The MoHFW, Govt. of India has initiated a program on Community Support to TB Patients - Nikshay Mitra (Donor)" under Pradhan Mantri TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan with the objectives to provide additional patient support to improve treatment outcome of TB Patients, augment community involvement to eliminate TB by 2025 and leverage the avenues for Corporate Social Responsibilities (CSR). The TB Mukt Bharat Abhiyaan was launched by the Hon'ble President of India on 09/09/2022.

In order to facilitate effective implementation of the Abhiyaan, Ni-kshay 2.0, an exclusive web portal for registration of Ni-kshay Mitra (Donors) has been developed. Ni-kshay Mitra for this program can include individuals, co-operative societies, corporates, elected representatives, institutions, non-governmental organizations, political parties and partners who can support by adopting consented TB patients in the peripheral health facilities/ blocks/urban wards/districts/states. Under this initiative,

nutritional support, diagnostic support and vocational support can be provided from 6 months to 3 years to all consented TB patients by Ni-kshay Mitra.

CSR support has also been mobilized by the Health Department to help the TB patients. The Canara Bank, Port Blair has come forward to become a donor to support the TB patients under the scheme and assured to donate Rs.1.90 lacs. The Hon'ble Prime Minister in his vision, has asked all the officers to register as Nikshay Mitra. The Hon'ble PM urged every person, every organization and representatives associated with the Civil Society to take up this resolution for playing an active role in building TB Free India. Accordingly, 20 Senior Officers and Doctors of Health Department have registered as Nikshay Mitra.

To attain the call of Hon'ble President of India, the A&N Administration has registered 59 Nikshay Mitras, who are providing nutritional support to 206 TB patients. The TB patients notification rate for the year 2022 is 101% and success rate is 86%, which is more than the national average. The Health Department is conducting active case finding for early diagnosis of TB patients and also doing followup management of all diagnosed cases.

I look forward to the active support of all serving Officers/Staff Associations to come forward and become Ni-kshay Mitras. The interested officials/organizations can register themselves as Ni-kshay Mitra by visiting https://communitysupport.nikshay.in. Necessary support would be provided to all willing officers to register, by the State TB Officer & District TB Officers.



Central share for 2022-23 under pre-matric scholarship for SC will be released only after receiving the verified data from the respective State Govt/UTs. Pre-Matric OBC Scheme is being implemented through the respective State Governments/ UTs. Every financial year, funds are allocated to all States/UTs from the overall annual outlay of the Scheme.

The enrolment of class I to VIII in Government schools has increased in the last 3 years by about 1 crore. Further, to incentivize children from these communities to attend school, the Government is providing free education, free uniform, free meal etc. under different programmes/ schemes like Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan, PM Poshan, etc.

Earlier, the students from Economically Weaker Sections were not provided Pre-Matric scholarship but in the revised scheme they are also being considered for Pre-Matric scholarship for classes IX and X.

Under the Right to Education (RTE) Act, 2009, the Government is committed to provide free and compulsory elementary education (Classes I to VIII) to each and every child. Under the centrally sponsored scheme- Samagra Shiksha, financial assistance is provided to States and UTs for undertaking various activities for universalization of education, including opening/strengthening of new schools upto senior secondary level, construction of school buildings & amp; additional classrooms, setting up and running of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose Avasiya Vidyalayas, provision of free uniforms, free text books to the eligible students at elementary level, transport allowance and undertaking enrolment & amp; retention drives. Further, special training for age appropriate admission of out of school children and residential as well as non-residential training for older children, seasonal hostels/residential camps, special training centers at worksites, are also supported to bring out of school children to the formal schooling system. There is also increase in the enrolment of students in class I to VIII in the last 3 years by about 1 crore.

From the year 2022-23, pre-matric scholarship scheme is available for students only in Class 9 and 10. This information was given by Minister of State for Social Justice and Empowerment, Dr. Virendra Kumar in a written reply in the Lok Sabha today.

Cutoff date for Processing, Approval and Payment of Final Claims based on yield data is three weeks from receipt of yield data.

Normal sowing & harvesting period of crops under Rabi- 2022-23 season is Sowing from $1^{
m st}$ October- $15^{
m th}$ January and Harvesting from $15^{
m th}$ January - 15th April.

All farmers (loanee or non-loanee) enrolled under PMFBY will have to pay maximum 1.5% of sum insured or actuarial premium rate whichever is lower for Pulses and also 5% of sum insured or actuarial premium rate whichever is lower for horticulture crops for all vegetables under Rabi-2022-23 season. The difference between actuarial premium rate and the rate of insurance charges payable by farmer shall be treated as rate of normal premium subsidy, which shall be shared equally by the State Government and Central Government in the ratio of 50:50. (As per revised operational guidelines of PMFBY, farmer's premium share will be 1.5 % & 5% for Rabi-2022-23 seasons. As decided by SLCCCI of A&N Islands in its meeting held on 11.04.2022, the farmers will pay the premium rates only @ 0.5% of the Sum insured for all the notified crops for their enrollment under PMFBY which will be collected by the Nodal banks of these Islands and the remaining premium share amount out of 1.5 % & 5% (i.e. 1.0 % & 4.5% of Farmer's premium) will be borne by this UT. Similarly, as the maximum farmers premium by default is 1.5% out of premium rate 5% of SI for Pulses and the farmers' premium to be borne by the farmers is 0.5%, so the U.T A & N Administration have to bear the balance 1%. Hence, the Central shares of the subsidy will be 1.75% ((5-1.5)/2), State shares of subsidy will be 2.75%(1.75+1) and also 5% out of premium rate 15% of SI for all vegetables and the farmers' premium to be borne by the farmers is 0.5%, so the U.T A & N Administration have to bear the balance 4.5%. Therefore, the Central shares of the subsidy will be 5% ((15-5)/2), State shares of subsidy will be 9.5%(5+4.5), a press release from Nodal Officer (PMFBY), Directorate of Agriculture said.

fishing, strict implementation of gear-mesh size regulations under Marine Fishing Regulation Acts (MFRAs), etc. for sustainable and responsible fishing practices. These steps have resulted in increase in the overall fish production in the country over the years which has resulted in highest ever fish production of 162.48 lakh tones during 2021-22, which includes increment of fish production in marine sector from 37.27 lakh tones (2019-20) to 41.27 lakh tones (2021-22) and in inland sector from 104.37 lakh tones (2019-20) to 121.21 lakh tones (2021-22). As such, no report regarding damage caused to fish reserves due to natural calamities has been received in the Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairving, Government of India. This information was given by Shri Parshottam Rupala, Union Minister of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry & Dairying in a written reply in Lok Sabha today.
