivation Technology' concluded at ICAR-KVK, Sippighat. A total of 34 participants attended the training from different areas of the Islands. This training programme focused on growing mushrooms in urban and peri urban to generate self-employment among islanders.

During the training programme, Dr. Nitu

Sindhu (Women Scientist) demonstrated the mushroom cultivation technology and Dr. Y. Ramakrishna (Head & Principal Scientist, KVK) explained the importance of organic cultivation and how to develop marketing channel in Islands. Shri Tanmai Paul (Farm Manager, KVK) demonstrated different ways to manage the spent mushroom substrate for additional income. A model unit at Krishi Vigyan Kendra was also

demonstrated, which helped the participants understand its value in the integrated farming system and agrotourism. During the valedictory programme, Dr. E. B. Chakurkar, Director, ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair, emphasised the nutritional value as well as economic returns. He urged the participants to actively adopt this technology for entrepreneurship development, a press release from CIARI said.

◆ Do not install mobile apps which are offering loans online as they are most likely created by scammers.

◆ When installing new mobile apps on your phone, check the permissions requested by the app to ensure that it does not have access to your personal information.

◆ Occasionally check your phone to see if there are any mobile apps which you may not have installed.

◆ Please don't surrender to abusive/torturous method of recovery agents of these Loan App companies. In such case report the matter to the Police.

◆ Please do not give your documents for opening of bank accounts to be operated by someone else and also don't allow anybody to use your SIM to be used by someone else. These things can be used for illegal purposes.

urged for empowerment of human minds & human resources and not pockets. Highlighting that India has been treated unfairly by some global entities, VP asked them to delve deep into the nation's performance on human rights and not merely scratch the surface. He wanted such entities to take note of "India's governance model that is free from corruption, favouritism, nepotism. It's dictated by transparency, accountability and merit."

Referring transparency and accountable governance as a 'game-changer' for promotion of human rights especially for the vulnerable sections, the Vice-President underscored that utilization of technology in service delivery have also played an instrumental role in fortifying this advancement. Referring to Justice Misha's report on post poll violence, VP underlined that "visitation of consequences for exercise of franchise is worrisome" and commended the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) for encapsulating the essence of human rights in its reports, thereby promoting the principles of the Rule of Law.

In his address, VP cautioned that "greatest danger to human rights emanates from corruption", underscoring "corruption and human rights cannot coexist", Shri Dhankhar expressed satisfaction that "this bane of corruption in India for long is now contained". He further asserted, "There is now in place a governance mechanism that provides no room nepotism, favouritism and promotion. Corruption has been neutralised in power corridors." The Vice-President expressed concern over "pernicious narratives and external calibrations" by individuals gauging India's progress from air-conditioned and closed chambers, detached from the "index of hope, optimism, and confidence" fostered by Government policies.
