Member of Parliament demands increase in budget of Andaman & Nicobar Islands from Rs.5,987 crore to Rs.25,000 crore

Port Blair, Feb. 13

Raising his points in Parliament on the General Budget for the year 2023-24 on Friday, the Member of Parliament, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma noted that the budget allocated for Andaman and Nicobar Islands is a marginal increase of Rs. 280 crore from Rs 5,703.65 crore in 2022-23 to Rs. 5,987 crore this year. The Member of Parliament placed 50 demands in the Parliament in order to



ensure a holistic growth for Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The demands are as follows: 1. Increasing the budget of Andaman and Nicobar Islands from 5,987 crore to 25,000 crore (Twenty Five Thousand Crore) as one time investment to develop infrastructure so

that the Islands starts generating its own revenue and need not depend on Central Government rather contribute to the Central Government revenue. 2. To fill up all the 10,000 vacant posts of Andaman and Nicobar

Towards TB Free Status by 2025 Sub-National Certification Survey conducted in all three Districts of Isles under NTEP

Port Blair, Feb. 13

Under National TB Elimination Programme (NTEP) A&N Islands, a Sub-National Certification (SNC) Survey was conducted in all three Districts. SNC Survey is a novel initiative by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, GoI, New Delhi, to assess the progress towards TB Free Status by 2025, in which Districts/States/UTs are

reviewed with graded reduction in current TB incidence against baseline incidence of 2015 and awarded under Bronze, Silver, Gold and TB Free categories. This award claim is examined by an independent verification agency led by ICMR's National Institute of Research in Tuberculosis (NIRT) & National Institute of Epidemiology (NIE), WHO India and Indian Association

of Preventive and Social Medicine (IAPSM).

During this survey, 60 volunteers in 30 teams went door to door in 30 randomly selected villages/wards in all three Districts, capturing data in WHO India's District

Level Annual Survey (DLAS) - Mobile App and collected samples for TB molecular testing from eligible participants, under the supervision of Deputy Commissioners/Chairman, District Health Society and District TB Officers.

when Aero India used to be 'just a show' and a window to 'sell to India' but the perception has changed now. "Today, Aero India is India's strength and not just a show", the Prime Minister said as he stated that it not only showcases the scope of the defence industry but also showcases the self-confidence of India" The Prime Minister said that India's successes are bearing witness to its capabilities. Tejas, INS Vikrant, advanced manufacturing facilities in Surat and Tumkur, said the Prime Minister, are the potential of Aatmnirbhar Bharat with which the world's new alternatives and opportunities are linked.

"The new India of the 21st century will neither miss any opportunity nor will it lack any effort", the Prime Minister said as he noted the revolution brought in every sector with the help of reforms. He underlined that the nation which used to be the largest defence importer for decades has now started exporting defence equipment to 75 countries in the world.

Referring to the transformation of the defence sector in the last 8-9 years, the Prime Minister said that the aim is to take defence exports from 1.5 billion to 5 billion by 2024-25. "From here India will take rapid strides to be included among the largest defence manufacturing countries and our private sector and investors will play a big role in that", the Prime Minister said. The Prime Minister called upon the private sector to invest in the defence sector which will create new opportunities for them in India and in many other countries.

"The India of today thinks fast, thinks far and takes quick decisions", Shri Modi said as he drew the analogy of India in Amrit Kaal to a fighter jet pilot. The Prime Minister said that India is a nation which is not afraid but excited to soar to new heights. India is always rooted however high it flies howsoever is its speed, the Prime Minister stressed.

"Aero India's deafening roar echoes India's message of Reform, Perform and Transform", the Prime Minister remarked. He mentioned that the entire world is taking note of the reforms made for 'Ease of Doing Business' in India and touched upon the various steps taken to create an environment that favours global investments as well as Indian innovation. The Prime Minister said that in this year's Budget, tax benefits for manufacturing units have been enhanced. The scheme provides a financial incentive to Banks for promoting point-of-sale and e-commerce transactions using Rupay Debit Cards and person-to-merchant transactions of low value up to two thousand rupees on the BHIM-UPI platform.

New Delhi, Feb. 13 The Minister of State for Education, Dr Subhas Sarkar has said that out of 1,113 Universities and 43,796 Colleges in the country, the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has accredited 418 Universities and 9062 Colleges as of the 31st of last month.

In a written reply in the Lok Sabha, the Minister said the University Grants Commission has informed that in order

to bring all educational institutions, Universities and Colleges under the accreditation system, NAAC has considerably reduced the fee structure for Assessment and Accreditation.
