## A&N Police issues public advisory regarding fake delivery parcel scam to get OTPs from targeted victims

Port Blair, Feb. 3

As people become more aware about the methods used by cybercriminals, they are getting creative, developing new methods for fraud. Cybercriminals are perpetrating a new scam targeting many people to get OTPs (One Time Passwords) for making fraudulent bank transactions and getting access to the victims' email addresses/ smart phones by manipulating them with Fake Delivery Parcel Scam. These scams are often carried out by people who work closely with delivery agents or delivery agencies. When they find out that a particular person receives a lot of packages from various e-commerce companies,



then they plan to target him.

In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

- Confirm your order history and the potential delivery dates before accepting / cancelling any package.
- Avoid clicking on any link received in an SMS when dealing with such package deliveries.
- Scrutinize all the URLs (links) before opening and filling in any information/OTP.
- Avoid sharing your personal details such as address, email id, phone number, etc. if not required.
- Avoid clicking on a link or calling back the number from an unexpected delivery notice via a SMS or email.

As per norms of HCoI, 01 KuH is selected for 300 pilgrims. The final selection of candidate is subject to confirmation received from HCoI.

and justice delivery. He underlined that cooperation can take place while respecting each other's jurisdiction as when we work together, jurisdiction becomes a tool to deliver justice without delaying it.

Throwing light on the radical changes in the nature and scope of crime in recent times, PM Shri Modi pointed out the vast networks created by criminals across countries and their usage of the latest technology both in funding and operations. He also drew attention to the fact that economic crimes in one region are being used to fund activities in other regions, and the challenges of the rise of cryptocurrency and cyber threats. Stressing that the issues of the 21st century cannot be tackled with a 20th-century approach, the Prime Minister underscored the need to rethink, reimagine and reform including modernizing legal systems, making the system more flexible and adaptable.

The Prime Minister highlighted that reform cannot take place without making the justice system more citizen-centric as ease of justice is the pillar of justice delivery. Recalling his time as the Chief Minister of Gujarat, he said that setting up evening courts enabled masses to attend hearings after their work hours - a step which gave justice but also saved time and money, benefitting hundreds of people.

Explaining the system of Lok Adalats or 'people's court', the Prime Minister said that it provides a settlement mechanism for small cases related to public utility services and is a pre litigation service where thousands of cases are resolved while ensuring ease of justice delivery. He suggested carrying out discussions on such initiatives that can add great value to the world.

"Legal education is a key instrument in boosting justice delivery", the Prime Minister said, noting that both passion and professional competence are introduced to young minds through education. Giving insights into realizing the potential of women in every domain, PM Shri Modi suggested making each domain inclusive at the educational level. He said that an increase in the number of women in law schools will lead to an increase in the number of women in the legal profession. He also suggested exchanging ideas on how more women can be brought into legal education.

The Prime Minister emphasized the need for young legal minds with diverse exposure while asserting that legal education needs to adapt to changing times and technologies. He said that a focus on understanding the latest trends in crimes, investigation and evidence would be helpful.

Highlighting the need to help young legal professionals with greater international exposure, PM Shri Modi called upon law universities to strengthen exchange programmes between countries. Giving the example of the world's only university dedicated to forensic science located in India, the Prime Minister suggested students, law faculty and even judges from various countries be helped to explore short courses here. He also suggested developing countries work together to get greater representation in many international institutions related to justice delivery while also assisting students in finding internships, thereby enabling the legal systems to learn from international best practices.

PM Shri Modi pointed out that India's legal system was inherited from colonial times, but the last few years have witnessed a record number of reforms. He mentioned the abolition of thousands of obsolete laws from colonial times, some of which had the potential to become tools to harass people, and underlined that it has boosted ease of living and ease of doing business. "India is also modernizing laws to reflect the present realities", Shri Modi said, highlighting that the 3 new legislations have replaced more than 100-year-old colonial criminal laws. "Earlier, the focus was on punishment and penal aspects. Now, the focus is on ensuring justice. Therefore, citizens have a sense of assurance rather than fear", he remarked.

Underlining that technology can also have a positive impact on justice systems, the Prime Minister said that in the last few years, India has used drones to map places and provide clear property cards to rural people, reducing disputes, the possibility of litigation, and load on the justice system, making it more efficient. He said digitalisation has also helped many courts in the country, taking proceedings online, which has helped people access justice even from far-away locations. He said India is happy to share its learnings in this regard with other countries and we are also keen to learn about similar initiatives in other countries.

Concluding the address, the Prime Minister asserted that every challenge in justice delivery can be addressed if the one shared value of passion for justice is shared among nations. "May this conference strengthen this spirit. Let us build a world where everyone has access to timely justice and none is left behind", Shri Modi concluded.

Department in the area of Water Treatment. There were 69 participant in the program.

The program was designed to train newly recruited Engineers in details of treatment process commonly used for filtration of water before supply for distribution among public. Training included details theoretical classes on undergoing chemical treatment process and methods to measure treatment efficiency. Participants were also introduced with latest treatment technology and future prospect. Participants underwent practical training in determining the quantity of various types of chemical required with respect to raw water quality and treated water standards. They also participated actively in chemical dosing, back washing and other treatment process related activities at Lamba Line during day long camp at Lamba Line Treatment Plant. They were introduced to latest technology in desalination process and participants were encouraged for more interest in similar other technology which may become cheaper as better process is developed.

Such initial exposure shall help the newly appointed Junior Engineers to get familiar with their duties and responsibility after posting in the Water supply section of various Divisions of APWD and it shall improve service delivery at grass root level, a press release from APWD said.

**Test I - Filling of Polybags with provided soil**

- The candidates will have to fill the soil in the provided polybags (up to top), as per the standard filled polybags displayed at the site of the test for the candidates.
- 01 mark is assigned for filling each polybag and accordingly the total no. of polybags which are properly filled will be marked for grading.
- Half / partially filled polybags will not be accepted for marking.  
(Note: Provisioning of soil and polythene bags for the test will be made at the site of trade test to each candidate by the Department.)

**Test II - Making of sticks from the coconut leaves**

- The candidates will have to peel and make 10 numbers of sticks out of the 15 coconut leaves provided to them for making broom using the knife.
- The sticks should be as per the standard of coconut leaf sticks displayed at the site of the test for the candidates.
- Each stick peeled out as per the standard stick displayed will carry 01 mark.
- Half / partially/ improper split leaves will not be accepted for marking.  
(Note: Provisioning of coconut leaves, knives for peeling for the test will be made at the site of trade test to each candidate by the Department.)

**Test III - Making bamboo chataai/mat**

- The candidates will have to make one bamboo chataai/mat of size 2m x 1m with the given number of bamboos.
- The chataai/mat has to be made as per the standard chataai/mat displayed at the site of the test for the candidates.
- Marks will be assigned step-wise till completion of the task. The distribution of marks will be explained to the candidates during the briefing of the activity.  
(Note: Provisioning of bamboos and other tools required for the test will be made at the site of trade test to each candidate by the Department.)

**Test IV - Identification of Seedlings/Seeds**

- The candidates will have to identify 05 numbers of seedlings and 05 numbers of seeds kept in the test.
- Such identification of seedlings and seeds has to be done.
- Correct identification of seedlings and seeds will carry 01 mark each.

**NOTE:**

- No individual admit Card/Call letter will be issued for appearing in the Trade test scheduled above.
- Candidates have to produce a valid Photo Identity proof/Card such as – Aadhaar Card, Islander Card, Driving License, Voter Identity Card etc. issued from a Government agency to prove his/her genuineness at the venue for appearing in the Trade test on the appointed date.
- The candidates shall make their own arrangement to reach the venue at the reporting time and no TA/DA will be paid for attending the Trade test.
- Use of mobile phone or any other electronic gadgets will be strictly prohibited at the venue during the Trade test.
- In case, any candidate fails to attend the trade test on the prescribed date, time and venue due to coinciding of date(s) on which he/she has to attend any other recruitment test/exam conducted by the the Department of Environment & Forests or Andaman & Nicobar Administration, those candidates will be allowed to attend the trade test on the last day (13.02.2024) of the trade test on production of valid supporting documents for attending the trade test.
- No change in date, time and venue of Trade test shall be allowed for any candidate except under the circumstances mentioned above at Point (5). If the candidate fails to attend the trade test, it will be presumed that he/she is not interested for the test and his/her candidature will be summarily rejected/cancelled at that stage itself and no further communication will be made.
- In case, the trade test of the candidates could not be held on a particular day, due to some unforeseen reasons like natural calamity etc., trade test of the candidates fixed on that particular date will be held on a different date and the candidates will be informed separately.
- The candidates will be responsible for their own safety during the trade test and are advised to use the tools provided during the trade test carefully. The department will not be responsible for any mishap/accident, if any, occur during the course of the trade test. The candidates should make themselves satisfied with their health condition/physical fitness before attending the trade test.
- All the prescribed tests, i.e., Test-I, II, III & IV are to be completed by the candidates as prescribed in the schedule of the Trade test on the same day.
- Candidates who have not made any attempts in a particular trade test will be awarded zero in respect of that prescribed activity.
- In case of tie of marks, candidate with higher age will be given preference.
- Mere participation in trade test does not bestow any claim of the candidate for appointment to the post of Mazdoor.
