Prime Minister to participate in the Pran Pratishtha ceremony of Shri Ramlalla in the newly built Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Mandir in Ayodhya today

PM to visit Kuber Tila, where the ancient Mandir of Bhagwan Shiv has been restored

Pran Pratishtha ceremony to be attended by representatives of all major spiritual and religious sects of the country

New Delhi, Jan. 21 (PIB)

Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi will participate in Pran Pratishtha (consecration) ceremony of Shri Ramlalla in the newly built Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Mandir in Ayodhya at around 12 noon tomorrow (22nd January, 2024). Earlier in October, 2023, Prime Minister had received the invitation from Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Trust for the Pran Pratishtha ceremony.

The historic Pran Pratishtha ceremony will be attended by representatives of all major spiritual and religious sects of the country. People from all walks of life including representatives of various tribal communities will also attend the ceremony. Prime Minister will address this distinguished gathering on the occasion.

Prime Minister will interact with Shramjeevis associated with the construction of Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Mandir. Prime Minister will also visit the Kuber Tila, where the ancient Mandir of Bhagwan Shiv has been restored. He will also perform Pooja and Darshan at this restored temple.

The magnificent Shri Ram Janmbhoomi Mandir is constructed in traditional Nagara



style. Its length (east-west) is 380 feet; width 250 feet and height is 161 feet; and is supported by a total of 392 pillars and 44

doors. The pillars and walls of the temple showcase intricately sculpted depictions of Hindu deities, gods, and goddesses. In the main sanctum sanctorum at ground floor, the childhood form of Bhagwan Shri Ram (the idol of Shri Ramlalla) has been placed.

The main entrance to the Mandir is situated on the eastern side, which can be approached by ascending 32 stairs through the Singh Dwar. There are a total of five Mandaps (Halls) in the Mandir - Nritya Mandap, Rang Mandap, Sabha Mandap, Prathana Mandap and Kirtan Mandap. Near the Mandir is a historic Well (Sita koop), dating back to the ancient era. In the southwestern part of the Mandir complex, at Kuber Tila, the ancient Mandir of Bhagwan Shiv has been restored, along with the installation of a statue of Jatayu.

The foundation of the Mandir has been constructed with a 14-meter- thick layer of roller-compacted concrete (RCC), giving it the appearance of artificial rock. No iron is used anywhere in the Mandir. For protection against ground moisture, a 21-foot-high plinth has been constructed using granite. The Mandir complex has a sewage treatment plant, water treatment plant, water supply for fire safety and an independent power station. The Mandir has been constructed employing the country's traditional and indigenous technology.

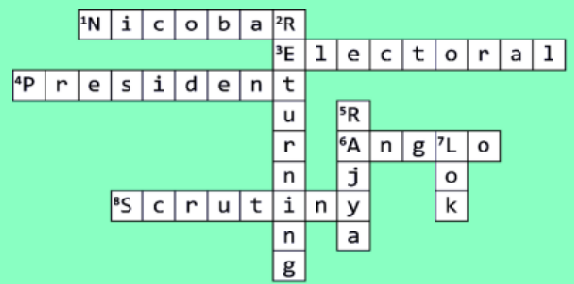

careers through entrepreneurship.

RSETI imparts comprehensive quality on residential training programme in personality and skill development to rural youth free of cost and facilitating them in settlement. RSETI has so far trained 6037 youth since its inception in the year 2008. Out of the total candidates trained, 73 percent of them (cumulative) have become successful entrepreneurs. A total number of 2577 male and 3460 female candidates were trained in different EDP training programmes since inception of the RSETI in these Islands. RSETI programme which is a three-way partnership between the Rural Development Ministry, State Governments and sponsor banks, the Entrepreneurship Development Programmes are organized in different sectors i.e. Agriculture, product, process and general EDPs. Under Agriculture, EDP trainings are imparted for vegetable nursery management & cultivation, Mushroom Cultivation. Under product, EDP trainings are imparted for women tailoring and



papad, pickle & masala powder making. Similarly, in the process, EDP training are imparted in beauty parlour management, Fast Food Stall Udyami. The duration of training ranges from 10 days to 30 days. Free lunch, tea & training materials are also provided during the training. The training includes interaction sessions, games, motivational videos; communication skills market survey etc which all is necessary for a successful entrepreneur. RSETI in collaboration with the Rural Development Department was able to reach out to the remote islands and was able to train SHG members in Rangat, Mayabunder, Diglipur in off campus trainings since 2020. RSETI conducts awareness camps at the remote villages to sensitize the rural youth the importance of being self employed. RSETI is working as an agent for transforming the unskilled, unemployed and underprivileged youth. New Training Programme was also organized in Mushroom Cultivation and Fast Food Stall Udyami.
