CEO, A&N Islands holds meeting with representatives of recognized Political Parties regarding Publication of Final Electoral Roll-2024

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Electoral Officer, A&N Islands, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS, with the representatives of recognized Political Parties and media persons in connection with the publication of Final Electoral Rolls-2024 at Secretariat today. The Electoral Registration Officer, ANIPC/Joint CEO, Shri Dilkhush Meena, IAS, Deputy CEO, Shri Azharuddin Zahiruddin Quazi, IAS and Electoral related Officers were also present during the meeting.

Chairing the meeting, the CEO said, that Election Department, A&N Islands is committed towards conducting elections in A&N Islands in a free, fair and transparent manner. Sharing the details of the Final Electoral Rolls-2024, the CEO informed that as per the Final



Electoral Rolls number of voters is 3,11,802 and there is a net addition of 4447 electors in the Final Electoral Roll - 2024. As per the Final Electoral Roll - 2024, the number of Male voter is 1,62,389 and Female voter is 1,49,410 while the number of Third Gender voter is 3, the CEO said adding that the number of Young Voters (18-19 years) is 4,472 as per the Final Electoral Roll - 2024.

The Chief Electoral Officer also urged the Political Parties representatives to appoint Booth Level Agents (BLAs) and help in identifying any missed out eligible voters besides encouraging eligible citizens who is going to attain the age of eighteen years as the inclusion of eligible voters is a continuous

process. Before publication of the Final Rolls, the list of claims & objections received during SSR-2024 was also shared with the Political Parties on weekly basis in Form-9, Form-10, Form-11 & Form-11b, the CEO added.

The CEO further requested the Political Parties to help the Election Department in increasing the voting percentage in A&N Islands by motivating the eligible voters and creating awareness among them to participate in the election process. The voters should feel empowered as they are electing their representative, the CEO said adding that Election Department will also conduct voter awareness campaign to motivate voters to exercise their franchise during the ensuing Parliamentary Election - 2024.

The South Andaman District Police has concluded the year 2023 with exceptional accomplishments, underscoring its commitment to public safety, crime resolution, and community engagement, said the Superintendent of Police, South Andaman, Shri Kalaivanan R, IPS, addressing the press conference held today at the SP's Office. He said, the Department's annual report reveals an impressive track record in crime detection, law enforcement, and proactive community



outreach. Informing about the key achievements of the A&N Police in the year 2023, the SP (SA), said, the District Police has registered an outstanding crime detection rates. Out of 1109 cases, 1038 cases have been worked out, achieving a remarkable 94% detection rate. The

protecting the vulnerable members of society.

The District Police also displayed their efficiency in effectively handling the Narcotics, Excise and Wild Life Crime Cases, said the SP adding that 29 NDPS cases were registered, leading to the arrest of 42 individuals and substantial seizures, including 20.255 kg of Ganja, 242.494 kg of Methamphetamine, and 10 Cannabis plants. 555 excise cases were registered which resulted in the arrest of 556 persons and significant seizures, such as 2652.49 litres of IMFL, 56.5 litres of illicit liquor and 1109 kg of handia. Apart from that, 10305 litres of premature liquor wash (Lehan) were also destroyed, thus, reinforcing the commitment to curbing illegal substances. 733.29 Kgs of Venison, 3.85 Kgs of Monitor Lizard meat and 16.68 Kgs of Wild Boar meat were also seized with respect to wildlife crime.

The SP further disclosed that pertaining to Traffic Regulation and Enforcement, the District Police rigorously enforced traffic regulations by issuing 15,394 challans and collecting fines amounting to Rs. 90,38,200. 1,287 individuals were booked for drunken driving, emphasizing a zero-tolerance approach to road safety. With regard to legal proceedings, 10,288 summons were received and 8,725 of them were served. 2249 warrants were received and 1,731 warrants were executed, ensuring the swift and effective administration of justice.

With regard to Law and Order, the District Police has displayed excellent performance in maintaining Law & Order, ensuring peace and security in the District, said the SP adding that VIP arrangements were seamlessly executed and flawless security were provided during VVIP visit as well as the recently concluded ITF.

He further informed that the District Police is not only confined to maintaining law & order, but has also taken up community engagement. In the year 2023, 615 awareness programs were conducted, covering critical issues such as POC SO awareness, Cybercrime prevention, and drug awareness besides facilitating 109 community interactions, thereby fostering positive relationships through meetings with senior citizens, PRI members, and Fishermen watch groups. Apart from this, to facilitate tourists visiting the Islands, a Tourist Police Kiosk was also set up near the National Memorial Cellular Jail to facilitate tourists coming to the historic site and to provide assistance to them. In addition, Project AASHA - an anti-suicide initiative was also launched to provide counseling and to improve mental well being of the citizens, the SP remarked.

Concluding the press conference, the SP South Andaman, said, the District Police remain committed to ensuring the safety of the residents, solving crimes, and engaging with the community to build trust and cooperation. The success of such measure is a result of the hard work and dedication of all the Officers and the support of the community. He also lauded all the Officers for their unwavering commitment to provide a safe and secure environment to the citizens of the Islands and urged them to continue to work with the same vigor and commitment, this year too.

6. **SAVINGS:**
Nothing in these rules shall effect reservation, relaxation of age limit any other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste, Schedules Tribe and other specified categories of persons in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

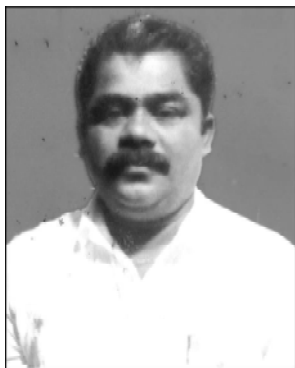

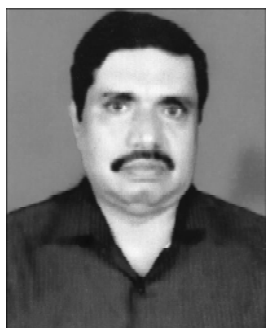

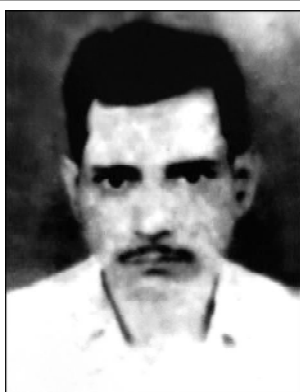
