India will emerge as 3rd largest global market in aviation sector in coming years: Prime Minister

New Delhi, Feb. 14

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has expressed confidence that India will emerge as the third-largest global market in the aviation sector in the coming years. He said, new opportunities are emerging in the aerospace manufacturing sector under the vision of Make in India and Make for the world. He said, India can become a Maintenance, Repair, Overhaul (MRO) hub for the aviation sector. Addressing a virtual meeting with French President, Mr. Emmanuel Macron on the agreement between Air India and Airbus, Shri Modi on Tuesday said, civil aviation is



playing an instrumental role in the growth of the country. He said, the Indian aviation sector will need more than 2,000 aircrafts in the next 15 years. Terming this deal historic, Shri Modi said, this shows strengthening of strategic partnership between India and France. He said, this deal will help in fulfilling the growing demands of the aircrafts.

On the India-

France relationship, the Prime Minister said, both the countries are significantly contributing on the various issues including security and stability in the Indo-Pacific region, global food and health security. He said, India and France partnership is playing an instrumental role in ensuring stability and balance of international order and multilateral

system.

Highlighting the initiatives taken under the Regional Connectivity Scheme-UDAN, the Prime Minister said, the number of airports in the country has increased from 74 to 147 in the last eight years. He said, remote parts of the country are being connected through air connectivity which helped in socio-economic development.

French President, Mr. Emmanuel Macron congratulated India for offering an opportunity for the strategic partnership in the aerospace sector. He said his country's companies are fully dedicated to developing new areas of cooperation. He said France has achieved so much with India in various sectors including space, cyber, defence, energy transition. (Source: india.gov.in)

The Education Department has made all arrangements to monitor and ensure smooth conduct of the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) examinations for Class XII and X in A&N Islands. The AISSE (Class X) will commence with Security /

Introduction to Tourism/Beauty & Wellness/Agriculture as first paper on February 16, 2023. However, the main papers will begin from February 24, 2023 with Tamil/Telugu/Bengali. The students of AISSE (Class XII) will have Hindi paper on February 20, 2023. The Class X exam ends on

March 21, 2023 with subject Mathematics while Class XII exam ends on April 05, 2023 with subject Psychology.

This year, the number of regular candidates likely to appear in CBSE for AISSE (Class XII) is 6426 and for AISSE (Class X) it is 5734 students. Altogether 12160 regular

candidates will appear in the ensuing CBSE examination from this UT for 2022-23.

Altogether 53 Examination Centres have been identified to facilitate students of AISSE and AISSE appearing from this UT including the private candidates. Nationalized Bank / Police Station / Police

Out Post have also been identified as custodians of examination confidential materials by CBSE for safe custody. Appointment of Centre Superintendents are also being done by the Regional Officer, CBSE, Chennai to ensure free and fair conduct of these exams.

for development and prosperity. He stressed that issues like terrorism, illegal arms trade, drugs smuggling, and human trafficking pose significant security threats to the whole world. He stressed on the need for real time engagements between nations considering the increasing pace of changes being witnessed. He highlighted that today, any major change in the domain of economy, security, health and climate has global reverberations.

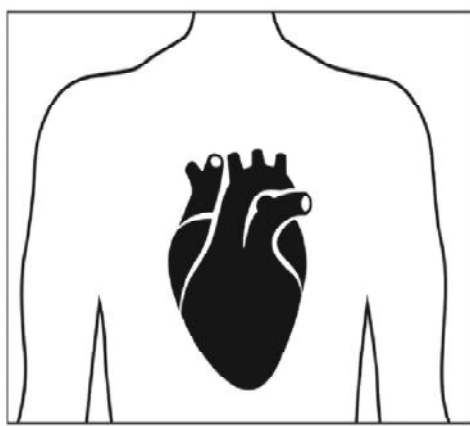

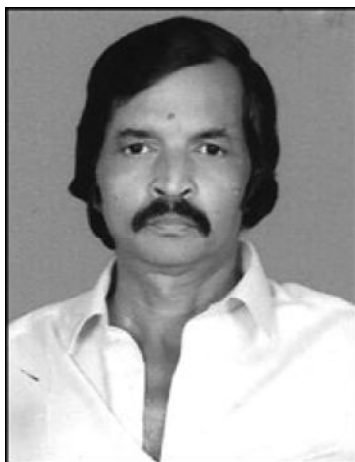
