Fast Attack Craft INS Tarmugli commissioned into Navy at Naval Dockyard, Visakhapatnam

Visakhapatnam, Dec. 15

INS Tarmugli, a Fast Attack Craft has been commissioned into the Navy at a ceremony held at Naval Dockyard, Visakhapatnam yesterday. Vice Admiral Sandeep Naithani, AVSM, VSM, Chief of Materiel, Indian Navy commissioned the Trinkat Class FAC which was gifted to the Maldivian Naval Defence Forces (MNDF) in 2006 by



India. The ship returned in May this year and post extensive restoration work by the Naval Dockyard, Visakhapatnam, was reincarnated in its present avatar.

The warship is fitted with advanced MTU engines, water jet propulsion, latest communication equipment, a 30 mm gun and an advanced Radar system and will be extensively used

for coastal surveillance and protection of our ODAs in the KG Basin area and along the East Coast of India.

INS Tarmugli would operate under the Naval Officer-in-Charge (Andhra Pradesh). Named after a picturesque island in the Andaman group, the 320-tonne INS Tarmugli, measuring 48 meters in length, can achieve speeds in excess of 30 knots.

No. 6-1(9)/2018-MPH(Vol-I)-In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No. 14-3/60-ANL dated 11th April, 1960 and in partial modification of Administration's Notification No.180 dated 14/07/2010 and Notification No.167 dated 21/06/2018, the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following amendment prescribing the method of recruitment to the post of “**Insect collector**”, Group ‘C’ (Non-Gazetted/ Non Ministerial) in the establishment of Directorate of Health Services under Andaman & Nicobar Administration.

Claims and objections are invited from the stake holder/persons to be affected thereby. The claims and objections (if any) should reach the Office of Directorate of Health Services, A&N Administration within 30 days from the date of its publication, for consideration.

1. Short Title and Commencement:-
i. These Rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration Group-‘C’ (Non-Gazetted/Non Ministerial) Posts of **Insect Collector**in the Directorate of Health Services Recruitment Rules, 2023.
(ii) These shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay:-
The number of Posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in Para 2 to 4 of the Schedules annexed thereto.

3. Method of Recruitment, Age Limit and Other Qualification:-
The method of recruitment, age limit, educational qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Para 5 to 13 of the attached schedule.

4. Initial Constitution of the service:-
The **Insect Collector**working on regular basis under the Health Department of this Administration as on the date of publication of this rules in the Official Gazette, their services shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules and they shall be members of the service.

5. Disqualification:-
No person-
(a) Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person having a spouse living.

OR

(b) Who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant Governor (Administration), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such persons and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the provision of these Rules.

6. Powers to Relax:-
Where the Lieutenant Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, if necessary, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving:-
Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

We are informed today that the Expert Committee constituted by the order dated 20th November, 2023 is arriving today in Port Blair to carry out the said order.

Although submissions on several aspects of the matter were made before us, we have today taken note of the urgent need to carry out and complete the temporary repairing work of the long highway from Chidiyatappu to Lamia Bay (NH-4), which Mr. D.C.Kabir, learned advocate has very aptly described as the life line of the Islands. Thus we only need to clarify and pass an order for implementation of Paragraph 12 of the said order dated 20th November, 2023.

After hearing submission of learned counsel for the parties, we are of the view that the said highway be suitably divided into parts or stretches, each of a specified length. Each part or stretch may be the subject matter of a tender issued by National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) wherein the nature, description and quality of the work should be stipulated to be positively completed by 30th April, 2024.

However, Mr. Shamit Sanyal, learned advocate appearing for the National Highways & Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) submits that the entire stretch is not damaged and only the highway running through the forest area needs to be repaired.

Considering the submissions made by other learned counsel, we are unable to accept this contention.

All engineering and technical issues relating to the work are left to be addressed by NHIDCL. Implementation and progress of the work shall be subject to the supervision of the Expert Committee.

This writ will appear on the first Friday of all subsequent Circuits to take stock of the progress made and receive an action taken report from NHIDCL.

The Registrar of the Circuit Bench of this Court is directed to transmit a server copy of this order to the newspaper “The Daily Telegrams” for publication tomorrow (16th December, 2023).

The application CAN/1/2022 is not moved and thus dismissed for default.

The application CAN/3/2023 is disposed of accordingly.
