Union Agriculture Minister unveils LMS, Krishi Rakshak Portal, Helpline- 14447 and SARTHI Portal

Initiatives aim to empower farmers, streamline grievance redressal, and enhance agricultural training for sustainable growth: Minister

New Delhi, Feb.8 (PIB)

Union Minister of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare and Tribal Affairs Shri Arjun Munda launched the centralized 'Kisan Rakshak Helpline 14447 and Portal', Agri-Insurance Sandbox Framework Platform SARTHI and Learning Management System (LMS) Platform for the farming community under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) in Delhi today. Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare and Food Processing Sushri Shobha Karandlaje and Minister of State for Agriculture and Farmers Welfare Shri Kailash Choudhary, Secretary Shri Manoj Ahuja were also present on the occasion.

Since its inception in 2016, the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) has been a safety net for farmers in India, protecting them from the unpredictability of nature through crop insurance. It became crucial for the scheme to ensure



transparent communication and real-time resolution of grievances related to compensation delays and insurance queries.

In his address, Union Minister Shri Munda said, "India is the country of farmers. The Ministry of Agriculture is working continuously under the guidance of Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi to support and empower the farmers. Keeping this in mind, efforts are being made to increase the income of farmers and make them self-sufficient through the schemes run by the Government." He also said that the continuous efforts are being made by the Government in this direction. He said that there is an opportunity to be a partner in empowering farmers technically and digitally as well. For the same purpose, the Krishi Rakshak Portal and Helpline, Sandbox Framework and LMS Platform have been launched under the Pradhan Mantri

Member of Parliament demands Rs. 25,000 Crore Budget Boost for Andaman and Nicobar Islands

Port Blair, Feb. 8

During the discussion on Interim Budget 2024-25 in the Lok Sabha, the Member of Parliament, A&N Islands, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma mentioned that the budget for the upcoming fiscal year for A&N Islands is Rs. 5,866 crore. Allocations for Water Supply is Rs 95.47 crores, Power 666 crores, Forestry and Wildlife 37.64 crores, Medical and Public Health 118 crores, Social Welfare 78.29 crores, and Road Transport 50.05 crores. The MP requested the Govt. that the budget for



Andaman and Nicobar Islands should be increased from Rs. 5866 crore to Rs. 25,000 crores.

In order to ensure holistic development, Shri Kuldeep Rai Sharma raised the following demands:

1. To fill-up all the 10,000 vacant posts of Andaman and Nicobar Administration through the youths of the Islands and stop online recruitment.

Space cooperative documents have been signed with 61 countries: Union Minister

New Delhi, Feb 8

The Government today informed that currently, space cooperative documents have been signed with 61 countries and five multilateral bodies. In a written reply to a question in the Rajya Sabha, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Science & Technology; MoS PMO, Personnel, Public Grievances, Pensions, Atomic Energy and Space, Dr Jitendra Singh said, the major areas of cooperation are satellite remote sensing, satellite navigation, satellite communication, space

science and planetary exploration and capacity building.

Dr Jitendra Singh informed that Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) is already working with the space agency of USA (NASA) for realising a joint satellite mission, named 'NISAR (NASA ISRO Synthetic Aperture Radar)' which is in the advanced stages of realisation. ISRO is working with CNES (French National Space Agency) for realising a joint satellite mission named 'TRISHNA (Thermal Infrared Imaging Satellite for

High Resolution Natural Resource Assessment)', which is in the initial stages. ISRO and JAXA (Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency) have carried out a feasibility study to realise a joint lunar polar exploration mission.

Indian Space Policy - 2023 has been released, which provides the freedom of innovation to the private sector to pursue end-to-end activities in the space domain. Further, the India National Space Promotion and Authorisation Centre (IN-SPACe) has been
