It has been reported that certain criminal, anti-social elements or terrorists, inimical to India may pose a threat to the safety of general public, dignitaries and vital installations by the use of sub-conventional aerial platforms like para-gliders, para-motors, hand gliders, UAVs, UASs, micro light aircrafts, remotely piloted aircrafts, hot air balloons, small size powered aircrafts, Chinese Lalten, quadcopters or even by para jumping from aircraft etc.

And whereas it is necessary to take suitable security measures in this regard keeping in view the VVIP visit to A & N Islands.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, I, Veditha Reddy, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District, Andaman And Nicobar Islands, do hereby prohibit flying of sub-conventional aerial platforms like para-gliders, para-motors, hand gliders, UAVs, UASs, microlight aircrafts, remotely piloted aircrafts, hot air balloons, small size powered aircrafts, quadcopters or para jumping from aircraft etc. from 18th February till 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 in the area of Port Blair Tehsil and Swaraj Dweep in connection with the VVIP visit to these islands and doing so shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

This order shall come into force with effect from 18th February 2024 to 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2024 till the return of VVIP. It shall extend to the entire area/ jurisdiction of Port Blair Tehsil and Swaraj Dweep.

PS Kalighat apprehends bootleggers in Parangara forest

A strategy of jungle search has been adopted in N&MA District as part of zero-tolerance against bootlegging. In the recent past, several jungle search operations were carried out. The operation has yielded excellent results in recovering illicit liquor/ lehan and apprehending the offenders.

appointing BLOs creating a clear line of accountability for preparation of an error-free electoral roll, making the BLOs its custodian at the polling booth level. The preparation of accurate electoral rolls and direct distribution of voter identification slip by the BLOs also boosted voter confidence in the credibility of the election process.

BLO assists eligible citizens to become voters and obtain voter card. BLO provides those different forms for addition, deletion and correction of Electoral Roll entries, carries out physical verification, and gives his/her report to Electoral Registration Officer (ERO).The BLO interacts with local people/ political parties' representatives and identifies dead/shifted/ duplicate voters to be removed from the electoral roll after due process of law.

Within a few years of introduction of BLO system and successfully using it in successive elections, it has now become an integral part of election management process. In this UT, Booth Level Officers are appointed in all 412 Polling Stations.

The Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS has requested citizens to contact the BLOs of their respective parts and verify their name in electoral roll.
