

Moreover, gross violations may lead to the disconnection of water supply and the temporary suspension of the establishment, in accordance with applicable laws.

Furthermore, in accordance with the Bye-Laws, the PBMC will now facilitate the monthly user fee collection through Point of Sale (POS) machines. These machines have been issued for each Ward, following the classified schedule-III for monthly user fees applicable to shops, establishments, institutions, and bulk waste generators.




