## Chief Secretary launches 'Cyber Suraksha Sankalp Mission' and 'Case Information SMS Service' initiatives of A&N Police

### Emphasizes on importance of cyber security & role of youth in promoting cyber awareness

The Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Shri Keshav Chandra, IAS, today launched two initiatives of A&N Police viz. 'Cyber Suraksha Sankalp Mission' and 'Case Information SMS Service' in the presence of the DGP, Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, IPS, senior officers of A&N Administration, A&N Police, A&N Command, college students and others in the auditorium of TGCE. The initiatives are significant step towards strengthening cyber awareness and accessibility to law enforcement services.

Addressing the gathering on the occasion, the Chief Secretary said that the A&N Police has started a series of new initiatives under the able leadership of DGP in a very short span of time which will benefit not only the Police Department but also the entire population of A&N Islands. He further said, the 'Cyber Suraksha Sankalp Mission' is very important which will enable to deal with different kinds of cyber fraud/ crime.



The Chief Secretary stated that the advancement in the technology and internet has also increased the dangers related to it. This danger is not confined to a particular group or section but for all those who are having a smart device and they are vulnerable to it. He said, cyber fraudsters change their methods every now and then to dupe innocent citizens in one way or the other. While surfing internet and Whatsapp messages or other social media platforms, citizens have to be very

careful and should cross check the authenticity of the messages of different magnitude, the Chief Secretary added. Cautioning the people and students present in the auditorium, the Chief Secretary remarked that sometimes, the cyber crimes are so damaging that it destroys one's life. Photo sharing or video sharing has also become dangerous, as sometime people get into huge trouble, and cautioned that one should not attend unregistered video call.



The Chief Secretary further mentioned that our internet connectivity has increased and per capita internet availability is higher as compared to mainland and we have to be very cautious and alert while using the smart device to avoid cyber frauds. He urged the students present in the auditorium to disseminate the knowledge gained today through videos and skits about various modes of cyber crime among their friends and also in the society so that people do not fall prey

to cyber frauds. Concluding his speech, the Chief Secretary said that the transaction of drugs takes place in the Cyber World and cautioned the students to refrain from drugs as it not only destroys their dream, own life and career but also the whole family. He urged the students to become a good citizen by keeping themselves away from drugs and contribute their mite in nation building. In his address, the DGP, A&N Islands, expressed his

### Citizens advised to remain vigilant and report about persons filing Form '7' with malafide intentions to ERO, ANIPC

It has come to the notice of the Electoral Registration Officer (ERO), A&N Parliamentary Constituency that a large number of applications have been submitted in Form '7' for deletion of voter's name from the Electoral Roll. Upon field verification of the applications, it was observed that several applications were

made through false and bogus numbers. The applications could not be ascertained as bonafide. A serious view in the matter has been taken and a complaint has been filed to the SHO concerned to investigate the matter. Further, the Election Department has a well-defined procedure for disposal of such cases and it is being followed in letter and spirit. The

list of all such claims and objections received are being uploaded on the CEO's Portal on daily basis and also being shared with the recognized parties for greater transparency. All the voters whose names have been proposed for deletion are notified individually through format "B" notice by registered post for their

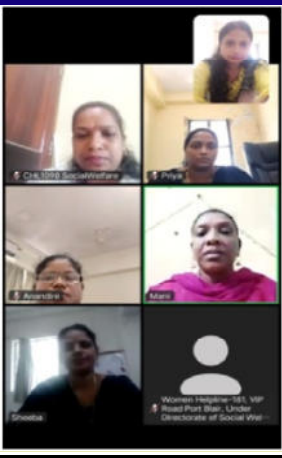

Successful confiscation of suspected venison and wild boar meat by staff of PS Ograbraj

Port Blair, Feb. 28

The diligent efforts of South Andaman Police led to the successful confiscation of suspected venison and wild boar meat in Dinghyghat at Collinpur. Acting on crucial information provided by Shri Arshdeep Singh Panwar, SDPO Bambooflat, a team swiftly assembled and conducted an operation resulting in the detention of one person namely Ashit Mondal and seizure of the suspected meat.

On 24<sup>th</sup> February, 2024, acting on this tip-

off, a team intervened at the scene where they spotted an individual, Ashit Mondal, in possession of the suspected meat. Despite attempts to conceal the meat, the diligent efforts of the team led to the recovery of two plastic buckets containing approximately 9.645 kgs of suspected venison and 4.220 kgs of suspected wild boar meat. Ashit Mondal, a fisherman residing in Collinpur, confessed to acquiring the meat from a person named Prokash of Wandoor.

Following proper protocol, the seized meat, along with the buckets and machete, were confiscated on the spot and Ashit Mondal was detained. The information was promptly relayed to the concerned Forest officials, and in their presence, the suspected meat was weighed.

The successful operation exemplifies the dedication of South Andaman Police in combating illegal wildlife trade and preserving biodiversity, a press release from SP (SA) said.

NTA to conduct CUET PG 2024 from March 11 to 28

New Delhi, Feb. 28

The National Testing Agency, NTA, will conduct the Common University Entrance Test, CUET PG 2024, from March 11 to 28 in Computer-Based Mode throughout India and in 24 cities outside India. The National Testing Agency has released the schedule for conducting examinations for 157 subjects. This time, the exam will be held in three shifts - the first shift will be conducted from 9 am to 10.45 am, the second shift will be held from 12.45 pm to

2.30 pm, and the third shift will be from 4.30 pm to 6.15 pm. Each shift will be for a 105-minute duration. Meanwhile, the NTA has also released the notification for inviting online application forms for the Common University Entrance Test, CUET UG 2024 for admission to undergraduate programs into central universities and other participating universities, institutions, organizations, and autonomous colleges.
