Night Collection of waste for Commercial/ Industrial & Institutional establishments by PBMC to begin from Feb.1

Segregation of waste into dry & wet categories made mandatory

Port Blair, Jan. 30

In a significant operational shift, the Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) has notified all Commercial, Institutional, and Industrial Establishments in Port Blair regarding the waste collection during night collection by the Sanitation Wing of the Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) starting from February 1, 2024, replacing the existing process handled by the Self Help Group.

This aligns with the Solid Waste (Handling and Management) Bye Laws, 2017 of the Port Blair Municipal Council, emphasizing a collaborative approach to waste management. Industrial Establishments in Port Blair regarding the waste collection during night collection by the Sanitation Wing of the Port Blair Municipal Council (PBMC) starting from February 1, 2024, replacing the existing process handled by the Self Help Group.

It is now mandatory for Commercial, Institutional, and Industrial Establishments to segregate waste into Dry and Wet categories. Additionally, establishments are required to process organic waste at the source, handing over only dry recyclables to PBMC's Staff during the daily waste collection, in adherence to the PBMC -Solid Wastes (Handling and Management) Bye-Laws, 2017. Failure to adhere to these regulations will result in necessary penalties.

Advance distribution of PDS foodgrains for the month of Feb. & March

Port Blair, Jan. 30

The foodgrains shall be distributed in advance for 2 months for February, 2024 & March, 2024 in one go in the entire UT in the month of February, 2024. All the Ration Card holders have been informed that they can purchase the foodgrains as per their entitlement for 2 months in February, 2024.

The subsidized sugar will also be distributed to all NFSA households i.e. PHH & AAY @ 1 Kg per card/per month for twelve months (April, 2023 to March, 2024) in one go @ Rs. 30/- (PHH) & Rs. 15/- (AAY) per kg w.e.f. 1st February, 2024 onwards.

All such Ration Card holders have been asked to draw the foodgrains as per their entitlement for 2 months in one go between 1st February, 2024 & 31st March, 2024. However, the Ration Card Holders who are not able to lift the ration in the month of February, 2024 can also lift their foodgrains in the month of March, 2024, a press release from Deptt. of CS&CA said.

required documents.

> **Name correction or deletion from the electoral roll:** If there are any errors in your voter registration details, you can apply for name correction or deletion online through the VSP. You will need to provide your EPIC number, as well as the correct information.

> **Application for a duplicate EPIC:** If you have lost your EPIC, you can apply for a duplicate one online through the VSP. You will need to provide your EPIC number or your basic information, such as your name, date of birth, and address.

> **Marking of PwD:** The VSP also provides the feature to mark the existing voter as PwD to avail various services to its doorstep. The elector needs to provide their EPIC number and apply a form 8.

> **Download of e-EPIC:** You can download a digital copy of your EPIC (e-EPIC) online through the VSP. This is a convenient way to have your EPIC with you at all times.

> **Search for polling station and BLO details:** You can search for your polling station and BLO details online through the VSP. This information is important to know so that you can cast your vote in the upcoming elections.

> **Tracking of application status:** You can track the status of your voter registration application, name correction or deletion application, or duplicate EPIC application online through the VSP. This is a convenient way to know the progress of your application.
