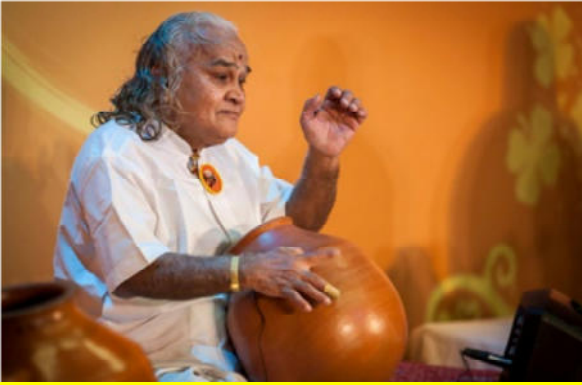
Hectic preparations on to host Island Tourism Festival at ITF Ground from Dec. 27 to 31

The much awaited Island Tourism Festival-2023 will be held at ITF Ground, VIP Road from Dec. 27 to 31. Hectic preparations are on at the venue to make the event a gala one. Islanders as well as the tourists alike are waiting for the spectacular event to unfold on Dec.27. Being organized by the Tourism Department, A&N Administration in collaboration with Department of Art & Culture from Dec. 27, the five days festival, will see performances by artistes from mainland as well as the Islands at various designated venues for the entertainment of the Islanders and tourists alike. The event will be held in 14 locations viz. Island Tourism Festival Ground, Wandoor, Wimberlygunj, Ferrargunj, Shaheed Dweep, Swaraj Dweep, Baratang, Rangat,

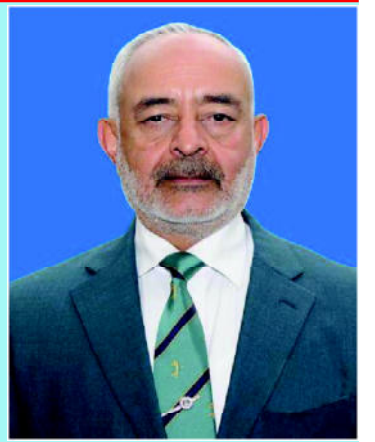

Women's Cricket: India record maiden Test victory over Australia with 8 wicket win

Mumbai, Dec. 24

India recorded their maiden victory against Australia in a women's test match at Wankhede Stadium in Mumbai today with their comprehensive eight-wicket win in the one-off contest.

India had taken control of the match with a commanding 187-run lead in the first innings. They needed just 75 runs to win the match after bowling Australia out for 261 in the second innings. India reached the target just after lunch losing two wickets.

This is India's first victory against Australia in 11 tests since the teams first clashed



in the longest format in 1977.

Earlier, after the tourists had resumed their second innings at 233 for 5, India took the final five Australian wickets for just 28 runs restricting the visitors to 261

all out.

Off-spinner Sneha Rana was chosen player of the match for her seven-wicket haul. The teams will now play three ODIs and an equal number of T20 Internationals.

Whereas as per the section 25(RESTRICTIONS ON NEW OUTLETS AND NEW DISCHARGES) of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, No person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or take any steps to establish any industry, operation or process, or any treatment and disposal system or an extension or addition thereto, which is likely to discharge sewage or trade effluent into a stream or well or sewer or on land.
Whereas as per the section 21(RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF CERTAIN INDUSTRIAL PLANTS) of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, subject to the provisions of this section, no person shall, without the previous consent of the State Board, establish or operate any industrial plant in an air pollution control area.
Whereas, it is the responsibility of the industrial unit to obtain Consent To Establish(CTE) from Andaman Nicobar Pollution Control Committee(ANPCC) before establishment of industry and also obtain Consent to Operate(CTO) after establishment of unit. Non compliance of this is the violation of the provisions made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
Whereas, it has come to the notice of ANPCC that the many of Industrial Units have been established without obtaining CTE and also started operating without CTO under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974 and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981, which is a violation of the aforesaid rules.
Whereas, ANPCC has given an opportunity to such units by giving window to all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving 60 days window from 10-03-2023 to 10-05-2023 and 90 days windows from 01-07-2023 to 30-09-2023for getting CTO from ANPCC. Even after the lapse of such period, ANPCC is still receiving applications for issue of CTO without having prior CTE.
Now, therefore the ANPCC in its XXIX meeting held on 24-11-2023 has decided to extend the window for further period of 90 days to regulate all such industrial establishment who have not obtained CTE before establishment by giving a window from 20-12-2023 to 20-03-2024to apply for getting CTO from ANPCC. However the CTO will be issued subject to fulfillment of environmental norms applicable to the industry.
Therefore, it is informed to all the stakeholders and general public that it is the statutory responsibility of all the industries to obtain CTE prior to establishment of any industry& CTO after establishment in Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The industrial unit/entrepreneur shall apply for CTE& CTO using the URL: www.anocmms.nic.infor the fulfillment of requirement made under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1974, Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act, 1981 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986. Any industrial unit which fails to obtain CTO from ANPCC within the stipulated time shall be liable for action as the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
No Consent to Operate will be issued to any industry after lapse of 90 days(i.e. 20-03-2024)who have not obtained CTE before its establishment.
