In his felicitation address, Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) emphasized on the importance of PBR and Para Taxonomy and how it would be beneficial to the trainees.

The DCF, Mill Division,in his address stated that this form of course implants the knowledge in capsule mode on relevant issues and inspire trainees for a better experience which will be put out through interactions with the notables. He also stated that the inputs from the course will help in biodiversity management in the field.

India defeats Bangladesh by 188 runs in Chattogram test; Take 1-0 lead in two-match series

Chattogram, Dec, 18
India registered a convincing 188-run victory against Bangladesh in the first test match played at the Zahur Ahmed Chowdhury stadium at Chattogram on Sunday. The hosts started the final day of the match at 272-6, needing 241 runs to win, but they were all out within one hour of the play at 324 chasing the massive score of 513 runs. Bangladesh made a valiant effort to chase the daunting score of India but had to concede defeat after Axar Patel sent Taijul Islam to finish with an impressive figure of 4-77. Kuldeep Yadav took 3 for 73 in the second innings. In the



first innings also he had an impressive haul of 5-40 contributing significantly to the victory of India in the first test.

Bangladesh captain Shakib Hasan put on a stiff fight scoring 84 runs off 108 balls before bowling to Kuldeep Yadav. His score of 84 included 6 sixes and 6 fours. Debutant batter Zakir Hasan scored 100 off 224 balls before falling to Ravichandran

Ashwin. India scored 404 in the first innings of the match with stellar performances by Cheteshwar Pujara (90) and Shreyas Iyer (86). Bangladesh folded up at a paltry 150 in response to this big score. India declared its second innings at 258-2 powered by the maiden century of opener Shubhman Gill (110) and an unbeaten 102 by Cheteshwar Pujara.

No. 1-10/RD & LSG/2022 – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India. read with the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs Notification No. 14/3/60-ANL dated 11th April, 1960 and in supersession of all notification issued to this effect, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group ‘C’ post of Daftary, Peon, Sweeper-Cum-Mali, Messenger-Cum-Rider, Chowkidar, Peon-Cum-Chowkidar and Safaiwala/Sweeper etc. re-designated as **“Multi Tasking Staff”** vide Order No. 989 dated 02.12.2013 borne in the Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement:
(i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Group ‘C’ Post of Multi Tasking Staff in the Rural Development and Panchayat Department) (Recruitment) Rules, 2022.
(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification, Pay Matrix Level:
The number of posts, classification and Pay Matrix Level attached thereto, shall be as specified in Sl. No. 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to.

3. The method of Recruitment, Age Limit, Qualification etc.:
The method of recruitment to the post, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in Sl. No. 5 to 14 of the Schedule aforesaid.

4. Disqualification: No person –
(i) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(ii) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post.
Provided that the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to Relax:
Where the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may , by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving: -
Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.


