ISRO begins New Year with successful launch of X-ray Polarimeter Satellite to study black holes and neutron stars in galaxy

Sriharikota, Jan. 1
Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has successfully launched X-ray Polarimeter Satellite (XPoSat) aboard Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle PSLV-C58. The satellite was launched from Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh at 9.10 today morning. Ten other scientific payloads were also launched along with XPoSat. This mission marks India's first dedicated scientific endeavour to study the polarisation of cosmic X-rays from celestial sources.



Following the launch of XPoSat, India has become the second country in the world after the United States to send a specialised astronomy observatory to study black holes and neutron stars in our galaxy. The mission life of the primary payload XPoSat is about five years. ISRO Chief, Shri S Somanath said, XPoSat has successfully entered

Technology, Inspecity Space Labs Private Ltd, Dhruva Space Private Ltd, Bellatrix Aerospace Private Ltd (two payloads) and three payloads from the ISRO.
As this was the first launch of the year and holiday time, the visitors gallery at the Space Centre was filled with enthusiastic crowds surpassing all ages. Children were encouraged to share their understanding of the mission of ISRO. The students were also encouraged to inspire and instill scientific temper in the minds of the future generation. ANIIMS spearheads ambitious Cataract Camp with crucial support from Ministry of Health and Family Welfare

Cataract and Eye Care Camp to begin from today

Andaman & Nicobar Islands Institute of Medical Sciences (ANIIMS), Port Blair in collaboration with the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoHFW), GoI, with the support of National Health Mission (NHM), the National Programme for Control of Blindness and Visual Impairment (NPCB&VI) and the Directorate of Health Services, A & N Islands, is set to host a Cataract and Eye Care Camp from 2nd January, 2024. This initiative, scheduled to be held during January and February, 2024 will witness the surgical correction of cataracts in more than 500 patients from all three Districts of A & N Islands with the ambitious goal of declaring A & N Islands as the first Cataract Free Union Territory in India.
The technical support for the same will be provided by 3 teams of Ophthalmologists visiting from Vardhaman Mahavir Medical College & Safdarjung Hospital (VMMC & SJH), New Delhi. With cataracts being a leading cause of avoidable blindness, this collaborative effort aims to make a substantial impact on the lives of individuals affected by this condition, a press release from ANIIMS said.

Secretary (Transport) inaugurates Road Safety Awareness Camp at Tushnabad

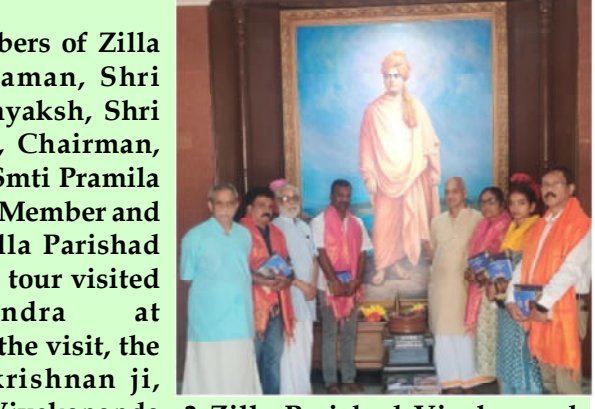
Emphasizes on the need for adhering to Road Safety Laws and Traffic Regulations to minimize road accidents

Significant amount of venison seized at
Baratang; one person arrested

Baratang, Jan.1
Information was received on Dec. 27 that a local resident of Bamboo Basthi, Baratang is in possession of significant amount of venison. As a result, a joint team was constituted consisting of Police, AAJVS, and Forest officials of Baratang. The team promptly arrived at Bamboo Basthi and initiated search operation. During the search operation, approximately 17.3 kilograms of venison was recovered in an aluminium vessel at the residence of Shri Halan Barla. The recovered venison along with the aluminium vessel was seized at the spot from the possession of accused by the Forest Department. Upon receiving the seizure intimation from the Forest Department, a case was registered at PS Baratang vide FIR No. 43/2023 dated 28/12/2023, U/s 7/8 PAT Regulation 1956. The accused, Halan Barla, S/o Late Jeevan Barla, aged about 68 years, Private Worker, R/o Bamboo Basthi, Baratang, was arrested at PS Baratang. Further investigation is under process. The general public have been requested to pass and share any credible information pertaining to any crime or illegal activities to



their nearest Police Station or over phone No.100, 112 & 03192-273344. The identity of the informers will be kept secret and will also be suitably rewarded, a press release from SP N&MA said.

Shri G. Koteswar Rao, Program Manager (SARA) highlighted about the registration process for adoption where prospective adoptive parents are required to register on the CARA website <https://carings.wcd.gov.in> and complete the online registration process.

Key Points of Adoption:

- > Online registration by Prospective Adoptive Parents (PAPs) in the CARINGS portal.
- > Handing over of relevant documents by PAPs to District Child Protection Unit for uploading it in the designated Portal.
- > Selection of Specialized Adoption Agency (SAA) by PAPs in their locality.
- > Home Study Reports (HSR) conducted by Social Worker of SAA or DCPU.
- > Based on choice and eligibility profiles on legally free children will be referred to PAPs.
- > Acceptance of the child by the PAPs and taking the child in pre-adoption.
- > Appearance of the PAPs before the District Magistrate.
- > Adoption order issued by the District Magistrate.

Smti T. Dharmila Program Officer (SARA) discuss the legal procedures and requirements associated with adoption ensuring potential adoptive parents to talk about the legal framework and also informed that, the District Child Protection Unit shall facilitate online registration of prospective adoptive parents uploading of their documents and addressing technical difficulties.

PS Rangat destroys 750 litres of lehan in
Shyamkund jungle at Bakultala



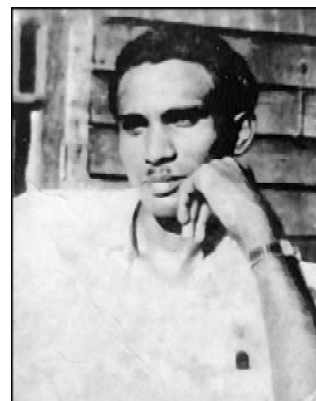
