PBMC to organize camp for profiling of Sewerage and Septic Tank Workers under 'NAMASTE Scheme' on Jan. 16 & 18

Port Blair, Jan. 8

The Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act (PEMSR), 2013 prohibits manual scavenging and hazardous cleaning of sewers and septic tanks. It is evident that identifying the sanitation workers and connecting them with entitlements has been a challenge as there is a lack of survey database. Hence, it is important to create a national evidence base of sanitation workers to link workers and

their families with NAMASTE scheme benefits. National Action for Mechanized Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE) is a central sector scheme jointly implemented by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment (MoSJE) and the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA). The scheme aims to bring the transition across all cities from manhole to machine hole through 100% mechanization of sewer and septic tank cleaning operations.

The scheme aims to create a comprehensive digital database of SSWs employed by ULBs, Parastatal agencies, Private Sanitation Service Organizations (PSSOs) and other private operators. This database will facilitate the provision of support, skill-building, and access to social and financial benefits for SSWs and their dependents. To implement the Scheme, Port Blair Municipal Council will be organizing two days camp in co-ordination with the

Kayakalp - Promoting Cleanliness, Hygiene and Infection Control Practices in Public Health Care Facilities

ANIIMS formulates Sanitation, Hygiene, Infection Control Policy for G B Pant Hospital

Port Blair, Jan. 8

Kayakalp guidelines, framed by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, GoI are being adopted by G B Pant Hospital for sanitation, house keeping, infection control, general maintenance, waste management, and support services etc. The hospital has undergone two peer assessment rounds and the third round of assessment by representatives from MoHFW will take place in next one week. This initiative

has been taken not only to improve the overall ambience of the institution but also to prevent Health Care Associated Infection (HCAI) that are most common complications of health care management and contribute significantly to increased duration of hospital stay along with morbidity and mortality among patients. Thus, to monitor and improve practices, identify risks and proactively establish policies to

prevent the spread of infections in GBPH, ANIIMS has set up Hospital Infection Control Committee (HICC) and formulated the Hospital Infection Control Program (HICP). The guidelines under this program aim to reduce the probability of cross infections among patients, decreased length of stay after surgery and ensure safe care to newborn babies and their mothers. It is thus necessary for all the staff and patients in

GBPH to strictly adhere to these guidelines. Patients have been requested not to bring more than one attendant to take care in the hospital while admitted in the wards. The attendants should strictly follow the instructions regarding smoking/tobacco consumption, no sharing of bed with the patient and no spitting in the hospital premises. For the patients admitted in the critical areas

(ICU/CCU/NICU/PICUs/Operation Theatre, Post Operative area), only one attendant will be allowed inside the area, with all precautions, after permission of the sister in-charge of that area. However, they can wait in the waiting area and can see their relative/patient. The visiting hours for admitted patients, fixed for the attendants need to be strictly adhered to, a press release from ANIIMS said.

generations to not have to live the life that the earlier generation lived. We want to get a large population of the country out of the struggle for small daily needs. Therefore, we are focusing on the future of the poor, farmers, women and youth. For us, these are the four biggest castes of the country. When the poor, farmers, women and youth are empowered, the country will become powerful."

The Prime Minister reiterated the chief goal of VBSY is not to leave any deserving beneficiary from the benefits of the Government schemes. He informed that since the Yatra began, 12 lakh new applications for Ujjwala connections were received along with lakhs of applications for Suraksha Bima Yojana, Jeevan Jyoti Yojana, PM SVANidhi.

Throwing light on the impact of VBSY, the Prime Minister informed that health checkups for more than 2 crore people have been carried out so far including 1 crore TB checkups and 22 lakh sickle cell checkups. Today, the Prime Minister said that the doctors are reaching the doorsteps of the poor, Dalits, deprived and the tribals. 
