75th Republic Day to be celebrated in A&N Islands today

Hon'ble Lt. Governor to unfurl the National Flag at Marina Park road stretch

Port Blair, Jan. 25 Together with the rest of the country the 75th Republic Day will be celebrated in A&N Islands tomorrow (Jan. 26). The Republic Day is celebrated with grandeur every year with ceremonious Parade. This year, in A&N Islands, the main function for the Republic Day will be held at Marina Park road stretch on Jan. 26.

As per the minute to minute programme

chalked out for the Republic Day-2024, Admiral D. K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, will unfurl the National Tricolor at 8.37 am followed by fly past by helicopter carrying National Flag. Thereafter, there will be presentation of medals, gallantry awards & distribution of LG's

Commendation Certificates by Hon'ble Lt. Governor. Soon after the presentation of awards, Hon'ble Lt. Governor will address the Islanders.

Before arriving at the main function, Hon'ble Lt. Governor will visit National Memorial Cellular Jail and place wreath at the 'Martyr's Column' there.

The main attraction of the Republic Day is the march past in which the contingents of Defence Forces, Police, NCC contingents, School (Boys & Girls) will participate. Apart from the Tableaux Departments, the highlight of this year's Republic Day celebration will be a 'Dare Devil Bike Show' by IRBn. Cultural programme by school children will add grandeur to the Republic Day function at Marina Park road which will conclude with the National Anthem.

Criminal Procedure, 1973, Smti Veditha Reddy, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman District, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, has prohibited the flying of sub-conventional aerial platforms like para-gliders, paramotors, hand gliders, UAVs, UAS, micro-light aircrafts, remotely piloted aircrafts, hot air balloons, small size powered aircrafts, quadcopters or para jumping from aircraft etc. from 26th January till 29th January, 2024 upto 1900 hrs in the area of Port Blair Tehsil due to Republic Day Celebrations-2024 and doing so shall be punishable under section 188 of the Indian Penal Code.

The order to this effect issued by DM (SA) has come into force with immediate effect and shall remain in force upto 29th January, 2024 till the completion of celebration of Republic Day -2024. It shall extend to the entire area/ jurisdiction of Port Blair Tehsil.


