Union WCD Minister inaugurates Regional Symposium on Child Protection, Safety and Child Welfare

Programme focussed on amendments in Juvenile Justice Act and its impact on adoption process

Series of regional symposiums to be held across the country to raise awareness & outreach about child protection, safety and welfare issues

New Delhi, July 2 (PIB)

The Ministry of Women and Child Development (MWCD), Government of India organized a one day Regional Symposium on Child Protection, Safety and Child Welfare today at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. There were nine participating States of Himachal Pradesh, Punjab, Haryana, Uttarakhand, Uttar Pradesh and UTs of Delhi, Chandigarh, Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh. The Symposium was attended by more than 2000 representatives from Child Welfare Committees (CWCs), Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs), Members of Village Child Protection Committee (VCPC) and Anganwadi Workers. The programme is the start of a series of regional symposiums to be held across the country to raise awareness and outreach about child protection, safety



and welfare issues.

The Symposium was graced by Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani, Union Minister for Women and Child Development, Government of India.

The focus of the programme was on the Amendments in the Juvenile Justice Act, Rules. It's impact on adoption processes was highlighted by

experience sharing by Prospective Adoptive Parents who received quick resolution post the Amendment in September, 2022. An online Training Module on the JJ Act, developed by the MWCD in collaboration with the LBSNAA, Mussoorie was inaugurated and launched on the Karmayogi Igot platform aimed at sensitization and capacity building of all functionaries who need to be aware of the provisions for child safety, protection and welfare right up to the village level.

Union Minister, MoWCD, Smt. Smriti Zubin Irani, highlighted how in 9 years, 7 lakh children have been aided across the country with the help of CCIs. Further, she stated that about 3 lakh children, who were declared

Online registration on CARINGS mandatory to adopt a child

Port Blair, July 2

Children are the supreme asset & the most precious treasure of every nation. India has the largest child population in the world. Although Constitution of India guarantees several rights to the children, but still there are children who are neglected and abandoned by their parents, who are vulnerable to child abuse, trafficking, forced labour etc at a very tender age. Adoption is the suitable resort for their secured life.

Through the process of adoption, an individual/couple assumes parental rights of a child, who is not biologically his/her kid, and the child so becomes the



legitimate child of his adoptive parents. It is now mandatory to register online on CARINGS to adopt a child. One can adopt a child only through submission of online application available at www.cara.nic.in and following the procedures provided in the Adoption Regulations.

As per the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection for Children) Act, the State Government shall recognise one or more institutions in

each district as a Specialised Adoption Agency (SAA). It must be a registered Child Care Institution run for housing orphan, abandoned and surrendered children who are placed by the order of Child Welfare Committee for the purpose of adoption.

SAA is mandated to furnish report regarding all cases of a d m i s s i o n s, restorations, transfers, death and adoption of

- The Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) in the category of blindness, Locomotor Disability (Both Arms Affected - BA) and Cerebral Palsy are provided the facility of Scribe, if desired by the person. In case of other category of person with Benchmark Disabilities as defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe is allowed to such candidates on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write, and scribe is essential to write examination on behalf, from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care institution in the prescribed proforma.
- The candidates have discretion of opting for his/her own scribe or request the R & E Cell of A&N Administration, Secretariat to provide for the same. However, the qualification of the scribe should be below Matriculate.
- The Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) in the category of blindness, Locomotor Disability (Both Arms Affected - BA) and Cerebral Palsy are allowed additional Compensatory Time of Twenty minutes per hour of the examination. In case of other PwBD categories, this facility is provided on production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write from the Chief Medical Officer/Civil Surgeon/Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care institution in the prescribed proforma, a press release from Special Secretary (Personnel) said.

StartUps Intellectual Property Rights Protection is aimed at promoting innovation and entrepreneurship: Science & Technology Minister

New Delhi, July 2 (PIB)

Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Science and Technology, MoS PMO, Department of Atomic Energy and Department of Space and MoS Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Dr Jitendra Singh has said that "StartUps Intellectual Property Rights Protection" is aimed at promoting innovation and entrepreneurship.

In his inaugural address at the 'National Intellectual Property Festival', organised by the CSIR at the National Physical Laboratory in New Delhi, Dr Jitendra Singh said, the filing of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) including Patents and Trademark by StartUps, along with Industry linkages will encourage innovation and motivate enterprise in India. Under the leadership of Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, after the Government came up with the IPR Act in 2016, the T r a d e m a r k Registration process has come down to one month, which was more than one year earlier, he said.

"Soon after this, 'StartUps Intellectual Property Rights Protection' scheme



was brought in, which envisages 80% rebate in patent filing and 40%-50% rebate vis-à-vis the Industry and the companies," the Minister said.

Dr Jitendra Singh said, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi has launched several schemes which supplement each other to reinforce the StartUp ecosystem and their Capacity Building. "You can couple the StartUps, eg. you have the Mudra scheme, which offers you a loan of 10-20 lakhs without any gratuity, mortgage, almost interest free," he said.

Pertinent to mention that with the vision to protect IPRs for StartUps, the Government has launched a scheme, Startups Intellectual Property Protection (SIPP) for encouraging innovation and creativity of Startups. The startups are given an 80% rebate on Patent filing fees and a facility for expedited examination of patent applications. Under the new Trademark Rules, Startups have been given a 50% rebate in filing fees

"Today, we are equal partners with other nations in technology application. In Quantum Computing, for example, we are in the same league as the developed world," he said.

Every Specialised Adoption Agency (SAA) shall treat biological parents of a surrendered child with respect and dignity throughout the surrender process. It must also maintain confidentiality of unmarried mother and biological parents. Presently, in A & N Islands, Pranab Kanya Sangha, a registered CCI, situated at AIR Road, Port Blair, is the only registered Specialised Adoption Agency (SAA). The SAA under the Directorate of Social Welfare is functioning as an adoption agency for the purpose of placing children in adoption.

Two-time champions West Indies fail to qualify for ICC World Cup 2023

New Delhi, July 2

Two-time champions West Indies failed to qualify for the 2023 ODI World Cup in India after suffering a shock seven-wicket defeat against Scotland in a Super Six match of the qualifier in Harare on 1st July 2023, Saturday. West Indies needed a win against the Scots to


keep their slim qualification hopes alive but were bowled out for 181. Riding on Matthew Cross and Brandon McMullen knocks, Scotland chased down the target with 6.3 overs to spare. The champions of the 1975 and 1979 editions, this is the first time in the 48 years of tournament history that West

Indies won't feature among the top 10 teams in limited-overs cricket. It was also Scotland's first-ever win over the Caribbean side in the ODIs. With two more matches left, even if West Indies win, they can reach up to four points while Sri Lanka and Zimbabwe already have six points in their three games.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has said that the Southwest Monsoon has covered the entire India



six days before the normal date of 8th July. IMD said, the monsoon on 1st July 2023, Sunday further advanced into the remaining parts of Rajasthan, Haryana, and Punjab.

The Weather Office has predicted extremely heavy rainfall over Assam, Meghalaya, Sub-Himalayan West Bengal, Sikkim,

Coastal and South Interior Karnataka, and over Kerala over the next two days. Heavy to heavy rainfall is also likely over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Kerala, Konkan, Goa, Madhya Maharashtra, West Bengal, Sikkim, Assam, Meghalaya, and Arunachal Pradesh during the next five days. (Source: india.gov.in)


