# STATE LEVEL MOCK DISASTER MANAGEMENT EXERCISE ON FEB. 9

## Mock Exercise- Objectives and Programme

### Background:

The geographical location of Andaman and Nicobar Islands (ANI) makes them vulnerable to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters. Disaster Preparedness at all levels is a challenge as these Islands are one of the most seismically active parts of the world where several great earthquakes have occurred and cluster of earthquakes activity was observed.

These Islands are located between latitude 10.35N and 13.70N and longitudes 92.20 E and 93.95 E, covering an area of 6.231 Sq.Km.

Andaman Nicobar Islands region forms parts of the major global Alpine-Himalayan seismic belt which extends from south Pacific islands through Java, Sumatra, Andaman-Nicobar Islands, Himalayan Mountains, Greece, Italy and Spain.

A tectonic process called "Sea Floor Spreading" is presently widening the Andaman Sea, just like the Atlantic Ocean. This is taking place along undersea ridges on the seafloor. The Indian plate is diving beneath the Burmese Microplate along the Andaman Trench in a process known as "**Subduction**". Shallow and occasional intermediate-depth earthquakes delineate the subducted slab under the Andaman-Nicobar Islands joining the seismicity trend of the Indo-Burma ranges. This belt is seismically one of the most active parts of the world.

As per Seismic Zoning Map of India contained in IS 1893-1984 the A&N Islands fall in the **Zone V**, The devastating earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical movement of land mass in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands and generated "Tsunami killer waves" in which many lives were lost besides loss of properties.

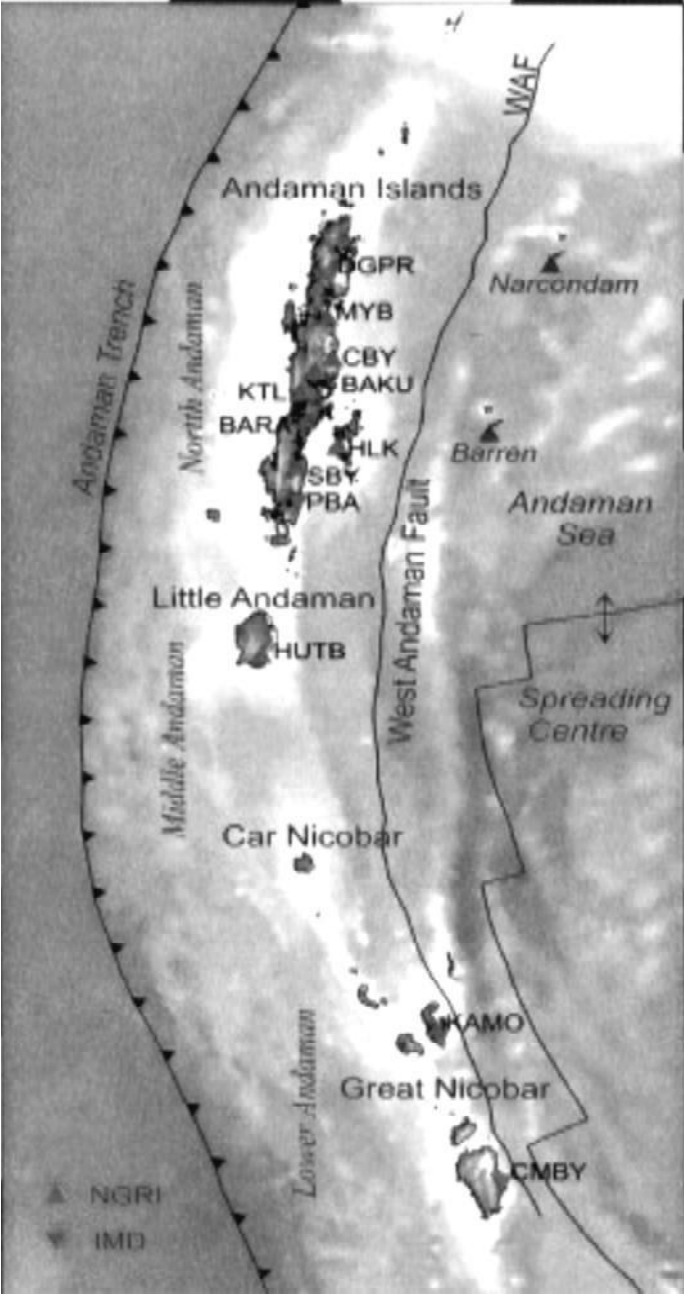
The Andaman trench marks this boundary and lies in the Bay of Bengal to the west of the archipelago. Another prominent feature is the North-South West Andaman fault which is strike-slip in nature and lies in the Andaman Sea, to the east of this Island chain. [Fig-1 shows **Andaman Trench** stretched 2200 kms from Banda Ache to Bay of Bengal].

Disasters when they occur, impact all irrespective of political, social, economic or geographic boundaries. There has been an increase in number of natural disasters over the past few years. The impact of such a calamity transcends physical components and impacts the socio-economic condition of affected persons and places.

We have made long strides in several areas towards strengthening the institutional mechanism and response capacity for different activities related to disaster management. However, despite the best preparedness and highest response standards, disasters remain a challenge to humankind. Continuous up-dation and state of readiness become extremely important in disaster management. One should not forget the Manmade Disasters like; Terrorist Outrages, Mutiny, Breakdown of Services, Forest Fire, Biological, Chemical, Nuclear, Cyber Terrorism, Hijacking and Oil Spill.

The challenge before us is, therefore, is to strive towards higher levels of understanding, preparedness, mitigation efforts and response mechanism. This in turn needs to be backed by better coordination among different organizations, departments, Panchayati Raj Institutions, academic institutions, the civil society and citizens at large.

Keeping this in view, the Administration proposes to conduct State Level Mock Disaster Management Exercise in Andaman and Nicobar Islands on **9th Feb, 2023 in coordination with National**



**Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and Indian National Central for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS)** incorporating the painted hazardous scenarios in different areas and different Islands to check response mechanism and procedures followed by stakeholders by observing **COVID** appropriate behaviour. This will help us to assess preparedness level of departments, schools, colleges and communities as well as inter-departmental co-ordination.

### Exercise Objectives:

Sound preparedness and effective response of various stakeholders to disaster is the key to success. It is also to test the efficacy and effectiveness of Disaster Preparedness of all the stakeholders of ANI under the supervision and in coordination with National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) and National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM), Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), Government of India (GOI), New Delhi, National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad, Indian Meteorological Department (IMD), Ministry of Earth Sciences (MoES), GOI, New Delhi, Andaman and Nicobar Command (ANC), Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO), National Institute of Ocean Technology (NIOT) and Coast Guard.

### Objectives: -

- Check the response time of each SEOC, EOCs CRs, DMOs, ESFs and ERSS.
- Validate the emergency communication, warning system, dissemination process of the disaster management organizations/ institutions and other participating agencies.
- Evaluate the processes of confirming, receiving and disseminating bulletins/messages by the disaster management organizations to other responsible agencies within their area or to the public.
- Hone the organizational decision-making process about public warnings and evacuation.
- Identify proper communication methods that would be used to notify and instruct the public.
- Record and assess community preparedness: the response time, methodology adopted, the arrangements made and system of mass evacuation of public from vulnerable areas.

The exercise will be coordinated by the Directorate of Disaster Management (DDM) at State Level and the respective District Administration in the three Districts.
