In order to facilitate the citizens to access all

The portal is intended to act as a single window interface for all the services offered by various Government Departments, institutions and organizations. Services offered by various Government Departments

are now served by various applications and software and this portal brings together all those with minimum applications under a common umbrella. Individual web applications can be accessed from this portal for availing the particular services offered by them. Further, to facilitate the citizens to submit their grievances, the Department of IT with the assistance of SOVTECH developed Mobile App AN Seva 311. The Mobile App will enable citizens to submit their grievances with minimum information and has the facility to upload the photos, videos along with the grievances. SDM South Andaman holds meeting with stakeholders of Central Ground Water Authority. Member of ACCI & Hoteliers Association Permission for operation of bore wells & dug wells for Commercial/ Industrial purposes needs to be obtained

Port Blair, Jan. 10
Shri Vinayak Chamadia, IAS, Sub-Divisional Magistrate South Andaman, held a meeting with stakeholders of Central Ground Water Authority, Member of ACCI and Hoteliers Association in South Andaman District today. SDM, SA emphasized that during summers, illegal ground water extraction add to the water crises.

Sub-Divisional Magistrate South Andaman, apprised ACCI and Hoteliers Association regarding the requirement of obtaining permission for operation of bore wells and dug wells for Commercial/ Industrial purposes. Any

organization extracting water above 10 KLD has to obtain No Objection Certificate from CGWA and those extracting below 10 KLD must obtain exempt category status from CGWA. Every Commercial and Industrial organization extracting water must install the Tamper Proof Digital Water Meter.

It was decided that all hotels and other such organizations must get the NOCs or exemption status before 31st January, 2024.

It was also reiterated that all bulk water suppliers must adhere to CGWA guidelines, otherwise strict penalties would be imposed as per law, a press release from SDM (SA) said.

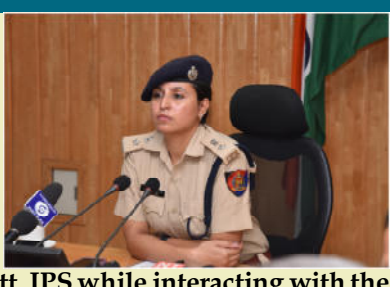
