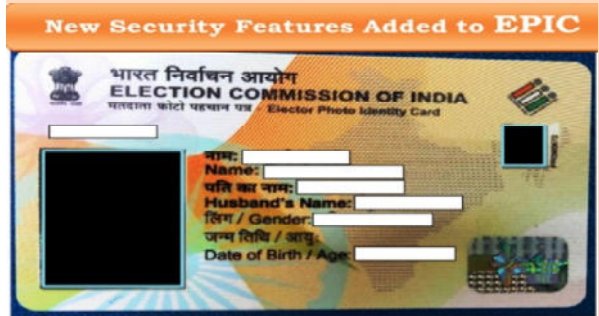
Rozgar Mela is a step towards fulfilment of

Electors registered during Special Summary Revision of photo electoral roll - 2024 to receive EPICs through Postal Deptt. soon

To prevent electoral fraud, Elector's Photo Identity Card (EPIC) was introduced by the Election Commission of India in the year 1993 and with passage of time and in view of major advances of technology; the Commission has decided that the quality of cards, security features and other specifications shall be further improved.

In this line, as per the

ECI's instruction new security featured EPIC was introduced in A&N Islands since last Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Roll - 2023. The new features like in card size, thickness, hologram, Micro text, Ghost image, Guilloche patter, QR code etc are enhanced in new EPIC cards.

Those electors who

are registered during Special Summary Revision of Photo Electoral Roll - 2023, in revision 2, 3, 4 of continuation updation and in final revision 2024 are eligible to get this new security features EPIC card.

The printed EPICs are distributed to electors through Postal Department. For smooth and safe delivery of

EPIC cards to enrolled electors. The office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Postal Department, A&N Islands.

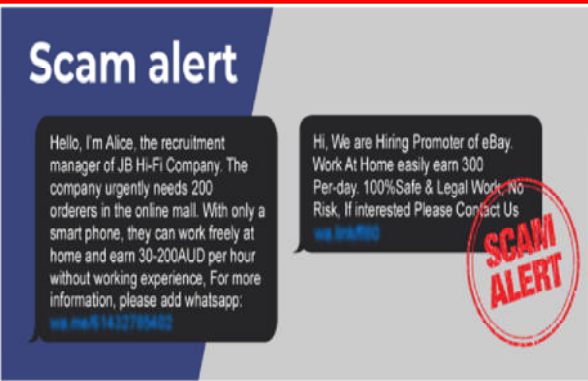

Public Advisories on Fraudsters sending Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime

Port Blair, Feb. 11

A new trend in financial cyber fraud has been observed where fraudsters send Fake Job Offer SMSs to perpetrate Cyber Crime. Fraudsters place online advertisements claiming that they can give jobs where one can make large amount of money working from home with little time and effort. A job scam occurs when a fraudster poses as an employer or recruiter, and offers attractive employment opportunities, which require job seekers to pay some money in advance. The SMSs sent by fraudsters offer high-paying part-time jobs to siphon off victims' money and their personal information. In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police issues the following advisory to safeguard



yourself:

- 1) Avoid tempting job offers sent via text messages or emails by unknown senders.
- 2) Scrutinize the job offering company online (use words like "scam," "fraud," or "complaint" with company name to online search & verify if similar scams are happening).
- 3) Avoid making any payment without authenticating the employer for registration or other purposes.
- 4) Scrutinize the

SMS-Headers to confirm the authenticity of a job offer.

Fraudsters typically show urgency in their requests. Scrutinize properly, if a request seems too urgent.
