

Centre's new guidelines bar Coaching Centres from enrolling students below 16 years of age

New Delhi, Jan. 19

Ministry of Education has issued 'Regulation of Coaching Centers 2024' Guidelines, saying that no Coaching Center shall enroll students below 16 years of age. The Guidelines stressed that student enrolment should be done only after Secondary School Examination. Coaching Centres have been directed not to make misleading promises or guarantee of rank or good marks to parents and students. Education Ministry said, these guidelines prioritize mental well-being, fair

practices, and inclusivity. The guidelines stressed the need for State and UT Governments to regulate these centers and refer to legal actions, such as the PIL in the Supreme Court and letters sent to States and UTs. Fair and reasonable fee, a proper Grievance Redressal System and infrastructure requirements are some of the rules Coaching Centres must follow. The Guidelines also proposes a model framework for Coaching Centers and outlines the procedures for registration, renewal, and cancellation of Coaching Center

Certificates, along with an appeal process. Coaching Centres cannot engage tutors who do not have qualifications less than the graduation level. The Guidelines stated that the number of unregulated private Coaching Centers in the country continues to grow in the absence of any laid down policy or regulation. There are instances of such centers charging exorbitant fees from students, causing undue stress on students resulting in students committing suicides. (Source: india.gov.in)

Govt. directs all schools and higher education institutions to provide study material for every course in Indian languages digitally within the next three years

New Delhi, Jan. 19 (PIB)

In a decision aimed at providing students with the opportunity to study in their own language, the Government of India has decided that study material for all courses under school and higher education will be made available digitally in Indian languages included in the 8th Schedule of the Constitution. In an order issued by the Ministry of Education today, the Government has directed all schools and higher education regulators like UGC, AICTE, NCERT, NIOS, IGNOU and heads of INIs like IITs, CUs and NITs to make study material in Indian languages available for all courses in the next three years. UGC, AICTE and the Department of School

Education have also been asked to take up the issue with regard to State Schools and universities. The above directions emerge from the recommendations of the National Education Policy for promoting multilingualism in education at every level, so that students get the opportunity to study in their own language, and can have better learning outcomes. Studying in ones own language can provide a student the natural space to think innovatively without any language barrier. The NEP-2020 strongly conveys the idea that multilingual nature of Bharat is its huge asset and strength which needs to be utilized efficiently for the socio-cultural, economic and educational

development of the Nation. Content creation in local languages will boost this multilingual asset and pave way for its better contribution to 'Viksit Bharat' to make our country as developed nation by 2047. The Government has already been working in this direction during the past two years, with translation of Engineering, Medical, Law, UG, PG and Skill books being done through the Anuvadini AI based App. These books are available on the ekumbh portal. In school education ecosystem also study material is available in multiple Indian languages including over 30 languages on DIKSHA. Competitive exams like JEE, NEET, CUET are being held in 13 Indian languages.


facilitate the commuters of

Hit and run case: PS Aberdeen arrest accused within 24 hours

Port Blair, Jan. 19

The Aberdeen Police Station's dedicated team successfully cracked a challenging hit-and-run case through meticulous investigative work, leading to the apprehension of the Royal Enfield Himalayan motorcycle rider. The incident occurred on 17.01.2024, when the suspect fled the scene after colliding with a pedestrian near the SBI ATM, close to the RTO Office.

In the evening of 17.01.2024, the Aberdeen Police Station received information regarding an incident in which an unidentified Royal Enfield rider recklessly hit a pedestrian in front of the SBI ATM near the Regional Transport Office in Port Blair around 18:15 hours. The rider hastily fled the scene with the motorcycle after committing the crime. Promptly, an autorickshaw driver evacuated the injured person to G.B Pant Hospital, where, unfortunately, the

victim was declared brought dead after examination.

In response to this tragic event, an FIR dated 17/01/2024, U/s 279/304(A) IPC r.w.s 134(A)/187 MV Act was swiftly registered at Police Station Aberdeen and the investigation into the matter was entrusted to SI Nixon Isaac. A dedicated team comprising of SI Nixon Isaac, SI P. Jeevan and others conducted a thorough search for the accused and the involved motorcycle. The team members displayed utmost professionalism as they meticulously reviewed numerous CCTV footages in the surrounding areas. Through their thorough investigation, they conclusively identified the involved motorcycle as a Royal Enfield. Subsequently, the team secured detailed information on the registered owners of all Royal Enfield motorcycles in the South Andaman District. In addition to this, team

members systematically inspected various garages and workshops. Owners were earnestly requested to promptly inform the authorities of any Royal Enfield motorcycles brought in for repair.

As a result, on the morning of 18.01.2024, a crucial breakthrough emerged, when the Manager of Royal Enfield reported to the team that an individual had brought a Royal Enfield for repair. Acting swiftly, the team intercepted the accused and initiated a thorough interrogation. During questioning, the individual confessed to the crime and was subsequently arrested and the Royal Enfield with registration number AN01 S 9898 was seized. The collaborative efforts of the team along with the information from the vigilant Manager of Royal Enfield, played a pivotal role in swiftly resolving the case and bringing the perpetrator to justice, a press release from SP (SA) said.
