

Thousands of Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra beneficiaries from across the country will join the event

New Delhi, Jan. 7 (PIB)

Two more Myanmar Poachers apprehended by joint anti-poaching team; 10 Poachers apprehended so far

Katchal, Jan. 7

On 27/12/23, two vigilant fishermen reported the presence of foreign nationals in the West Bay area of Katchal. In response, the anti-poaching team from PS Katchal promptly mobilized on 28/12/23. The operation resulted in the apprehension of 06 Myanmar Poachers on 28/12/2023, while few managed to evade capture within the dense jungle area. During intensive combing operation 02 more poachers were



apprehended on 30/12/2023.

Recognizing the gravity of the situation, a joint anti-poaching operation was formed, comprising personnel from the Police, IRBn, PMF, and the Andaman Nicobar

Command. The Unified Force established a camp near Intona of the South Bay area. Following this success, on 30/12/23, a local resident of MRN Village, Katchal, reported observing 02 poachers approaching

the Village area. In a swift response, the Police party apprehended these 02 Myanmar Poachers, ensuring the safety of the local community. Again, on 06/01/24 evening hours, 02 more poachers were apprehended by the vigilant anti-poaching team. With this apprehension, a total of 10 Myanmar poachers have been apprehended so far.

Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana implemented in Isles by Social Welfare Department

Port Blair, Jan. 7

The Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY) was launched on January 1, 2017 and is being implemented by the Ministry of Women and Child Development. This scheme is a maternity benefit program run by the Government of India. It is a conditional cash transfer scheme for pregnant and lactating women of 19 years of age or above for the first two living birth.



The objective of the PMMVY is to provide cash incentive for partial compensation for the wage loss, so that the women can take adequate rest before and after delivery of the first child, and to improve health seeking behaviour amongst the Pregnant Women & Lactating Mothers (PW&LM). The scheme also seeks to promote positive behavioral change towards girl child by providing additional cash incentive for the

second child, if that is a girl child. The benefit is available to a woman for the first two living children provided the second child is a girl. In case of the first child, the amount of Rs. 5000/- in two installments and for the second child, the benefit of Rs. 6000/- will be provided subject to second child is a girl in one installment after the birth. However, for availing benefits for second child, registration during

pregnancy shall be mandatory. This would contribute to improve the Sex Ratio at birth and to prevent female foeticide.

Further, all Pregnant Women and Lactating Mothers, in regular employment with the Central Government or the State Governments or PSUs or those who are in receipt of similar benefits under any law for the time being in force shall not be entitled to benefits under PMMVY.

Benefits can be availed only on the basis of the Aadhaar Number of Beneficiary so as to avoid any duplication or malpractices.

Cash incentives in two installments are provided as per the schedule in the table below:

Conditonalities and Installments

First Installment	On registration of pregnancy and at least one Ante-natal check-up within 6 month from LMP date at the Anganwadi Centre (AWC)/ approved Health facilities may be identified by the respective administering State/UT.	3,000/-
Second Installment	Child Birth is registered. Child has received first cycle of BCG, OPV, DPT and Hepatitis-B or its equivalent /substitute.	2,000/-

In case of miscarriage/still birth, the beneficiaries would be treated as fresh beneficiary in the event of any future pregnancy.

The Social Welfare Department is instrumental in implementing the Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana in these Islands. The number of beneficiaries enrolled since the inception of Scheme to till date is 9472, a press release from Programme Officer (ICDS) said.

A&N Police issues advisory on Telegram hijacking

Instant Messaging (IM) Apps have become popular medium of communication among individuals. Fraudsters have targeted the app users and have managed to devise ways and means to take over or hijack their IM accounts to commit cyber offences by impersonating them. Users need to be aware and alert about these frauds with necessary safety measures against the same. In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens against Telegram Hijacking:

- > Make your phone number private.
- > Never share verification codes with anyone, even if you know them.
- > Beware of unusual

requests received over Telegram or other messaging apps.

- > Turn off notification preview for SMS.
- > Anyone who can see the verification code on your phone can easily hijack your account.
- > Enable "Two-Step Verification" for your Telegram account.
- > Log out of Telegram web/ desktop when you finish using it.
- > If your Telegram account has been hijacked inform your family and friends that your account has been hacked, and they should not respond to

any Telegram messages that appear to be from you.

- > Warn others not to share their verification codes or any other confidential information.
- > Report to Telegram regarding your stolen account "https://telegram.org/support".

PS Rangat destroys 900 litres of lehan in dense forest of Kalsi village

In a swift and efficient operation carried out on Jan.5, the Rangat Police once again demonstrated their commitment to combating illegal activities by successfully confiscating a significant quantity of Lehan in the dense forest of Kalsi village. 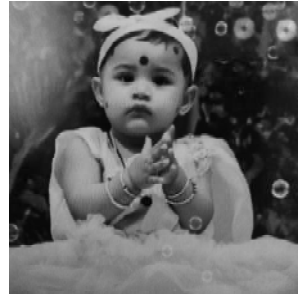
