Therefore, Aadhaar is only one of several documents for authentication and identification for the purposes of purifying the electoral rolls.

According to the Election Commission of India, with regard to persons enrolled on Voter ID database, as per the final publication of electoral roll as on 01.01.2023, the total number of persons enrolled were 94,50,25,694. Another information is being collected and will be laid on the Table of the House.

PROPOSAL FOR AMENDMENT OF ANDAMAN & NICOBAR ISLANDS TOWN & COUNTRY PLANNING REGULATION, 1994

Whereas, the Govt. of India promulgated & notified Andaman & Nicobar Town & Country Planning Regulation, 1994 (A&NITCP Regulation, 1994) (No. 07 of 1994) in the Gazette of India vide No. 61 dated 05/08/1994 which was again notified in the A&N Gazette vide No. 158 dated 19/12/1994. Subsequently, the Administrator/Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Andaman & Nicobar Islands had formulated and notified the Andaman & Nicobar Town & Country Planning Rules, 2005 vide No. 283 dated 28/09/2005 by invoking powers to make the rules under Section-34 of A&NITCP Regulation, 1994.

Whereas, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration has now proposed to make few amendments to include provisions related to constitution of Development Authority and in addition to including the amendment proposal already contemplated to empower the Administrator to carry out modification to the Master Plans including its characters, extend of land uses and standards of Population density etc.

Accordingly, views, suggestions and comments are invited from all stakeholders on the amendment proposal as at Annexure-I.

Promulgated by the President in the Seventy -Sixth Year of the Republic of India. A Regulation to provide for the development of the Union Territory of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands according to plan and for matters connected therewith.

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of article 240 of the Constitution, the President is pleased to make following Regulations further to amend the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Town and Country Planning Regulation, 1994 namely-

Short title and Commencement;

i. This Regulation may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Town and Country Planning (Amendment) Regulation, 2023.

ii. It extends to the whole of the Union Territory of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

iii. It shall come into force from the date of its publication in the official Gazette of India. 2. After sub-section (2) of Section 5 of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands Town and Country Planning Regulation, 1994, (herein after called Principle Regulation), the following shall be

"5(3) Constitution of the Development Authority

a) As soon as may be, after the Notification of the Development Area under Sub Section (1) of Section 11 of the Regulation, the Administrator may constitute a Development Authority by such name as may be notified for the purpose of preparation and implementation of Master Plans and Detailed Development Plans, Schemes, Projects for the overall planned development of the Development Area.

b) The Development Authority shall be a body corporate having perpetual succession and a common seal with power, subject to the provisions of the Regulation, to acquire, hold and dispose of property, both moveable and immoveable, and to contract, and may sue or be sued by its corporate name aforesaid

c) Composition of the Development Authority:-

The Authority shall consists of Chairman, Chief Executive Officer and other members not exceeding twenty, who in the opinion of Administrator are closely related with the Planning and Development of the area-representing Departments like Agriculture, Forest, Police, Tourism, Shipping, Power, Civil Aviation, Tribal Welfare and APWD etc. & elected representatives, as

d) Delegation of powers to the Town Planner:-The power conferred upon the Town Planner by the regulation be exercised by the Chief Executive Officer or any member of the Authority to be appointed by the Administrator under Sub-Section (1) of Section-3 of the

e) Temporary association of any Officers/Experts/Persons:- The Authority may temporarily associate any Officers/Experts/Persons whose assistance or advise may considered to be necessary in performing any of its functions with the permission of the Chairman.

f) Honorarium & Allowances:- The Honorarium & Allowances of the non-official members attending the meeting shall be paid as may be notified.

g) Staffing of Authority:- The Planning & Development Authority may with the approval of the Administrator appoint such numbers of Officers and Staff as may be necessary for the efficient performance of its functions and determine their designation and grades as may be

h) Salary and allowances of Officers and Staffs of Authority:- The Officers and Staffs of the Planning & Development Authority shall be entitled to receive such salaries & allowances from the funds of the authority and shall be governed by such terms and conditions of service as may be notified.

5(4) The broad functions of the Authority maybe as follows which may vary subjected to specific notification for the respective development area :-

(1) The object of the Development Authority shall be to administer the affairs and secure the planned development and maintenance of the township and industrial development areas. (2) Without prejudice to the generality of the functions of the Development Authority, specified in clause(1), the Development Authority shall perform the following functions, namely:-

(a) to act as a single point of contact for clearances required from different agencies or departments and for the said purpose, all the powers and functions of the said agencies or department shall devolve upon the Development Authority and wherever needed separate Notification to the said effect shall be issued by the Administrator.

(b) to acquire land in the township and industrial development area, by agreement or through proceedings under the Right To Fair Compensation And Transparency In Land Acquisition,

Rehabilitation And Resettlement Act 2013 for the purposes of this Regulation; (c) to prepare a plan for the development of the township and industrial development area; (d) to lay down the purpose, demarcate and develop sites for the purposes of industrial

commercial and residential purposes or any other specified purpose according to the plan; (e) to allocate and transfer either by way of sale or lease or otherwise plots of land for industrial commercial, residential or any other specified purposes;

(f) to provide infra-structure and all necessary amenities for industrial, commercial, residential or any other specified purposes;

(g) to enter into contracts, agreements or arrangements with any person or Development Authority as the Development Authority may deem necessary for performing its functions;

(h) to regulate and supervise the setting up of township and industrial area; (i) to lay-out directions, regulate, supervise and ensure that the construction and erection and maintenance of buildings is in accordance with the Rules and directions made hereunder;

(i) to regulate, supervise and ensure that the site/building is being constructed/utilised/occupied in accordance with the Rules made hereunder and hold inquiry, inspection, measurement survey etc. for the said purpose;

(k) to engage suitable consultants or persons having special knowledge or skill to assist the Corporation in the performance of its functions;

(I) all such other acts and functions as may be necessary for or incidental or conductive to, any matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects of the Development Authority; (m) To exercise such other powers and perform such other functions as are supplemental. incidental or consequential to any of the forgoing powers and functions or as may be directed

by the Administration. 5(5). Land to vest in the Development Authority and power to deal

a) Notwithstanding anything contained in any Regulation, the land in the notified development area shall, immediately after the establishment of the Development Authority under Clause 5(3) of the Regulation, be deemed to have been covered in the jurisdiction of Development Authority which may also take over such land for and on behalf of the Administration for public purpose in accordance with law for the purposes of this Regulation.

b) The Authority on acquisition of land or buildingfor public purpose or belonging to the Development Authority or transferred to the Development Authority in the development area, may sell, lease, dispose or otherwise transfer whether by auction, allotment on such terms and conditions as it may, subject to any Rules that may be made under this Regulation.

c) No development of land in the Development Area shall be undertaken or carried out except by or with the permission of the Development Authority.

5(6). Levy of tax, charges and fees

a) The Development Authority may, with the previous approval of the Administrator, levy taxes.

b) The Development Authority may, levy charges, at such rate and from such date as may be prescribed, for the purposes of providing, maintaining or continuing any amenities in the Development Area.

c) The Development Authority may, charge fee, at such rate and from such date as may be prescribed, for any licences and permissions that may be granted by the Development Authority.

d) If the Administrator consider it necessary or expedient in the public interest, it may, by a general or special order, exempt wholly or partly- any such transferee or occupier or any class hereof from the taxes, charges or fees levied under clause (a), (b) and (c) above. 5(7). Cessation of application of local body Act/Regulation

On and from the date on which an Development Authority is constituted under Sub-Section-B of Section-5, the Administrator may by notification direct that any functions exercisable by the ocal body, within the development area shall be transferred and performed by the Development Authority under the Municipal or PanchayatRegulation on the said date, in relation to such development area, which shall cease to apply to the said development area.

5(8). Power to authorize a person or agency to provide infrastructure or amenities and collect taxes or fees

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in any other provisions of this Regulation and subject to such terms and conditions as may be specified in the Rules, the Development Authority may, by agreement, authorize any person or agency to provide or maintain or continue to provide or maintain any infrastructure or amenities under this Regulation and to collect taxes or fees, as the case may be, levied therefore.

5(9). Funds of the Development Authority

) The Development Authority shall have and maintain its own fund to which shall be credited: a) all moneys received by the Development Authority from the Administration by way of grants, loans advances or otherwise;

(b) all money borrowed by the Development Authority from sources other than Administration by way of loans or debentures;

c) all fees, tolls, charges, fees etc. received by the Development Authority under this Regulation d) all moneys received by the Development Authority from the disposal of lands, buildings and other properties movable and immovable, and

(e) all moneys received by the Development Authority by way of rents and profits or in any other manner or from any other sources.

i) The funds shall be applied towards meeting the expenses incurred by the Development Authority in the administration of these Regulation and no other purposes.

ii) Subject to any directions of the Administration, the Development Authority may keep in current account of any Scheduled Bank such sum of money out of its fund as it may think necessary for meeting its expected current requirements and invest any surplus money in such manner as it thinks fit.

v) The Administration may make such grants, advances and loans to the Development Authority as the Administration may deem necessary for the performance of the function of the Development Authority under this Regulation and all grants, loans and advances made shall be on such terms and conditions as the Administration may determine.

r) The Development Authority may borrow money by way of loans or debentures from such sources (other than Administration) and on such terms and conditions as may be approved by

vi) The Development Authority shall maintain a sinking fund for the repayment of moneys borrowed under sub-section (v), and shall pay every year into sinking fund such sum as may be sufficient for repayment within the period fixed of all moneys so borrowed.

ii) The sinking fund or any part thereof shall be applied in or towards, the discharge of the loan or which such fund was created and until such loan is wholly discharged it shall not be applied for any other purpose.

5(10). Budget of the Development Authority

The Development Authority shall prepare in such form and at such time every year as the Administration may specify, a budget in respect of the financial year next ensuing, showing the estimated receipts and expenditure of the Development Authority.

5(11). Accounts and Audit

a) The Development Authority shall maintain proper accounts and other relevant records and prepare annual statement of accounts including the balance-sheet in such form as the Administration nay specify.

b) The accounts of the Development Authority shall be subject to audit annually by Examiner, ocal Fund Audit or any other as prescribed by the Administration.

Provided that in place or in addition to the Examiner, Local Fund Audit, the Administration may entrust the audit to the Comptroller and Auditor General of India or to any other Auditor on such terms and conditions, in such manner, for such period and at such times as may be agreed upon between him and the Administration.

c) The rights, authority and privileges of any person conducting audit under sub-section(b) shall

In the case of Examiner, Local Fund Audit, be the same as he has in connection with the audit of the accounts of local Authority;

i. In the case of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India, be the same as he has in connection with audit of Government accounts; and

i. In the case of any other auditor, be as prescribed; and in particular, he shall have the right to demand production of book, accounts, connected vouchers, papers and other documents and to inspect the Office of the Development Authority. d) The accounts of the Development Authority, as certified by the Auditor or any person appointed by him in that behalf, together with audit report thereon shall be forwarded to the Administration annually or at such times as may be directed by it. The Administration may issue such direction to the Development Authority as it may deem fit and the Development Authority shall be bound to comply with such directions.

Any expenditure, incurred by the Auditor in connection with the audit, shall be payable the Development Authority to the Auditor.

5(12). Annual Report& Returns

The Development Authority shall prepare a yearly report of its activities during the year such other reports & returns and submit to the Administration in such form and on or before such date as the Administration may specify.

5(13). Payment of Dues

The manner of raising demand, mode of payment, manner of realization of dues and all other natters incidental thereto, shall be prescribed by the rules, made in this regard.

5(14). Authentication of orders and documents of Authority All permission, orders, decisions, notices and other documents of the Development Authority shall be authenticated by the signature of the Chief Executive Officer of the Development Authority or any other officer authorized by the Development Authority onits behalf.

5(15). Members and officers to be public servants

Every member and every officer and other employee of the Development Authority shall be deemed to be a public servant within the meaning of Section 21 of the Indian Penal Code.

5(16). Power to delegate

The Chairman of the Development Authority may by general or special order direct that any power exercisable by him under these Regulations may also be exercised by such officer of the Development Authority in such cases and subject to such conditions, if any, as may be specified therein.

5(17). Dissolution of Development Authority

a) Where the Administrator is satisfied that the purpose for which the Development Authority was established under these Regulations have been substantially achieved so as to render the continued existence of the Development Authority in the opinion of the Administrator is not necessary, that Administrator may by Notification in the Gazette declare that the Development Authority shall be dissolved with effect from such date as may be specified in that Notification and the Development Authority shall be deemed to be dissolved

o) From the said date -

) all properties, funds and dues which are vested in, or realisable by the Development Authority shall vest in or be realisable by the Administration

ii) all lands placed at the disposal of the Development Authority shall revert to the Administration:

iii) all liabilities which are enforceable against the Development Authority shall be enforceable against the Administration; and iv) for the purpose of carrying out any development which has not been duly carried out by the Development Authority and for the purpose of realising properties, funds and dues

referred to in clause (i) above, the functions of the Development Authority shall be discharged by the Administration. 3. Sub-section (1) and Sub-section (2) of Section 9 of the Principle Regulation

shall be substituted as follows:-

"(1) The Administrator may make any modification to the Master Plan, if he is of the opinion to do so in the interest of general public. 2) The Central Government may, in the interest of security of the State or of the General

Public make any modifications to the Master Plan." 4. Section 16 of the Principal Regulation shall be substituted and read as below:

"Penalty Any person who contravenes any provisions of this Regulation, or

Rules made thereunder or any directions issued thereunder or makes any default in the payment of any consideration money or instalment thereof or any other amount due on account of the transfer of any site or building by the Development Authority or any rent due o the Development Authority in respect of any lease, or where any transferee or occupier nakes any default in the payment of any fee or tax levied under this Regulation, or in case

of any breach of any condition of such transfer or breach of any Rules made under this Regulation, shall, be dealt in manner provided under the Rules, punishable with either one or more than one of the following modes of penalties, including but not limiting to, as

a) Recovery of arrears/ tax/charges/fees/rent;

b) Fine as prescribed;

c) Forfeiture:

d) Imprisonment; e) Demolition, if applicable;

f) Resumption."

1) After Clause (K) of Sub-Section (2) of Section 34 of Principal Regulation, the following shall be added;

I) The levy of taxes, development charges and charges for provision of amenities and services as under Sub-Section (6) of Section-5.

m) The form and contents and timing of the budget to be submitted by the authority under Sub-Section (10) of Section-5.

n) Form of statement of account, balance sheet, Audit details as per Sub-Section-(11) of Section-5.

o) The form and timing of submission of annual report and returns of the authority under Sub-Section (12) of Section-5.

p) Prescription of penal provisions for violations of regulations & rules, default in payment, breach of conditions of transfer under Section-16.

2) The existing Clause (I) of the Sub-Section (2) of Section 34 of the Principal Regulation shall be read as clause (q).




